D.U.I. PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

PERSONAL CONTACT/DRIVING PATTERN/OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

I responded to the parking lot of 1475 W. Gateway Blvd in reference to a Traffic Stop conducted by Officer Cardenas. This incident occurred within the City of Boynton Beach, Palm Beach, Florida.

Upon arrival I made contact with Officer Cardenas who stated while completing a left (westbound) turn onto W. Gateway Blvd from Renaissance Commons Blvd he observed a Blue 2016 Jeep Grand Cherokee (later learned to bear Florida tag 771EC) traveling eastbound in the westbound lanes. Officer Cardenas advised that the vehicle was heading front in his direction. Officer Cardenas advised that he quickly activated his emergency equipment, at which time the Jeep slowed down. The Jeep then entered the parking lot of 1475 W. Gateway Blvd (Hampton Inn). Officer Cardenas advised that while making contact with driver/sole occupant W/F Brydge, Whitney (05/13/93), Brydge advised that she exited the parking lot of 2212 W. Gateway Blvd (Boynton Beach Ale House) and made an immediate left onto Gateway Blvd. Brydge advised that she was familiar with the area. Officer Cardenas advised that while speaking with Brydge he detected the odor of an unknown alcoholic emanating from within the vehicle and from Brydge breath. Officer Cardenas advised that Brydge's speech was thick and slurred and her eyes were glassy. Officer Cardenas advised that due to his observations and traffic infraction he contacted me to assist with a possible DUI investigation.

I then made contact with Brydge, who was still sitting in the driver seat of her vehicle. When I approached the vehicle, I noticed that Brydge was asleep. As I spoke out to Brydge she quickly woke up and opened her eyes very wide. Brydge stated again the reason why she was stopped and again stated that she wasn't familiar with the area. Brydge advised that she thought it was a one-way roadway. While speaking with Brydge I detected the odor of the unknown alcoholic emanating from her breath and from within the vehicle. Brydge's speech was thick and slurred and her eyes were glassy; just as Officer Cardenas advised. I then requested Brydge to exit the vehicle, which she complied. While escorting Brydge to the front of my patrol vehicle I noticed that she was sway side to side. While in front of my vehicle, I advised her that the investigation was being audio and video recorded, which she stated that she understood. Brydge again stated that she was at Boynton Beach Ale House, which is approximately 400 feet west from where Officer Cardenas first observed Brydge. While explaining to Brydge my observation she quickly admitting to consuming 2-3 Tito lemonades at Ale House. Brydge then advised "it might

have been a little more than that". Brydge advised that she arrived at ale house approximately 2130hrs and had left just prior to the traffic stop. While speaking wih Brydge she swayed side to side. Brydge's condition did not change at this point. Therefore, based on the above facts, I asked Brydge if she would submit to a series of Standardized Field Sobriety Task, which she agreed to. Prior to beginning I asked Brydge if she had any disability and/or injuries I should be aware of, which she stated yes. Brydge stated that she sustained a head trauma in 2013 from a soccer incident. Brydge advised that she was told it may affect her short-term memory but she doesn't feel like it does.

Pen Exercise: During the task Brydge swayed side to side. Brydge had a difficult time following the top of the pen but rather would follow the bottom of it. Brydge moved her head at times during the task.

WALK AND TURN:

The following task was demonstrated and explained to Brydge, which she stated that she understood. During the instructional stage, lost her balance and started too soon. Brydge advised that she was familiar with the task. During the walking stage, Brydge took 8 steps forward, missing heel to toe between steps 3-4. Brydge stopped and asked from further instructions. Brydge then completed 8 steps back, missing heel to toe between step 1-2.

ONE LEG STAND:

The following task was demonstrated and explained to Brydge, which she stated that she understood. During the instructional stage, Brydge swayed side to side. During the balancing stage, Brydge repeated her numbers and stopped on number 11, prior to the 30 second timer. Brydge than asked for further instructions.

FINGER TO NOSE:

The following task was demonstrated and explained to Brydge, which she stated that she understood. During the instructional, Brydge swayed side to side. During the exercise stage, Brydge missed the tip of her nose on the first and last LEFT command. Brydge touched the bridge of her nose and slid her finger down to the tip of her nose.

ROMBERG/ALPHABET:

The following task was demonstrated and explained to Brydge, which she stated that she understood. During the instructional stage, Brydge swayed side to side. During the exercise stage, there were no clues.

Based on the above facts Brydge was placed into handcuffs (D/L and Spaced) and arrested for suspicious of DUI. Brydge was then placed in the back seat of my patrol vehicle (#4734) and transported to the Palm Beach County BAT facility. As I was taking Brydge out of my patrol vehicle I noticed that she had regurgitated and held it in her mouth. Brydge cleaned out her mouth prior to the 20 minutes observations started. I arrived at the facility at 0153hrs, started my 20 minutes observations at 0205hrs and completed it at 0225hrs. At 0224hrs, Brydge regurgitated again. Brydge then rinsed out her mouth again and another 20 minutes observations was conducted starting at 0227hrs and completed at 0247hrs. Upon completion I requested Brydge to provide a sample of her breath to determine the alcohol content, which she agreed. Brydge provide a sample of .100 at 0252hrs and .104 at 0255hrs. I then read Brydge her Miranda Warnings, which she stated that she understood. Q&As were completed.

Based on the above facts, Brydge was charged with 1M count of DUI pursuant with F.S.S. 316.193.1.B. Brydge was processed and later TOT PBCJ.


