

P R O B A B L E	<p>On 02/12/2022, at approximately 0312, I along with Sgt. Graham was dispatched to the area of 469 Juno Dunes Way (Juno Beach/Palm Beach County) in reference to a disturbance. A citizen in the neighborhood stated her neighbor was banging on peoples doors and garage doors causing a disturbance. The caller also stated the subject appeared to be "manic". Sgt. Graham and I were both in full police uniform operating a fully marked police vehicle with agency insignia. Upon our arrival, I observed items strewn across the street to include tape from one end of the street to a neighbors staircase as if to block the area off. Once I exited my vehicle, I observed a white male, later identified as the defendant Walter W. Oakden (W/M 03/13/1964), laying in the roadway screaming loudly. Oakden was wearing a long sleeve shirt with a towel around his waist and gray shoes.</p>										
	<p>We approached Oakden and asked what he was doing. Oakden stated he was making a movie and attempted to show us his props. Oakden was very loud and aggressive as he spoke. I observed several of his neighbors blinds and lights come on due to the scene Oakden was causing. While speaking with Oakden, I detected the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from his person. Oakden was very erratic standing and kneeling several times, raising his voice as he would go from his driveway to the roadway breaching the peace. At one point, Oakden jumped on the hood and roof of his BMW SUV shouting and rambling stating he wanted to kill himself. At this time we determined Oakden was a danger to himself and the community and needed to be Baker Acted for a mental health evaluation (22-000075). Oakden stated he was going into his house and demanded we leave his property (driveway). Oakden began to back up toward his open garage door which became a concern for us due to the possibility Oakden may have weapons inside his residence.</p>										
C A U S E	<p>I ordered Oakden to place his hands behind his back to be taken into custody for the Baker Act. Oakden refused and began to walk up his driveway toward his open garage door.</p>

I used my right arm to grab Oakden at which time he aggressively backed up causing me to lose my grip. Sgt. Graham then grabbed Oakden and attempted to take him to the ground but Oakden began to struggle. Sgt. Graham then successfully forced Oakden to the ground as I retrieved my CEW (Conducted Energy Weapon). Sgt. Graham landed on Oakdens back as Oakden was on his stomach flailing his arms. Sgt. Graham was able to briefly secure Oakdens arms to the ground as I secured him into handcuffs which were checked for tightness and double-locked. Oakden actively resisted Sgt. Graham and I as we attempted to take him into custody for an LEO Baker Act.

Once Oakden was secured he was placed into the rear of my patrol vehicle. I observed Sgt. Graham to have deep abrasions to his right hand caused by Oakdens active resistance. Sgt. Graham then stated he had discomfort in his shoulders from the struggle. It should be noted this occurred in the driveway which has brick pavers.

Oakden was taken to JFK north for a mental health evaluation. Oakden was still violent within my vehicle as he banged his head numerous times on the partition. At the hospital, Oakden was placed into a wheel chair as staff attempted to sedate him. While his hands were still secured behind his back, Oakden jumped from the chair, ran down the hall and leaped into a medical bed. Eventually the medication took affect and Oakden fell asleep. I unsecured Oakden and left him to be medically cleared and evaluated.

I then spoke with Sgt. Graham who stated he believes he may have internal injuries from the struggle. Sgt. Graham stated he had bruising and inflammation on both pectoral muscles and under both his arms. After completing applicable paperwork Sgt. Graham left duty and checked into Palm Beach Gardens medical facility to assess his injuries. His preliminary diagnosis was that he suffered from sprained shoulders however he would need to have an MRI. As of the writing of this PC, Sgt. Graham is unable to work due to his injuries.

After my lawful investigation, Walter W. Oakden did actually and intentionally touch or strike Sgt. Graham, a law enforcement officer, against the will of Sgt. Graham, while Sgt. Graham was engaged in the lawful performance of a duty and while Walter W. Oakden knew that Sgt. Graham was a law enforcement officer, contrary to Florida Statute 784.03(1) and 784.07(2) (b). (3 DEG FEL) (LEVEL 4)

Walter W. Oakden did knowingly and willfully resist, obstruct or oppose Sgt. Graham, a law enforcement officer of the Juno Beach Police Department, in the execution of a legal process or in the lawful execution of a legal duty, by offering or doing violence to the person of such officer, contrary to Florida Statute 843.01. (3 DEG FEL) (LEVEL 5)

Walter W. Oakden did unlawfully commit such acts as are of a nature to corrupt the public morals or outrage the sense of public decency, or affect the peace and quiet of persons who may witness them, or engaged in brawling or fighting, or engaged in conduct
