

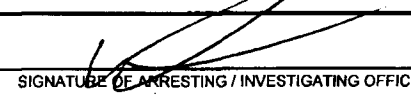
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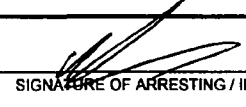

On Saturday, June 18, 2022, at approximately 4:19p.m. I responded to 6010 Northlake Boulevard, Palm Beach Gardens, Florida, in reference to a vehicle accident. My department issued body-worn camera was used for the entire investigation. Upon arrival I made contact with Officer Bradley who advised the following; he responded to the area in reference to a vehicle crash. Upon his arrival, he made contact with a white Lincoln (bearing FL tag 97CBER). He made contact with the sole occupant who was a white male. Officer Bradley asked for his license, registration, and insurance. The male gave Officer Bradley a credit card, and then gave him a NYPD card and a passport card. Officer Bradley again asked for his license, registration, and insurance. He got the documents and was identified as Joseph Jeffery (defendant) went back to talk to the other party involved in the crash. The defendant then backed his car up and attempted to leave. Officer Bradley yelled "STOP, DO NOT LEAVE." The defendant told Officer Bradley to just take his car he is fine. Officer Bradley told him to sit still, don't leave. The defendant then drove away. Officer Bradley got into his car and chased after the defendant where he pulled over on Hiatt Drive and Officer Bradley had him get out of the car. While talking to the defendant, Officer Bradley noticed his eyes were red and watery, there was the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating off his breath, he was slurring his words, and he was very irate. Officer Bradley informed me the other party involved in the crash watched him throw a glass cup out the window prior to our arrival. Sergeant Glass retrieved the cup, from the roadway and observed the drink all over the roadway. Officer Bradley informed me he was done with his crash investigation and the stop was turned over to me to conduct a DUI investigation. I informed the defendant I was conducting a changing of the hats and we were transitioning from the crash investigation to a DUI investigation. He became very irate. I read the defendant his Miranda Rights from a department issued Miranda Card, he advised he understood. I asked the defendant

If he would perform several Standardized Field Sobriety Task (SFST) to make sure he was able to drive, he said no. I read the defendant his Taylor warnings, he again refused. While talking to the defendant, his eyes were red and watery, he had a hard time maintain his balance, he was having mood swings, he was slurring his speech, and there was a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating off his person. The defendant was transported to JFK Midtown Hospital to obtain medical clearance from a doctor for the Palm Beach County Jail. While at the hospital, I requested the defendant provide a sample of his Blood for the purpose of determining his alcohol and or chemical content. He did not want to at first, I read implied consent and he advised he would provide a sample. At 5:56p.m. both samples of blood were taken by Nurse Mollie. The blood samples were packaged properly and turned into evidence for testing. Based on the totality of the circumstances and Officers investigations, probable cause exists to arrest Joseph Jeffery for violation of F.S.S. 316.193(1) (A) - DUI driving under the influence (pending blood draw results). The defendant was turned over to the Palm Beach County Jail. The defendant was very irate and uncooperative throughout the entire incident. This case will be supplemented when the results of the blood are received.
