PERSONAL CONTACT/DRIVING PATTERN/OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

On October 16, 2022, at approximately 2259 hrs., I responded to 3625 S federal Highway in reference to a suspicious incident.

Contact was made with a witness by Officer Drury who stated the following;

"On Saturday, October 15, 2022, at approximately 2300 hours I responded to the area of 3625 S Federal Highway, Boynton Beach, FL 33435 (Wal-Mart) in reference to a reckless driver. Communications personnel advised the complainant had an unknown female following her and honking at her.

Upon arrival, officers made contact with W/F Amanda Guis (DOB: 8/3/1997). The female half who Guis advised was following her was standing by in the parking lot to meet with officers. I made contact with the female, later identified as off-duty Florida Highway Patrol Trooper Petrina Easton. Easton provided a sworn statement and advised she had been behind the black Ford Escape that Guis was driving since approximately Atlantic Avenue and Federal Highway in Delray Beach, FL. Easton stated that the vehicle was never able to maintain a lane for more than 30 seconds. She advised the vehicle was traveling in the left lane northbound and veered right, crossing the striped line causing the entire vehicle to enter the right lane and then veering back to the left lane. Easton also advised that the Escape began to drift into the right lane causing a vehicle immediately to its right to have to hit their brakes to avoid a collision. Once at the intersection of Gulfstream BLVD and S Federal Highway, the Ford Escape made a left hand turn in front of oncoming traffic that was traveling southbound on Federal Highway. This action almost caused a vehicle accident. Once the vehicle entered the Wal-Mart parking lot, Easton made contact with the driver, who she identified as Guis, and notified her that she was a Trooper and concerned of her driving behavior. Guis argued with Easton and then circled the parking lot multiple times until Boynton Beach Police arrived on scene. Easton did confirm that Guis never exited her vehicle and was in the driver's seat throughout the incident. Guis was still in the driver's seat of the black 2017 Ford Escape, bearing FL tag IDJC13 when BBPD officers made contact."

I approached the driver's side of Guis' vehicle (IDJC13 FL tag) where I was able to immediately detect the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from within the vehicle as the driver's side window was down. I was able to observe that Guis was the driver and the only occupant of vehicle, the keys were in the ignition and the vehicle was in running. As I spoke with Guis the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage only grew stronger as Guis spoke. Guis advised that she had left a friend's house located in Delray Beach and was headed to her residence which she advised was located on Buttonwood Rd. (should be Buttonwood Ln.). Guis advised that while at her friend's house she consumed 2 Sunday beers approximately 2 hrs. prior to her encounter with Officers. While speaking with Guis I was able to observe her to have slurred speech, trouble pronouncing words and bloodshot glassy eyes.

Based on the information gathered thus far I asked Guis to step out of the vehicle to which she refused as she "did not want to". I then gave Guis a second lawful order to step out of the vehicle which she once again she refused as she "did not want to". I advised Guis she was under arrest for resisting arrest without violence and then gave a final order for Guis to step out of the vehicle to which she once again refused. Due to Guis refusing multiple lawful orders to step out of the vehicle I reached inside of the vehicle, unlocked the driver's door, opened the door and escorted Guis out of the vehicle.

While walking Guis to the front of her vehicle Guis had a hard time keeping her balance.

Based on the above obtained information and the evidence in which I observed, I asked Guis if she was willing to submit to a series of road side sobriety tasks in order to dispel my fears that she is unable to

safely drive her vehicle. Guis refused to conduct the tasks at which time I informed her of her Taylor warnings. Guis then agreed to go perform the tasks.

The results of the tasks are as follows;

HORIZONTAL GAZE NYSTAGMUS:

WALK AND TURN:

During the instructional phase of this task Guis repeatedly lost her balance, swayed side to side and had to be reminded to stand in the instructional position. This task was explained to Guis multiple times which she continuously advised was not possible and that it was an acrobat stunt. Guis then stated that she had bad balance but followed up with her balance was fine and she could perform the task and that she understood the tasks. During this task Guis Missed heel to toe, stepped off line, used her arms for balance with each step and walked forward 13 steps. Guis then conducted an improper turn asked if she should continue and continued back missing heel to toe, stepping off line, using her arms for balance with each step and walking back 12 steps before stopping.

ONE LEG STAND:

During the instructional phase of this task Guis repeatedly lost her balance, swayed side to side and had to be reminded to stand in the instructional position. I explained and demonstrated this task to Guis multiple times until she stated she understood. Guis stated that she would have trouble completing this task as she did "The Rocks leg workout" yesterday and was sore. Guis was able to balance on her left foot utilizing his arms for balance for approximately two seconds on her first try then dropped his foot and approximately two seconds on her second try. Guis then stated that she was going to switch feet and was able to balance for approximately seven seconds on her right foot.

FINGER TO NOSE:

I explained and demonstrated this task to which she stated that she understood. Upon beginning this task Guis swayed from front to back, did not close her eyes or tilt her head back, did not touch the tip of her nose and waited till the next instruction to bring her hand back down to her side.

ROMBERG/ALPHABET:

I explained and demonstrated this task to Guis who stated she understood. While completing this task Guis swayed front to back and then stated S, T, O, V W, X, Y, M, Z.

Based on the above, Guis was placed under arrest (handcuffed D/L and checked for tightness) at 0000 hrs. Once at PBCJ, I began a required 20 min. observation period at 0027 hrs. After completing this, I requested Guis submit to a lawful sample of his breath for the purpose of determining its alcohol content.

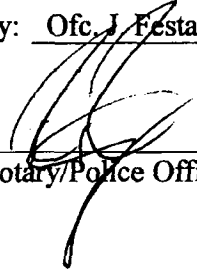
Guis attempted to submit her first valid breath sample but after numerous chances at providing a sample and being unable to follow directions the breathalyzer timed out at 0056. I then read implied consent to guis and she then refused to try again at 0059 hrs. I informed Guis of her Miranda warnings to which she stated that she understood. In attempting the question and answer portion Guis invoked her right to not answer questions.

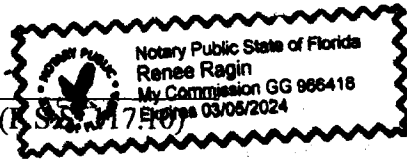
Based on the above I find probable cause to charge Amanda Desiree Gius with DUI refusal pursuant to FSS # 316.193(1)(A) and Resisting without violence Pursuant to FSS # 843.02. Gius was then processed and turned over to the quality care and control of the PBCJ.
