The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did
 On 02/01/2022, I was dispatched to a vehicle crash at Dale Mabry Highway and Lambright Street in Tampa, Florida. Upon Arrival, I observed a white Volvo with extensive left front damage. As I walked the scene, I also observed a black Nissan involved in the crash with extensive right rear damage. I made contact with the driver of the black Nissan, Maria Diaz, who advised me that she was rear ended while traveling northbound on Dale Mabry Hwy just south of Lambright Street. Ms. Diaz advised that she observed the driver of the white Volvo in the driver seat in actual physical control of the Volvo. I made contact with the driver of the Volvo who was identified by her Florida driver License # N142-233-88-8650, as Elizabeth Nieblas. Ms. Nieblas was uncooperative while speaking to her. I could smell a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from her mouth area and her person. Ms. Nieblas had slurred speech and bloodshot eyes and decided to sit down at one point because she didn't want to stand. I changed from a crash investigation to a criminal investigation due to having reasonable suspicion and probable cause to believe that she was under the influence of an alcoholic beverage, chemical, or controlled substance. I asked Ms. Nieblas if she would be willing to perform voluntary roadside exercises which she refused. Ms. Nieblas was placed into handcuffs and became uncooperative while being escorted to my patrol vehicle. Ms. Nieblas was transported to the Central breath testing facility where she consented to a breath test. The results were a .236 and a .234. Appropriate documentation was conducted. Ms. Nieblas was then walked over to the County Jail and charged with DUI with property damage. All events occurred in Hillsborough County, Florida.
