The affiant responded to the scene, observed the defendant to have watery/glassy eyes, bloodshot eyes, he was unsteady on his feet, and detected the distinct odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath. The affiant requested the defendant perform Standard Field Sobriety Exercises (SFSES) which the defendant agreed to perform. During the exercises, the defendant showed multiple signs of impairment and was subsequently arrested for DUI. The defendant agreed to provide a lawful sample of his breath to determine his breath alcohol content (BrAC). Breath Technician J. Piercy (ABN 4553) provided me with the BrAC results and they are as follows: First BrAC sample .149, Second BrAC sample .138. The defendant was identified via FL DL. The defendant was issued a DUI citation (AFYJT6E) which reflects the charge.
