On 12/27/2021 at approximately 9:21 PM, I was conducting a traffic crash investigation at the Citgo Gas Station located at 701 E Bearss Ave, Tampa, FL 33613 my attention was drawn to the exit ramp from northbound I-275 (SR-93) to Bearss Ave where several cars were honking at a white pickup truck that was stationary in the outside turn lane. I walked over to the pick-up truck (FL tag# 81AZHZ) which was running but stopped at a traffic light. Sitting inside in the driver seat, I found a white male asleep in the driver seat. I knocked on the window in an attempt to wake him up. He did not wake up immediately, so I tried to open the driver side door and it was locked. I knocked harder on the window and he woke up. I observed him to have watery blood shot eyes. He rolled the window down and I asked him to place the truck in park, turn off the ignition and step out of the vehicle. I escorted him to the sidewalk and asked him if he knew where he was. At first, he answered with the destination he was headed to, then answered that he was on "I-4". As he spoke, I smelled the odor commonly associated with alcoholic beverages emanating from his breath. After obtaining the driver's permission, I moved the pick-up truck out of the roadway into the Citgo parking lot. At that point I asked the driver if he would be willing to perform Standard Field Sobriety Exercises (SFSE) and he initially agreed. I ask him to stand behind the truck while I moved my car over to the side of the parking lot. As I went to move my car, the driver walked toward the driver side of the truck and I instructed him to move back to the rear of the vehicle. He asked to get his phone out of the truck. I retrieved the phone for him and instructed him to wait at the rear of the truck. As I walked back to my car once more, the driver then started to jog toward the front door of the store. I ran after him and grabbed him by the arm to prevent him from going into the store. At that time, I detained the driver and placed him in handcuffs. While a deputy stayed with the driver, I moved my car over to the side parking lot in order to record SFSEs. I moved the driver over to the front of my car and informed him that I would be removing the handcuffs in order to administer SFSEs. After he argued with me, I did give him the opportunity to perform them. While trying to administer the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus Exercise, I began reading the driver instructions straight from the standard issued card and asked him to put his feet together with the heels and toes together. He placed his feet together with the heels touching however would not close the gap near his toes. After asking several times to place his feet together properly, the driver still refused. At approximately 9:36 PM, I placed the driver under arrest for driving under the influence. I then searched him and placed him in the back seat of my patrol car. During the search I found his FL Driver License (S426-334-73-259-0) where I identified him by the photo as Howard Salickram. I ran his information through DAVID and it was revealed that Mr. Salickram had a prior suspension on 8/30/2014 for refusal to provide a breath sample during a DUI arrest. At approximately 10:13 PM,

Mr. Salickram was transported to the Hillsborough County Jail on Orient Road. I brought Mr. Salickram into Central Breath Testing and requested a breath sample at 10:41 PM and he agreed. After an observation period of at least 20 minutes, the BTO attempted to collect a breath sample however Mr. Salickram failed to follow instructions and was unable to provide a sample. Mr. Salickram was reminded several times of the consequence of failing to provide a breath sample however he still failed to do so. Mr. Salickram was then brought over to central booking and turned over to the staff at the Hillsborough County Jail.

All events occurred in Hillsborough County. Attempted SFSEs, arrest, search and transport were all recorded on board the mobile video recorder on board FHP2412.
