Driving Pattern

Actual physical control (physical evidence putting the driver behind the wheel)

On July 1, 2022, at approximately 0354 I was making a welfare check on a male passed out behind the wheel of his vehicle. About twenty minutes prior Officer Perdigone had watched the vehicle drive very slowly east on Datura St. Officer Perdigone watched as the driver, Christian Bieler, parked his Silver BMW (FL/19BVBB) facing eastbound at the 100 BLK of Datura St. When Officer Perdigone drove back by westbound approximately fifteen minutes later he observed Christian passed out behind the wheel. I arrived on scene and made contact with Christian to make a welfare check. Christian told me he was not having a medical emergency and did not need medical attention.

Observation of Driver

I observed Christian had bloodshot/glassy eyes. There was a strong odor of alcohol coming from Christian. Christian's speech was slurred. Christian was very unsteady as he walked.

Drivers Statements:

At first Christian denied driving to where he was parked but eventually stated he drove to where he was parked from a bar at Rosemary square. Christian stated he parked because he was too drunk to drive all the way home. Christian said he had three strong vodka drinks about two hours prior to driving.

Odors:

Christian had a strong odor of Alcohol coming from him that became stronger as he spoke.

General Observations

Speech: Slurred

Attitude: Calm

Clothing: Gray shirt and blue jeans

Medical Problems/Medications: None

Other: I transported Christian to the PBSO BAT where Christian became combative and refused to give a sample for the state approved breath test. Christian was read implied consent and again refused.

I asked Christian if he had any medical issues with his eyes that were not corrected with glasses or contacts. Christian advised he did not. I asked Christian if he wore glasses or contacts and he stated he did wear glasses. I explained to Christian I would be checking his eyes and gave him instructions to follow my finger with his eyes and only his eyes. I held up my right index finger and told Christian to look at the tip of my finger. I told Christian to keep his head still. Christian stated he understood. I checked Christian's eyes for equal pupil size and resting nystagmus. Christian had equal pupil size and did not have resting nystagmus. I told Christian with his eyes and only his eyes to follow the tip of my finger. I attempted to make two passes with my finger from center to maximum deviation then back to center on each eye to check Christian's eyes for equal tracking. However, Christian would not follow instructions by either not looking at my finger or moving his head. I had to make multiple passes. I had to stop to ensure Christian understood the instructions and he stated he understood the instructions. Christian was able to follow directions well enough to confirm Christian's eyes tracked equally. After medically qualifying Christian I immediately started two passes on each eye from center to maximum deviation then back to center to check for lack of smooth pursuit. However, Christian would not follow instructions by not looking at my finger. Christian had to be given instruction multiple times. Multiple passes had to be made to complete the evaluation. Eventually I was able to have Christian follow directions well enough, and I saw nystagmus in each eye. After checking for lack of smooth pursuit I immediately started two passes on each eye to check for distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation. I moved my finger from center to maximum deviation, holding at maximum deviation for approximately eight seconds then back to center for both eyes. Again, Christian had trouble following directions and additionally passes had to be made. I saw distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation for each eye. I then started two passes on each eye to check for onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees. Christian continued to fail to follow directions, however, was able to follow well enough to complete the evaluation. I saw nystagmus prior to 45 degrees on each eye during both passes. After checking for onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees, I started two passes for vertical nystagmus and did not see nystagmus in either eye.

Walk and Turn Task

I instructed Christian to stand with his feet together and his arms down by his side. I asked Christian to put his right heel touching his left toe along a line (traffic line) extending straight off his left toe and to remain standing in that position until I told him to begin the evaluation. I asked Christian if he understood those instructions and he stated he did. I instructed Christian when I told him to, he would take nine heel to toe steps along the line in front of him. I told Christian that on his ninth step he would leave his lead foot on the line and make a series of small steps around and make nine heel to toe steps back along the same line. I told Christian that it would look exactly like this and demonstrated the evaluation for him. I demonstrated the evaluation for Christian. I told Christian there were four things I wanted him to keep in mind while completing the evaluation. I told him to look at his feet at all times, count his steps out loud, keep his arms at his side at all times, and to not stop until he had completed the evaluation. Christian asked me to explain the instructions again. After giving Christian the instructions again, he stated he understood. Christian was unable to maintain balance during the instructional stage. While conducting the evaluation Christian displayed all six clues (stops while walking, steps off line, missed heel to toe, uses arms for balance, incorrect number of steps and incorrect turn). Christian also failed to follow instructions and only walked in one direction. Christian would return back to where he started and walk down the line again. Eventually I had to stop Christian from walking.

One Leg Stand

I asked Christian to stand with his feet together and his arms down by his side and I would tell him when to begin. I told Christian when I told him to, I wanted him raise either one of his feet approximately six inches off the ground, parallel to the ground, and count out loud in the manner of "one thousand one, one thousand two, one thousand three" and so on until I told him to stop. I told Christian it would look exactly like this and demonstrated it for him. I told Christian there were four things I wanted him to keep in mind while performing the evaluation. I told Christian to look at his raised foot at all times, count out loud, keep his arms at his side at all times, and to not put his foot down until I told him to stop. I asked Christian if he understood these instructions and he stated he did. While conducting the evaluation Christian displayed three of four clues (Puts foot down, uses arms for balance, sways).

Finger To Nose

I told Christian to stand with his feet together and his arms by his side. I asked Christian if he knew his right from his left and he demonstrated he did. I had Christian extend his index fingers while making a fist. I had Christian face his palms toward me with his arms by his side. I told Christian when I told him to, I wanted him to close his eyes and tilt his head back. I advised Christian when I instructed him to, I would tell him either left or right. I told Christian if I said right, I wanted him to touch the tip of his right finger to his nose and then return his hand back to his side. I told Christian if I said left, I wanted him to touch the tip of his left finger to his nose and then return his hand back to his side. I asked Christian if he understood, and he stated he did. During the evaluation Christian missed touching tip to tip on three commands. Christian also failed to keep his head tilted back and his body had a significant sway. At one point Christian almost fell over and he had to get back in position.

Romberg Balance

I told Christian to stand with his feet together and his arms by his side. I told Christian when I instructed him to, I wanted him to tilt his head back and close his eyes. I told Christian I wanted him to approximate thirty seconds in his head. I told Christian when he finished to look at me and tell me he was done. I asked Christian if he understood those instructions and he stated he did. While conducting the evaluation Christian failed to keep his head back and his body had a significant sway. Christian stated he was finished after approximately 30 seconds.

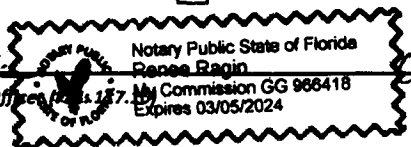

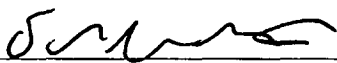
