On the 1 day of November, 2022 at 02:24 (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

On 11/01/2022 at approximately 0200 hours, I was conducting routine patrol at 200 S Federal Hwy facing northbound when I observed a dark-colored sedan driving northbound on Federal Hwy and ran a red light at Palmetto Park Rd and Federal Hwy. I then followed this vehicle northbound on Federal Hwy attempting to catch up to it for a traffic stop. While maintaining an approximate speed of 75 mph, I was unable to catch up to the vehicle, so I informed Ofc. Williams, who was near Yamato Rd and Federal Hwy to assist with speed measurement for a dark-colored sedan in lane 2 driving northbound. Ofc. Williams visually estimated and confirmed the vehicle's speed with his certified Stalker radar at 74mph in a clearly posted 45mph zone. Ofc. Williams then got behind this vehicle, a dark gray Ford bearing FL tag 46BZGW, which I had been following from Palmetto Park Rd, and initiated a traffic stop by activating his lights and sirens in his marked police vehicle.

The vehicle came to a stop at approximately 5000 N Federal Hwy. Myself and Ofc. Williams then made contact with the driver and sole occupant of the vehicle. I informed the driver that he had been speeding and ran a red light. The driver apologized and acknowledged he was speeding, advising he was trying to get to his friend's house in Delray. I asked the driver for his driver's license, vehicle registration, and insurance. The driver provided me his FL DL, identifying him to Brendan Reyes. Reyes informed me he was coming from O'Brien's, a local bar in Boca Raton, where he consumed one beer. I noticed Reyes' eyes were glossy and dilated.

Based on my concern that Reyes was possibly operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol and/or a chemically controlled substance, I asked Reyes to step outside of the vehicle to speak with me. Reyes then willingly stepped outside. I then asked Reyes if he would be willing to participate in field sobriety tasks to dispel my alarm that he was impaired. Reyes agreed to participate in the tasks. The tasks were captured on Ofc. William's In-Car Video. I then guided Reyes over to a flat, dry, and

P R O B A B L E C A U S E	<p>leveled surface with a solid white line. I asked Reyes to identify the color of the line, to which he replied "white," and then he pointed to the white line. According to Reyes, he has no physical injuries, he is not taking any prescription medications, he does not have any medical issues, he has no issues with his eyes that are not corrected by contact lenses or glasses, his primary language is English, he is not diabetic, and his highest level of education is a high school diploma. While speaking with Reyes, I could smell a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage on his breath and person. Reyes was also wearing a purple wrist band commonly used for entry into bars/clubs. I explained and demonstrated each task before Reyes performed them.</p> <p>The first task was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus. Reyes advised he does not use glasses or contact lenses to see. After explaining the instructions, I asked Reyes if he understood. He replied yes. I then asked if he had any questions, and he replied no. During this task, I observed equal tracking in both eyes, lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes, distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes, and onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in both eyes.</p> <p>The second task was the Walk and Turn. After explaining the instructions, I asked Reyes if he had any questions. He replied "no." I then asked if he understood the task, and he replied "yes." Reyes chose to perform the task with his shoes on. Reyes did not remain in the starting position as I instructed him to while I explained the instructions. Reyes then took 9 steps forward, turned around incorrectly, and took 9 steps back. He did maintain heel-to-toe and counted out loud.</p> <p>The third task was the One Leg Stand. After explaining the instructions, I asked Reyes if he had any questions. He replied "no." I then asked if he understood the task, and he replied "yes." Reyes lifted his left leg. He performed this task without issue.</p> <p>The fourth task was the Finger to Nose (L-R-L-R-R-L). After I explained and demonstrated the task, he advised he understood. He showed me he knew what hand was his left and right. He also showed me he knew what his index finger was, and where the tip of his nose was. On his first left, he touched his nose then brought it down and touched his nose again. While his eyes were closed, Reyes was swaying.</p> <p>The fifth task was Rhomberg Balance (estimate 30 sequence). After explaining the instructions, I asked Reyes if he had any questions. He replied "no." I then asked if he understood the task, and he replied "yes." Reyes estimated 30 seconds in 27 seconds.</p> <p>The sixth and final task was the Rhomberg Alphabet. Reyes stated he could recite the English alphabet without singing it or skipping any letters without issue. I then asked if he had any questions, and he replied, no. Reyes then recited the English alphabet correctly, however, stopped at "R" then continued until "Z."</p>

	<p>Based on Reyes` driving pattern, my observations, and his performance on the SFST`s, I developed probable cause to arrest Brendan Reyes for DUI pursuant to F.S.S. 316.193(1)(a). I handcuffed Reyes, checked for tightness and proper fit. Ofc. Williams conducted a search of his person and then placed him into my marked police vehicle. I then transported Reyes to BRPD booking facility BAT room. Ofc. Williams responded to BRPD BAT as my breath tech operator. Upon arrival, a 20-minute observation was conducted. Reyes was then taken into the BAT room. Reyes agreed to provide a sample of his breath for the purpose of determining the alcohol content. Reyes provided two samples of 0.061 and 0.064. I then requested a urine sample. Reyes agreed to provide a urine sample, and one was collected by Ofc. Williams at 0335 hours on 11/01/2022. I read Reyes his Constitutional Warnings, and he advised he understood, and agreed to answer my questions. Brendan Reyes is being charged with DUI pursuant to F.S.S. 316.193(1)(a). I issued Reyes a uniform citation (#AG415JE). I also issued Reyes a citation for speeding 74mph in a 45mph zone, which was the reason for the traffic stop (#AG41C8E).</p>



