# DUI PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

## Personal Contact

### Driving Pattern

Actual physical control (physical evidence putting the driver behind the wheel)

Received a call regarding a white male non-responsive in a gray Toyota Corolla stopped in the drive-thru at 2421 Okeechobee Blvd. (McDonald's). Officers attempted to make contact with callers with unsuccessful results due to the callers no longer being on scene and did not answer telephonic communications.

Upon my arrival, I observed a gray Toyota Corolla bearing FL tag Y90UJD which was stopped in the left drive-thru lane, facing northwest. The vehicle was observed with an unresponsive white male in the driver seat, with the vehicle still in drive and running. Officers on scene positioned their vehicles along the front and rear bumper of the Toyota Corolla in order to prevent the driver from being startled and potentially causing serious bodily injury or property damage.

### Observation of Driver

The driver was sitting in the driver's seat with the vehicle still running, the gear shifter in drive, and his foot was pressed on the brake. Officers on-scene attempted wake the male by banging on the driver's window repeatedly and shining flashlights at the driver through the non-tinted windows. After almost breaking the driver's window, the driver woke up but appeared to be incoherent, as he looked around as if he did not know where he was or what was currently happening. The male driver appeared to be dazed as if he were under the influence of an unknown substance, as he had glassy and bloodshot eyes. After yelling multiple times to ask the incoherent driver to roll the window, the driver finally became responsive by looking at us and finally cooperated by rolling the window down. As the window rolled down Officers were met with the overwhelming odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage which emanated from the interior of the vehicle. Due to the vehicle still being in drive, FTO Thomas opened the driver's door and asked the driver to step out. The driver acknowledged FTO Thomas' statement by stating "yeah" two times. The driver appeared to be very lethargic as he did not step out of the vehicle after being advised to do so multiple times. This caused me to physically touch the driver's left arm to bring his focus to what Officers were asking him to do. Once touching the driver's arm, the driver proceeded to step out of the vehicle. While doing so, the driver appeared to be unsteady on his feet, as he stumbled towards me. Once ensuring the male had his footing, FTO Thomas and I proceeded to speak to the driver while evaluating if he required medical attention. With slurred speech, the driver refused medical attention multiple times by slurring "No" repeatedly. It should be known that the odor of alcohol became more profound as the male spoke to me.

### Drivers Statements:

FTO Thomas and I proceeded to speak to the driver while evaluating if he required medical attention. With slurred speech, the driver refused medical attention multiple times by slurring "No" repeatedly. FTO Thomas asked the male driver if he had any medical conditions at which time the male answered "No". FTO Thomas asked if the male understood what he just asked when the male answered "Yeah, just like getting a chicken sandwich". FTO Thomas asked again if the male had any medical conditions. The male answered, "No no no, not at all". Throughout our conversation with the male, with heavy slurred speech, the male stated he was going home and getting a chicken sandwich. When asked where he was coming from, the male stated, "just getting the spicy chicken sandwich". I again asked where the male was coming from when he stated, "in the Okeechobee Blvd". I then recognized a blue Respectable's street entry paper bracelet on his right wrist, at which point I asked if that was where he was coming from. The male answered "Yes". I asked the male if he had been drinking tonight at which time he answered "No".

Unknown alcoholic beverage(s) which emanated from his breath.

Attitude: Confused, polite.

Clothing: Short sleeve black t-shirt, black long jeans, black thick sole boots.

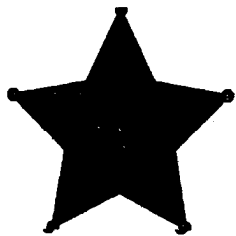
