The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did
 On 01/30/2022, at approximately 0114 hours, off duty Manatee County Sheriff's Office Deputy P. Fellows (ID #11005206) was traveling northbound on I-75 in his marked patrol vehicle. Deputy Fellows observed a white Subaru Crosstrek (FL tag: 39AWUG) to be traveling in front of his patrol vehicle in the left lane. Deputy Fellows observed the driver of the Subaru to be having a hard time maintaining it's travel lane, affecting the other traffic on the roadway. The driver of the Subaru changed lanes and almost rear ended a semi-truck. Deputy Fellows conducted a traffic stop on the Subaru to check on the driver to see whether they were ill, tired or impaired. Upon contact with the defendant, she had glassy eyes and the distinct odor of an alcoholic beverage emitted from her breath as she spoke. The defendant was asked to participate in the Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises (SFSE's), which she agreed. During the SFSE's, the defendant showed signs of impairment and was placed under arrest for DUI. Implied consent was read and the defendant refused to provide a lawful sample of her breath. The defendant was positively identified via her Florida driver license.
