The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did:

On May 8, 2020, at approximately 11:35 PM, the TBRCC received a request from the Saint Petersburg Police Department to assist with a traffic stop on southbound Interstate 75 north of Gibsonton Dr. Ofc. J. Woolverton initiated the stop after observing a vehicle all over the road and unable to maintain a single lane of travel. While the officer spoke with the driver, he observed the driver exhibit several signs of possible impairment and requested a trooper arrive on-scene to evaluate the driver. When I arrived on-scene, I observed the driver behind the wheel of the vehicle. Ofc. Woolverton informed me the reasoning for his stop and the signs of impairment he had observed her exhibit thus far. While I spoke with the driver, I observed her to have bloodshot watery eyes, an unsteady gait, and I detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from her facial area. I asked the driver if she would be willing to perform Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises (HGN, WAT, OLS, and FTN.) The subject consented to performing SFSEs and was taken off the interstate to a paved parking lot. The driver performed poorly on all SFSEs and was placed under arrest for DUI. The driver was transported to CBT and I requested her to provide a valid sample of her breath. The driver stated that she did not know if she should provide a breath sample. I read the driver Implied Consented in video recorded room CB-01 but the driver refused to provide a response. I informed the driver that I would begin the twenty-minute observation period and if at any point she decided whether or not she wanted to refuse, I would stop the observation period and proceed with a refusal. The subject provided two breath samples of 0.159 and 0.150. The samples were voided due to an error of control outside tolerance. The driver was provided four additional attempts to provide a breath sample but was unable to meet the volume required for the instrument. The subject was given a refusal to submit and booked into Orient Road jail. This incident occurred within Hillsborough County.
