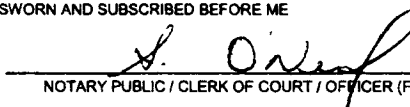
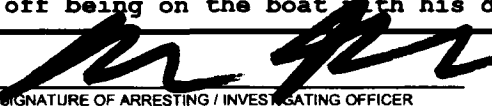


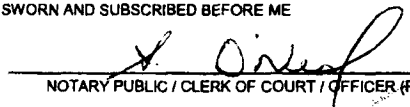

On the 9 day of July, 2022 at 21:50 (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.) On 07/09/2022 at approximately 2150 hours, this Officer was conducting speed enforcement in the area of the 2400-block PGA Blvd, PBG, FL, when a vehicle was observed traveling at an increased rate of speed east bound in the middle through lane. Body worn camera and in car video were used in the investigation. This Officer initially observed the vehicle, a black Mercedes sedan (49BHLZ/FL) conduct a lawful U-turn from west bound PGA Blvd to east bound PGA Blvd in the same block as this Officer. The vehicle then rapidly accelerated to what this Officer visually estimated to be approximately 70 MPH in a posted 40 MPH zone. Using RADAR Stalker DSR2X (DB001317), front antenna (KC086606) this Officer received a steady tone and reading of 67 MPH. The RADAR calibration was last checked on 05/09/2022 and was due on 11/09/2022. Prior to this tour of duty on this date, this Officer ensured the RADAR was in working order, to confirm the accuracy of the unit. At the end of this tour of duty, this Officer did the same. This Officer received RADAR/LIDAR certification on 05/31/2008, in Cannon AFB, NM. This Officer entered the same lane as the vehicle and pulled up behind same in the inside through lane at a red light for the intersection of Ellison Wilson Rd. Once the light changed to green, the vehicle continued forward then almost struck a raised concrete median on the opposite side of the intersection. This Officer then activated overhead red and blue lights to initiate a traffic stop. The vehicle slowed in the far right lane, then traveled across three other lanes to the right side of the road. This Officer made contact with the driver and sole occupant, identified via Florida Driver License photo, Chandler Prescott (OF) while he was still in actual physical control of same. Prescott had a flushed red face, a slur in his speech, glassy watery eyes, and this Officer was able to detect the obvious odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath at conversational distance. Prescott acknowledged he was speeding and said he just got off being on the boat with his dad.

Prescott said he was on his way home which is why he made the U-turn. It should be noted, the direction Prescott was traveling was not practical for taking a direct route to his residence. Prescott admitted to consuming "a little bit" to drink and said he was "fine now". Based on this Officer's observations, Prescott was asked to participate in Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises, to which he complied. Prescott said he did not have any medical conditions which would affect the exercises performed. The first exercise conducted, was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus. The stimulus used was a Stylus Streamlight with an illuminated red tip. This Officer observed a lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes and sustained involuntary jerking in both eyes at maximum deviation as well as the onset of Nystagmus in both eyes prior to 45 degrees. The second exercise conducted, was the Walk and Turn. The line used was a strip of yellow tape placed upon the pavement by this Officer. During the instructions, Prescott stepped out of the starting position and raised his arms from his sides. During the first set of steps, Prescott raised his arms more than six inches from his sides and missed heel-to-toe one time. Prior to the turnaround, Prescott paused and looked at this Officer. During the return set of steps, Prescott missed heel-to-toe three times. The third exercise conducted, was the One-Leg Stand. During the exercise, Prescott raised his left foot. Prescott swayed during the exercise and raised his foot less than six inches from the ground. The fourth exercise conducted, was the Finger to Nose. During the exercise, the following observations were made: During all six commands, Prescott used the pad of his corresponding finger to touch the tip of his nose. The fifth exercise conducted, was the Modified Rhomberg Balance. During the exercise, Prescott estimated the passage of 30 seconds in approximately 59 seconds. Based on this Officer's observations, Prescott was placed under arrest at 2205 hours. On the roadside, this Officer requested Prescott to provide a breath sample for the purpose of determining its alcohol content, to which he requested a lawyer. This Officer read Florida Implied Consent, via Florida DOT Cards to Prescott to which he acknowledged and agreed to provide a breath sample. During a tow inventory of the vehicle, medical Marijuana belonging to Prescott's grandmother was located in the center console. A metal "grinder" containing a small amount of Cannabis within was in the center console as well. This Officer also located a glass smoking bowl with burnt Cannabis residue contained within, in the driver door pocket. Since Prescott mentioned the vehicle belonging to his brother and the Cannabis belonging to his grandmother, it was determined the items most likely did not belong to Prescott and were left in place.

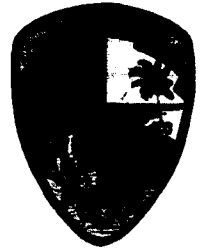
