## D.U.I. PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

### PERSONAL CONTACT/DRIVING PATTERN/OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

On September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at approximately 0246 hours, I was traveling Northbound on 1500 block of N. Federal Highway, Boynton Beach; when I observed a Black Volvo traveling Northbound at 44mph in a 35mph zone. The attached tag was confirmed to be NYtag JDL3493. Prior to me initiating my emergency lights the vehicle turned eastbound onto Gateway Blvd.

Pursuant to FSS 316.187(1), I conducted a traffic stop on the Black Volvo that cocluded at the 600 block of E Gateway Blvd. I walked up the vehicle that had all of its windows rolled up. I knocked on the vehicle and the operator had opened the truck of the vehicle. As the truck opened, I yelled out to the operator to roll down the vehicle's window. I made contact with the driver who was currently sitting in the driver seat of the previously mentioned vehicle. He was later identified as W/M Harkins, Conor (3/19/99) by his New York driver license. I asked Harkins for their license, registration and proof of insurance. As they retrieved these items I noticed his eyes were red, watery and glossy. Their cheeks were flushed, mouth dry and they slurred their speech while speaking. Their movements were slow, calculated and lethargic. I could smell a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from the inside of his vehicle. While gathering the requested documents Harkins had difficulty locating his registration that was in his hand and he looked over multiple times. I assisted Harkins by pointing out his registration that was in his possession. I asked Harkins where he was coming from and he stated that he is coming from Delray Beach, FL. Harkins stated that he was currently going to Delray Beach, FL. Harkins stated that he turned East on Gateway Blvd to travel on A1A. It should be noted that Harkins was currently in Boynton Beach which is north of Delray Beach, FL and was traveling Northbound. Harkins also turned eastbound on Gateway Blvd to access A1A but there is no A1A access on E Gateway Blvd. Harkins stated that he was following his GPS.

Based on the above mentioned encounter I asked Harkins to step out of the vehicle. As Harkins was exiting his vehicle, he stumbled and had to reset his footing. While outside of the vehicle Harkins changed his statement and stated that he was in the area to drop off his friend (unknown address) and is currently heading home. Harkins later stated that he was heading to another bar in Lake Worth Beach called sneakers. I asked Harkins if they had been drinking alcoholic beverages. Harkins stated that he had approximately 2 beers about one hour ago at El Camino and Park Tavern in Delray Beach, FL. Based on my suspicion, I asked if Harkins would consent to performing Standardized Field Sobriety Evaluations (SFSTs) for the purpose of determining if he was impaired while operating a motor vehicle. Harkins refused and I explained Taylor Warning informing Harkins that the SFSTS were voluntary and he did not have to perform them; however in the absence of their performance, I would be only left with the physical evidence of impairment before me. I informed Harkins that he decision would be considered in a criminal proceeding. I asked if Harkins understood the warnings, after further explanation Harkins stated that he did and agreed to perform the task.

Prior to their performance, I asked if they had any physical problems with their body that would inhibit them from performing light physical exercises. Harkins stated that he has a bad shoulder. I escorted Harkins to a level surface that was smooth and free from obstructions and debris. I could now smell a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from Harkins breath that intensified when they

spoke. I placed a orange strip of masking tape on the surface that formed a line. Harkins identified the tape by giving its color and placing their left foot on it when prompt to do so. The following SFSTs were explained, demonstrated and acknowledged by him prior to his performance: HGN, The Walk and Turn, The One Leg Stand, The Finger to Nose and The Romberg Alphabet Recitation. Harkins deficiencies were recorded on another form in this work sheet. At the conclusion of the SFSTs, coupled with my observation of Harkins' vehicle in motion and my observation of personal indicators of impairment exhibited by the defendant, probable cause was established for DUI. I told Harkins he was being placed under lawful arrest for suspicion of DUI pursuant to FSS 316.193(1). Harkins were searched and handcuffed (double locked and checked for tightness) prior to being seated into the rear of my patrol car (Vehicle 4038). Back up Officers arranged for the defendant's vehicle to be towed by Beck's Towing.

**WALK AND TURN:**

This task was explained and demonstrated to several times and Harkins, and he stated he understood. Harkins was unable to keep his balance while I was explaining the instructions. Harkins started too soon. Harkins used his arms for balance. Harkins missed heel to toe. Harkins took the incorrect number of steps. Harkins turned improperly. I attempted to give Harkins another opportunity but he asked to move on to other task.

**ONE LEG STAND:**

This task was explained and demonstrated to several times and Harkins, and he stated he understood. Harkins started to soon. While performing the task Harkins, used his arms for balance and he put his food down more than three times.

**FINGER TO NOSE:**

This task was explained and demonstrated to several times and Harkins, and he stated he understood. While performing the task Harkins did several movements that were not demonstrated to him several times and had to be corrected each time. Harkins, acknowledged each time that he understood that he was not to perform the such movement. Harkins failed to return his arms back down to his side. Harkins finger missed his nose.

**ROMBERG/ALPHABET:**

This task was explained and demonstrated to several times and Harkins, and he stated he understood. While performing the task Harkins did not follow instructions by not closing his eyes and tilting his head back. Harkins swayed more than two inches in each direction.


I then transported Harkins to Palm Beach County Breathalyzer. Upon my arrival at 0403 hours, I completed the required 20-minute observation. I then requested Harkins provide a sample of his breath for the purpose of determining the alcohol content. Harkins refused my request, at which time I read him Implied Consent, which he stated he understood. A second request was made to Harkins to provide a sample of his breath. After further explanations Harkins was again refused.

At this time, due to the above mentioned information I have established probable cause to charge Harkins with one count of DUI pursuant to FSS 316.193(1). I issued Harkins citations for his Speeds (AG4JVME) & DUI (AE157RE). The citations were explained to Harkins to include the court date and offense. Harkins was given ample time to review and sign the documents and after several moments he asked if he can sign the documents later instead of at moment it was issued. While processing Harkins, he became argumentative and refused to sign the issued citations. Harkins made requests for his lawyer to be present. Harkins was additionally charged with Refusal to accept/sign summons FSS 318.14(3).


Upon completion of the booking process, Harkins was turned over to Palm Beach County Jail.

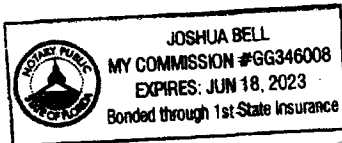

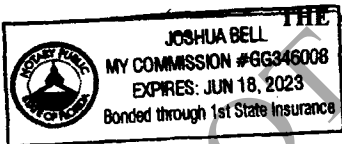
