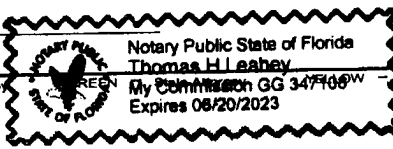

On 05/13/2022 I responded to S. Jog Rd just north of Lake Worth Rd, Greenacres, Palm Beach County, Florida. I was assigned a crash with unknown injuries, reference PBSO case#22067105. Upon arrival I observed that I had a split scene. One vehicle was laying across the right lane and the other was over 300 feet away, north of the first vehicle. I assessed the wellbeing of the nearest vehicle a white Toyota. The driver said she was the single occupant and was not injured. As I started walking towards the blue Camaro bearing FL tag# QIXM27, PBSO supervisor Fisher advised me that the driver had claimed no injuries and was the single occupant. I continued to the car and met with W/M Jorge Tarafa who provided me his identification as proof of identity. I saw him next to his vehicle along with one Greenacres Fire department employee. I saw that he continued to enter and exit the driver's seat of his vehicle. I asked him if he was driving and he answered in the affirmative. I then asked him to provide his license, insurance, and registration. He fumbled for the documents I had to point out the registration that was sitting just on top of all the others in plain view. Upon review of the registration he was the named registered owner of the Camaro. I then asked him where he was coming from and the more I spoke to him the more I smelled the odor of an alcoholic substance. He stated that he was coming from the golf course. I explained the smell of alcohol that was emanating from his breath and he stated that he had several drinks during the course of playing golf. When asked who long ago, he stated that it was about three hours prior. I then asked him to explain the crash and he stated he was NB on S. Jog Rd and he said that the white Toyota hit him while he was in his lane. When asked how fast he was traveling he stated 45mph. I challenged him on this fact stating that the extensive amount of damage could not be caused by a vehicle traveling at that low rate of speed along with the fact that his vehicle traveled over 300 feet after the wheels were damaged. While on scene DUI Investigator Pointu #16032 arrived and completed an evaluation.

PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: Actual physical control (physical evidence or statements putting def. behind wheel of vehicle)

D/S Torres (#24971) was dispatched to a crash that just occurred on the northbound lanes of South Jog road, just north of Lake Worth Road. A white Toyota Camry bearing Florida tag PDEP11 and driven by Noemis Espino hit a blue Chevrolet Camaro bearing Florida tag QIXM27 driven by Jorge Tarafa. Upon his arrival D/S Torres observed Tarafa going in and out of his car. He was the only person within a 300 feet radius, with the exception of Palm Beach County Fire Rescue who was assessing him for possible injuries. Tarafa was identified by his Florida driver license and was also the registered owner of the car. The crash investigation concluded that Espino made an improper lane change and failed to yield to Tarafa, but also that Tarafa was driving above the speed limit.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

Tarafa was unsteady on his feet. His eyes were bloodshot and glassy.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

Post Miranda, Tarafa admitted being the driver and sole occupant of the car at the time of the crash. He admitted drinking two double vodka soda, the first one around noon, the second one around 6 pm.

ODORS:

Obvious odor of unknown alcoholic beverage that became stronger when he talked.

GENERAL OBSERVATIONS

SPEECH: slurred

ATTITUDE: very cooperative, polite

CLOTHING: white shirt with green stripes, gray short, black sneakers.

MEDICAL/OTHER: High blood pressure: propranolol, lisinopril, pravastatin, carvedilol, nexium

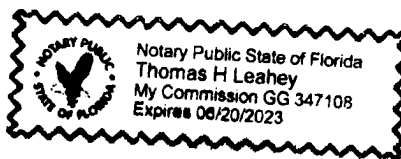

Tarafa started before being told and stopped the task to ask for instruction.

Tarafa swayed and used his arms to balance. He did not look at his foot and did not count as instructed. He lowered his foot to the ground at his count of 15 before being told.

FINGER TO NOSE:

Tarafa used the pad of his finger instead of the tip on tasks 1, 2, 3 and 6. He did not lower his hand immediately after touching his nose on tasks 1, 2 and 6. He touched his left cheek on task 1 and searched for his nose. He touched the left side of his nostril on task 2 and 3 and searched for his nose. He also searched for his nose on task 6.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

Tarafa skipped a letter and repeated back. He swayed during the task.

For the Romberg balance, he swayed in all direction and stopped the 30s task at approximately 20 seconds.

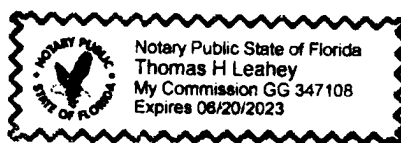
