MVR is available. On Thursday July 21st, 2022, at approximately 1308 hours, I responded to the area of 1300 NW 2nd Ave in reference to a delayed accident. Prior to my arrival, BRPD dispatch received a call of a white pickup truck that had ran over a traffic sign and fled the area westbound on NW 11th St. While sitting at the southbound traffic light to go southbound on NW 2nd Ave through W Glades Rd, I noticed a white pickup truck standing in the northbound turn lane over the median facing southbound. I then saw a white male wearing a blue t-shirt walking to the front of the vehicle before entering through the driver side door. Once inside of the vehicle, the driver proceeded westbound onto NW 11th St. While searching the area, I located a white 2003 GMC Sierra bearing FL Tag 76BZHJ stationary on NW 11th St. I made contact with the driver as he was driving eastbound on NW 11th St and asked him to pullover. I then conducted a traffic stop by initiating my overhead lights and sirens at 216 NW 11th St. I walked up to the driver side window and made contact with the registered owner W/M Harley Reno and immediately noted a strong odor of alcohol protruding from inside of the vehicle. When asked to provide his license, registration, and insurance, Reno provided me his vehicle title and his registration. Reno appeared to be disorientated and confused when I asked for his documentation. Reno kept stating, "I'm Harley Davidson. I'm Harley Davidson.". After several requests, eventually Reno was able to provide his drivers license. I then asked Reno to step out of the vehicle when I noticed that he was unable to maintain his balance and grabbed onto the vehicle for support. Officer Torsiello then arrived on scene. Officer Torsiello arrived at the scene and conducted a traffic crash investigation. Once Torsiello concluded his traffic crash investigation, I explained to Reno that I

was conducting a DUI investigation. Before asking Reno any questions, I read his Constitutional Warnings from a department issued pre-printed card. I asked Reno what road his vehicle was stopped on and he stated that he didn't know. I asked Reno if he knew what road he was driving on prior to the traffic stop and he stated, "Military Trail". I asked Reno what direction he was driving on Military Trail, and he stated, "South". According to Reno, he was driving southbound on Military Trail, and jumped the median to avoid hitting a vehicle. When he jumped the median, Reno stated that he may or may not have hit a traffic sign. Reno said that he had been working a demo job at Walgreens on Spanish River and Federal Hwy. Reno stated that he was working and traveling in Delray prior to the traffic stop. When asked if he had consumed any alcohol, Reno stated that he drank a 16oz green apple Four Loko around 1200 hours. When asked what time it was, Reno stated, "3:48". I explained to Reno that based on his inconsistent and inaccurate statement, the strong odor of alcohol protruding from his person and vehicle, along with his vehicle being observed standing in the northbound turn lane facing southbound, I had reasons to believe that he was driving under the influence. I asked Reno if he would like to conduct a series of tasks to dispel my alarm of him driving under the influence which he consented to. I explained and demonstrated each task to Reno before he performed them. The first task was the Walk and Turn. Reno began the task before I read the instructions and conducted a demonstration. Reno was unable to maintain his balance in the starting position once placed in it and once he conducted the task. Reno had walked off the line multiple times while conducting the task. The second task was the One Leg Stand. Reno was unable to maintain his balance while performing the task. Reno had dropped his left foot multiple times while performing the task. The third task was the Finger to Nose. On the fifth command, "right", Reno had raised his left arm before placing it back down to his side and raising his right index finger and touching the tip of his nose. The fourth task was the Romberg Alphabet. Reno was unable to recite the English Alphabet and could not complete the task. On Thursday July 21st, 2022, at 1345 hours, I placed Harley Davidson Reno under arrest for DUI per 316.193(1a). Reno was transported to the Boca Raton Police Department Booking Facility for processing. While at the BRPD Booking Facility, I asked Reno to provide a breath sample which he refused. I then read Reno his Implied Consent
