that N. Peck would be heading back to his residence at 103 Midleton Way.

I responded to 103 Midleton Way, and made contact with N. Peck. I observed blood on N. Peck's head coming from a small laceration. I also observed a red mark under his eye, right cheek and nose, blood on his hands, arms and shirt. He lifted up his shirt and I observed red marks and scratches on his back. N. Peck advised me that his brother, Vincent M. Peck (WM 6/7/91) hit him over the head with a lacrosse stick. He stated they were in the downstairs living room and got into an argument over V. Peck's substance abuse issues and drinking in the house. N. Peck advised his brother got argumentative and the argument continued up the stairs. He stated V. Peck began throwing things down the stairs at N. Peck and destroying his belongings. He stated once they were upstairs, V. Peck pushed him against a glass picture frame on the wall and the glass broke and the frame fell to the floor. He then stated that he and V. Peck began wrestling on the floor when V. Peck placed N. Peck into a headlock. N. Peck stated he could not breathe and thought he was going to die. N. Peck stated his father was trying to break them up and he was able to break free and walk downstairs away from his brother. N. Peck stated once he was downstairs, V. Peck followed him and they entered the courtyard area off the kitchen. On the wall in the outdoor courtyard are several lacrosse sticks. N. Peck stated V. Peck grabbed a lacrosse stick and struck him over the head with it. During the altercation, N. Peck stated V. Peck hit his surfboard with the lacrosse stick and caused a small hole (approximately \$200). He also stated V. Peck threw his Google 4XL phone on the ground causing the entire screen to shatter (approx. \$1000), he also stated that V. Peck damaged his record player (approx. \$200). After the altercation ensued, V. Peck left the area on a white Vespa motor bike and headed north bound on S. Central Blvd from Dakota Dr. I advised other Officers to keep an eye out for that vehicle.

I observed the interior of the home to be in disarray. Upon entering the front door, I observed several items thrown about on the stairs. I also observed a lacrosse stick on the kitchen floor that had what appeared to be fresh blood on it. There was blood on the doorway from the kitchen to the courtyard, and another lacrosse stick laying on the ground with broken glass inside it. On the stairs, there was a trophy of N. Peck's that was broken into several pieces on the downstairs floor, which N. Peck stated V. Peck threw at him. Along the wall leading upstairs, I noticed several spots of blood. Once in the upstairs hallway I observed several items thrown about, including a broken picture frame and glass on the floor. There were several holes in the wall and more blood on the wall and doors. I also observed a broken wooden chair laying in the hallway. There was a record player sitting on a table at the end of the hallway and it did appear to have a broken needle.

While on scene, Officer Brandt advised that he located V. Peck driving west bound on W. Indiantown Rd. He conducted a traffic stop and made contact with V. Peck who was initially uncooperative. Officer Brandt attempted to read V. Peck his Miranda Warnings but he refused to acknowledge them. See Officer Brandt's supplement for further.

I made contact with the father, Joseph B. Peck Jr (WM 10/22/55), who advised he was upstairs when he heard his two sons arguing. He stated that he believes they were arguing about V. Peck's drinking. He stated he heard them come upstairs and when he looked out into the hallway, he saw them both on the floor with each other. He stated he tried to break them up and N. Peck walked downstairs. He stated he also went downstairs to leave the residence when he saw his son, V. Peck grab a lacrosse stick. He stated he did not see what happened with the lacrosse stick after that but he believes he heard or saw V. Peck strike the surfboard that was in the courtyard. He stated he left and walked into the garage, and a few minutes later he stated V. Peck left the residence on the white Vespa and N. Peck walked out after him. He stated he observed N. Peck to have blood on his face and head. He stated he and N. Peck left to follow V. Peck because they thought he was intoxicated and

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should not be driving, when they located Officer Arango.

I notified Officer Brandt that probable cause existed for an arrest and he placed V. Peck into handcuffs. Due to the physical altercation, Officer Brandt transported V. Peck to the Jupiter Medical Center for medical clearance. I traveled to JMC and made contact with V. Peck who was irate and argumentative. I read V. Peck his Miranda warnings from a pre-printed, department issued card. V. Peck would not acknowledge that he understood his rights and would not speak with me. V. Peck then asked me if he could press charges and wanted to ask me questions. I instructed V. Peck that in order for me to talk to him about the incident he would need to acknowledge his Miranda rights. V. Peck continually refused to acknowledge his understanding. While at JMC, V. Peck did not allow medical staff to evaluate him and refused to answer their questions. At one point, V. Peck was holding his left arm with his free hand preventing medical staff from taking his blood pressure, Officer Brandt, Officer Schnaderbeck and I had to restrain V. Peck's right arm to the other side of the hospital bed. While attempting to restrain his right arm, V. Peck was pulling his left arm away violently from medical providers while it was already handcuffed to the bed. He was medically discharged and transported back to the Jupiter Police Department for booking procedures in the back of my patrol vehicle.

While at the JPD holding facility, V. Peck requested to speak with a supervisor, and Sergeant Lilienfeld responded. V. Peck then began complaining of swelling and pain in his left wrist/arm. I transported V. Peck back to JMC for further medical evaluation. While enroute to JMC, V. Peck disclosed to me that he recently tested positive for COVID-19.

Probable cause was established to arrest V. Peck for domestic battery by strangulation pursuant to FL SS 784.041(2) (A), aggravated battery with a deadly weapon pursuant to FL SS 784.045 (1) (A) (2), and criminal mischief pursuant to FL SS 806.13 (1) (B) (3).

Vincent Peck did knowingly and intentionally, and against the will of \*(Nicholas Peck), apply pressure on the throat or neck or block the nose or mouth of \*(Nicholas Peck), impeding the normal breathing or circulation of the blood so as to create a risk of or cause great bodily harm and \*(Nicholas Peck) was a family or household member or a person in a dating relationship with \*(Vincent Peck), contrary to Florida Statute 784.041(2) and (3).

Vincent Peck did actually and intentionally touch or strike \*(Nicholas Peck) against the will of \*(Nicholas Peck), and in doing so used a \*(lacrosse stick), a deadly weapon, contrary to Florida Statute 784.045(1) (a) 2 and (2).

Vincent Peck did willfully and maliciously injure or damage, or place graffiti thereon, or commit an act of vandalism to \*(Google 4XL cell phone, record player, surfboard), the property of \*(Nicholas Peck), causing damage in an amount of \$1,000.00 dollars or greater contrary to Florida Statute 806.13(1) (a) and (b)1.