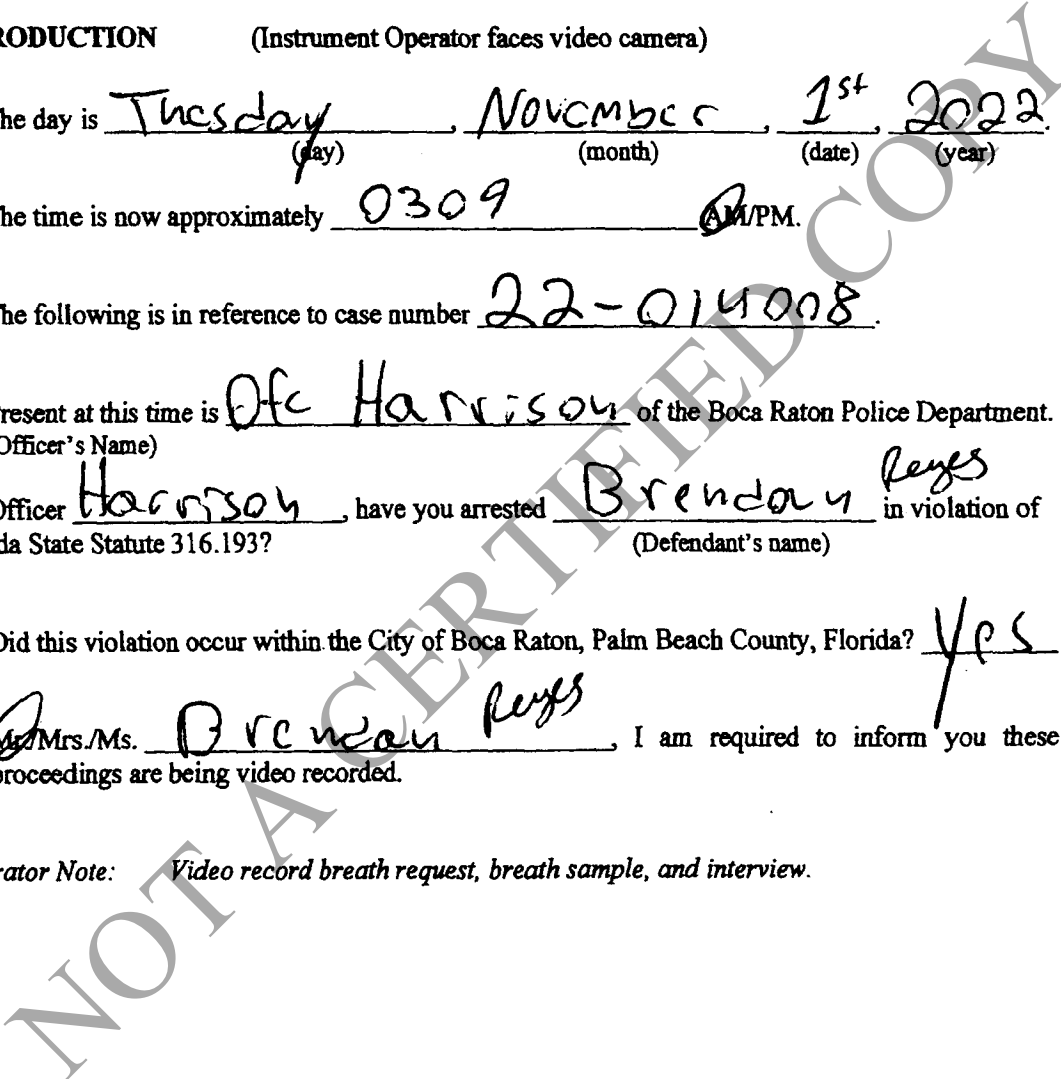

JUVENILE CONSTITUTIONAL WARNINGS

Rights of suspects prior to custodial questioning.

Identify yourself and state:

I am required to warn you before you make any statement that you have the following Constitutional rights:

-) You have the right to remain silent and not answer any questions. *Tell me in your own words what you think this means. (You do not have to talk to me or answer any questions about this offense. You can be quiet if you want.)*
-) Any statement you make must be freely and voluntarily given. *Tell me in your own words what you think this means. (If you do talk to me it has to be because you want to and not because anyone is forcing you to speak.)*
-) You have a right to the presence and representation of a lawyer of your choice before you make any statement and during any questioning. *Tell me in your own words what you think this means. (You can talk to a lawyer before we ask you any questions and you can have him/her with you now, during our questioning.)*
-) If you cannot afford a lawyer, you are entitled to the presence and representation of a court appointed lawyer before you make any statement and during any questioning. *Tell me in your own words what you think this means (If you do not have money for a lawyer and you want one, a lawyer will be given to you for free.)*
-) If at any time during the interview you do not wish to answer any questions, you are privileged to remain silent. *Tell me in your own words what you think this means. (If you decide to talk to me then change your mind, you can stop answering my questions at any time.)*
-) I can make no threats or promises to induce you to make a statement. This must be of your own free will. *Tell me in your own words what you think this means (I am not allowed to threaten you or make you any promises to get you to talk to me. If you decide to talk, it must be because you want to.)*
-) Any statement can be and will be used against you in a court of law. *Tell me in your own words what you think this means (Anything you say to me can and will be told to the judge or a jury in court. A judge is a person who decides if you have done something wrong. Sometimes a group of people called a jury decide this, but the Judge is the person who decides what punishment you get.)*
-) Do you understand these rights as I have read them to you, and do you wish to speak to me?
