The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did:
 On the listed date and time, the defendant and codefendant were seen via digital surveillance entering the Walmart at the listed location. While inside, the defendant and codefendant walked through various aisles within the store. The defendant and codefendant selected numerous items and concealed them within their purses. The items consisted of Tums, nail products, creams, etc. Both defendants continued to the self-checkout aisle. Once there, the defendant purposely miss scanned two boxes of "petit mango juice". Both defendants exited the store passed all points of sale without intent to pay for the items they concealed and miss scanned. The total value of the property unlawfully removed from the store was \$80.87 dollars. Both defendants were stopped by the Walmart's loss prevention employee and witness prior to law enforcement arrival. Post Miranda, both defendant's admitted to concealing the items, however, they refused to take responsibility for miss scanning the juice. Both defendant's did not take full responsibility for their actions and did not qualify for the APAD program. Both defendants identified themselves via their Florida ID. Both defendant's identifications were confirmed via D.A.V.I.D.
