The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did

The defendant was operating a black 2017 Honda CR-V, 4 door, Florida tag CBGI45. The defendant backed out of a parking space, backing directly backward and struck the passenger side rear bumper of a white 2020 Nissan Rogue, 4 door, Florida tag PDPT29, causing an estimated \$500.00 in damage to the bumper; and she also struck the driver side rear bumper of a white 2020 BMW 228i, 4 door, Florida tag PDRS04, causing an estimated \$500.00 in damage to the bumper. The defendant was observed driving the vehicle, and was positively identified as the driver at the time of the crash by the listed civilian witness. A video surveillance recording from a camera in the business parking lot captured the events and shows the defendant exit the vehicle after the crash to inspect the damage (video collected for evidence by Officer C. Miller). During the civil crash investigation Officers D. Janicijevic and C. Martin noted signs of impairment with the defendant to include the distinct odor of an alcoholic beverage on her breath, glassy and watery eyes, slurred speech, and unsteadiness on her feet. I responded to the crash scene in my capacity as a DUI investigator. I met with the defendant and advised her the civil crash investigation was complete and a criminal DUI investigation was being conducted. I read the defendant her Miranda Rights, to which she agreed to speak to me without an attorney present. The defendant had a strong an distinct odor of an alcoholic beverage on her breath. The defendant's eyes were bloodshot, glassy, and watery. The defendant's speech was slurred, and her face was flushed. The defendant was unsteady exiting her vehicle and she her gait was unsteady. The defendant had difficulty recalling her home address and her email address. The defendant swayed noticeably while standing. The defendant stated she did consume two glasses of straight vodka at the wedding event she was attending. The defendant refused to submit to Field Sobriety Exercises, even after being advised of the purposes of the FSE's and the possible consequences of refusal. The defendant exhibited signs and clues of impairment, and based on a totality of the circumstances she was arrested for DUI. The defendant refused to submit to a lawful test of her breath for the purpose of determining its alcohol content after she was read the Implied Consent Warnings. The defendant was positively identified by her Florida DL.
