Upon arrival, I observed a white female, in the drivers seat of a white vehicle FL Tag of 58ADPQ siting in the middle lane, not moving, while the light was green. While walking up to the vehicle I observed the womans head to be back on the head rest, no hands on the steering wheel, and eyes closed. When approaching the drivers window, the white female later identified as Krisztina Augusztin, moved her head forward, opened her eyes and began to move around, not noticing me at her window. I yelled out to Augusztin to "Put the car in park" which she began to look around the car in confusion. Augusztin then looked down at the shifter, pointed at it, and used her hand to push, but was unable to until she pressed the button to do so. Augusztin then opened the window, and I observed glossy eyes, smell of alcohol coming from her face and mouth. Augusztin was asked if she was okay, which she then smiled, looked at me, the began looking forward and grabbed the steering wheel. Augusztin was asked again if she was okay, but began to mumble, smiled and nodded up and down. Augusztin stated she was going to "Boca" but was driving South on SW 18th and Powerline which lead to Broward. Investigator Pointu #16032 was called to the scene to take over the investigation.

DRIVING PATTERN: Actual physical control (physical evidence or statements putting def. behind wheel of vehicle)

D/S Giglio (#35623) observed a BMW bearing Florida tag 58ADPQ standing through multiple light cycles in the middle lane of southbound Powerline Road, at the intersection of SW 18th Street, in unincorporated Boca Raton, Palm Beach County, Florida. The driver and only occupant of the vehicle, was a white blonde female with her head back on the head rest, no hand on the steering wheel and her eyes closed. The car was in drive with the engine running. She was identified by her Florida driver license as Krisztina Augusztin. The BMW was registered to Matthew Dembin.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

Augusztin had glassy and bloodshot eyes. Her speech was slurred, low and slow, at time mumbled. She was very unsteady on her feet. An obvious odor of unknown alcoholic beverage was coming from her breath. She appeared confused and had difficulties putting her car in park.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

Augusztin said she had two mixed drinks at a Japanese restaurant two hours earlier. Post Miranda she said he had a glass of wine then two Lytchee Martini. She admitted she was not in condition to drive her vehicle and should have sought alternate transport instead.

ODORS:

Obvious odor of unknown alcoholic beverage that become stronger when she talked.

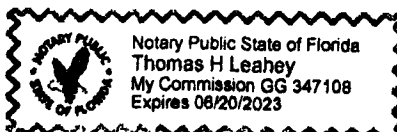

Other Observations:

Pupils round and equal. No resting nystagmus. Equal tracking. Onset of HGN at approximately 35 degrees. VGN present. Swayed during the task. Had to be reminded not to move her head as she either tilted it, nodded or turned it. She also stopped following the stimulus and looked at me instead multiple times.

WALK & TURN:

Augusztin was unable to maintain the instructional stance. When asked to start, she did not walk heel to toe. She counted improperly, repeating some number. She then stopped while walking after an improper number of steps. She made an improper turn and did not walk back.

ONE LEG STAND:

Augusztin swayed, hopped and put her foot down. She did not extend her leg fully.

FINGER TO NOSE:

Augusztin after confirming she understood the instruction tilted her head forward, opened her eyes multiple times. She used the pad of her finger on task 1 and did not raised her hand for the next tasks. She widened her stance during the task.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

Augusztin recited the alphabet very fast and muted. I asked her to restart slowly and she recited it again fast repeating some letters and muting herself again towards the end. On the last attempt, she recited it correctly but too fast. She swayed during the task and did not keep her feet together.

For the modified Romberg balance, she stopped the 30 seconds task at approximately 14 seconds.

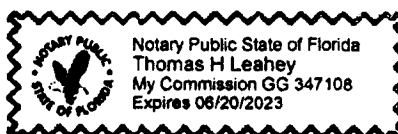
