On Saturday, July 16, 2022, at approximately 10:18 PM, I was stopped at the red traffic signal at the intersection of Indiantown Road and Alternate A1A when I observed a vehicle approaching the rear of my unmarked patrol vehicle at a high rate of speed not appearing to decrease speed as it approached my stopped vehicle. I further observed the vehicle abruptly stop within close proximity of my patrol vehicle. The traffic signal cycled, and I traveled southbound on Alternate A1A, where I observed the vehicle pass my view and observed the vehicle as a white Mazda Sport Utility Vehicle bearing Florida tag 63ARMV. I maintained a visual on the vehicle and observed that the unknown driver, on four different occasions, failed to maintain the lane as it traveled south in the middle lane. I also observed that the unidentified driver, later identified by her Florida driver's license as Alexandra K. Penny (W/F 10/01/1988), was traveling at 65MPH in a posted 50 MPH zone which was paced using the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office Asset number 79821 which has been calibrated. As the Mazda and I approached the intersection of Admirals Cove Boulevard and Alternate A1A, several Police vehicles stopped on the side of the road with the emergency lights activated. Penny braked abruptly, causing my vehicle to pass her and the vehicle directly behind her to honk its horn. Penny then accelerated rapidly and changed lanes directly behind my patrol vehicle while following closely until we passed the patrol vehicles with the lights activated. After observing what Penny's vehicle had done, I changed lanes to the center lane, which Penny also did. After following my patrol vehicle several hundred more feet, Penny swerved to the inside lane and rapidly accelerated passed my vehicle to approximately 62 MPH. After observing this driving pattern, I activated my emergency lights/siren and conducted a traffic stop on the Mazda. It should be noted that upon the activation of my emergency equipment, Penny abruptly stepped on the brakes and began changing lanes from the inside lane across two lanes of travel. I made contact with the driver Penny at the driver's window and immediately noticed the odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from Penny's facial area as well as her eyes were bloodshot red. I asked Penny for her driver's license, registration, and insurance, but she only provided me with the driver's license and proof of insurance after trying to hand me a gray/blue debit card.

PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: Actual physical control (physical evidence or statements putting def. behind wheel of vehicle)

On Saturday July 17, 2022 at approximately 2220hrs I responded to S. Alternate A1A and E. Frederick Small Rd, Jupiter, FL 33477 in reference to a DUI investigation. Agt. [REDACTED] had stopped a vehicle for failing to maintain a single lane and for following too closely. See Agt. [REDACTED] Supplemental Probable Cause Affidavit (attached).

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

I observed the defendant, W/F Alexandra Kervan Penny (10/01/88) who was wearing a long dress. The defendant was sitting inside the vehicle. I asked the defendant to walk over to the front of my vehicle and speak with me. While walking over to my vehicle, the defendant was unsteady on her feet and leaned against her vehicle. While standing stationary the defendant was swaying and I could see the defendants eyes were bloodshot and glossy. He/She had an obvious odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from his/her breath that grew stronger as he/she spoke. The defendants speech was slow and slurred. When [REDACTED] asked Penny for her identification she handed him a debit card.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

Penny had advised that she had been to her friends engagement party and was just a few minutes from her friends home. Penny said that she had drank several drinks and the last was three hours before the stop. She said she was fine and to please just let her go home. The defendant said she did not have any physical defects or preexisting injuries, diabetes, wear glasses or receive a bump on the head. She said she was driving the vehicle. I asked the defendant to submit to roadside field sobriety tasks to which she agreed.

ODORS:

STRONG ODOR OF AN UNKNOWN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE COMING FROM SUBJECT'S BREATH.

Other Observations:

Subject was asked to stand with their feet together and place their hands by their side. They were asked to focus on the stimulus and follow it with their eyes. Lastly they were told not to move their head to assist in following the stimulus with their eyes. Subject showed equal pupil size that tracked equally. Both eyes lacked a smooth pursuit. I saw distinct and sustained Nystagmus at maximum deviation. I also saw an onset of Nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in both eyes. Subject swayed while performing this task. Subject also turned his head to assist in following the light.

WALK & TURN:

THE DEFENDANT WAS PLACED IN THE INSTRUCTIONAL STANCE FOR THE WALK AND TURN. THIS TASK WAS EXPLAINED AND DEMONSTRATED TO THE DEFENDANT. THE DEFENDANT ACKNOWLEDGED THE INSTRUCTIONS PRIOR TO PERFORMING THIS TASK: Penny was unable to maintain balance while placed in the instructional position, swayed and abandoned the position altogether, Penny started the task too soon. During the performance Penny failed to touch heel to toe, stepped off the line, could not maintain balance while walking the line, stopped on line to steady, and turned improperly.

ONE LEG STAND:

THE DEFENDANT WAS PLACED IN THE INSTRUCTIONAL STANCE FOR THE ONE LEG STAND. THIS TASK WAS EXPLAINED AND DEMONSTRATED TO THE DEFENDANT. THE DEFENDANT ACKNOWLEDGED THE INSTRUCTIONS PRIOR TO PERFORMING THIS TASK: Penny swayed while standing, put foot down (more than once), and switched legs during the task. She also did not look at her foot during this task.

FINGER TO NOSE:

THE DEFENDANT WAS PLACED IN THE INSTRUCTIONAL STANCE FOR THE FINGER TO NOSE. THIS TASK WAS EXPLAINED AND DEMONSTRATED TO THE DEFENDANT. THE DEFENDANT ACKNOWLEDGED THE INSTRUCTIONS PRIOR TO PERFORMING THIS TASK: Penny swayed while placed in the instructional position, failed to touch the tip of her finger to the tip of her nose on all six attempts, rather touched underneath, sides and the bridge of nose with the pad of the finger, on the counter request Penny (flinched, raised more than half way or raised the wrong arm).

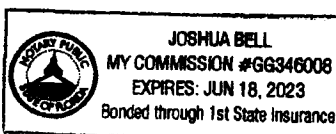
