PROBABLE CAUSE

On Saturday September 10, 2016 I, Trooper N. Tineo was on routine patrol on the Florida Turnpike in Palm Beach County. I was traveling northbound approaching the Boynton Beach Blvd exit when I observed a vehicle braking in the distance without any other vehicles near it or in front of it. The vehicle slowed to below the normal flow of traffic. As we approached the exit, the vehicle appeared to be exiting to Boynton Beach Blvd and attempted to enter the exit ramp. The vehicle then suddenly veered left and continued traveling north. The vehicle was weaving from left to right within its lane and at times straddled the solid white line on the right side of the road. The driving pattern appeared to be of someone who is sleepy, ill, or impaired.

I initiated a traffic stop and made contact with the driver. I explained to her the reason for the stop and she advised that she was fine. While engaged in conversation with her, I noticed her eyes to be bloodshot and glassy. As she looked for her documents (Drivers' license and insurance) a clear bottle caught my attention and it appeared to be that of an alcoholic beverage. The driver was identified as Velma Xavier by her Florida DL (DL # X160873748750). When I asked her where she was heading to, she stated that she was going to exit at the next exit. I then asked her what exit was that and she stated Glades Road. This traffic stop was made 12 miles north of Glades Rd and Ms. Xavier had a couple prior exits to get off the highway and head home. She handed me a few documents and stated that it was her Geico insurance. Ms. Xavier actually handed me a vehicle registration and a red Bank of American debit card ending in 2420.

Based on the events described above Ms. Xavier was asked to step out of the vehicle. As she exited the vehicle Ms. Xavier decided to wear a pair of sunglasses. She was asked if she were willing to perform field sobriety exercises and she agreed. The three standardized field sobriety exercises that were performed were HGN, walk and turn, and one leg stand. Her performance was poor.

HGN: Several attempts were made at HGN since Ms. Xavier had difficulty following directions and maintaining her head straight. She either moved her head or looked away after being instructed not to do so. Lack of smooth pursuit was present. Lack of smooth pursuit, distinct nystagmus at maximum deviation and on set prior to 45 degrees were all present. The front emergency lights of my patrol vehicle were turned off and she removed her sunglasses prior to start.

Walk and Turn: During the instruction phase Ms. Xavier was not able to hold the start position after attempting to do so more than once. She stated that she would not be able to perform this exercise because she did not have her glasses her on. Ms. Xavier advised she understood the instructions after being explained and demonstrated. This exercise was started over more than once. Instead of counting her steps out loud as instructed, she began to call out Left, Right, Left, Right as she stepped forward. She did not touch heel to toe on her way up the line and on her way down the line. Once she completed her first 9 steps, she stopped the exercise and was reminded that she had to take 9 heel to toe steps back. As she took her steps she began to crisscross her feet instead of walking heel to toe.

One Leg Stand: Ms. Xavier raised her right leg and shortly afterwards put it back down. She asked if she had to count up to 600. For safety reasons, this exercise was stopped once Ms. Xavier nearly fell back.

At 2:14am, I placed Ms. Xavier under arrest for driving under the influence. She was then transported to the Palm Beach County BAT. Once the 20 minute observation was complete, Ms. Xavier advised that she did not understand what was being asked of her when asked to provide a breath sample. I proceeded to read her implied consent and she stated that she did not understand. The BAT tech attempted to explain the process and implied consent to her. She asked for an attorney and stated that she did not know how to answer that right now. I read her implied consent again and reminded her that at this part of the breath sample she did not have the right to an attorney. At 3:13am, she was charged with DUI refusal. Implied consent and Miranda were read on camera at the BAT. There's also video available from the patrol car.

It should be noted that the bottle was later discovered to be an open container of Vodka. Ms. Xavier stated that she did not have any injuries or eye conditions that would prevent her from perform the exercise. She urinated on herself while sitting in her car. As she was doing the sobriety exercises I noticed her upper thigh and butt area to be wet. I later noticed that the driver seat was also wet. The vehicle was towed by Sister Towing.

Ms. Xavier was charged with DUI refusal, cited for proof of insurance, open container and violation of traffic control device. Ms. Xavier was then turned over to the Palm Beach County Jail staff without incident.
