The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did On the above listed date and time, I Trooper C. Winter (4596) with the Florida Highway Patrol was on routine patrol traveling east on State Road 618 (Selmon Expressway) at mile marker 3. I noticed a white 2005 Toyota Corolla Florida License Plate# JDRP93 traveling in the outside lane. The driver (who was later identified by his Florida Drivers License as, Lance Digangi FL DL#D252520623240) was unable to maintain his lane and was traveling from the outside lane to the shoulder and would straddle the lane line. I activated my lights and Mr. Digangi pulled over to the center median on State Road 618 (Selmon Expressway) at mile marker 5. I approached the driver side of Mr. Digangi vehicle. I immediately noticed Mr. Digangi had blood-shot watery eyes. I asked Mr. Digangi where he was coming from and he stated that he was going to the casino from home. I asked Mr. Digangi if he had consumed alcohol and he denied. I asked Mr. Digangi to step out of the vehicle and approach the front of my patrol vehicle FHP1573. I noticed Mr. Digangi was unsteady on his feet and would lose balance as he walked. Mr. Digangi explained to me that he was taking medication for Parkinson's disease (Levodopa Carbidopa) and that he consumed his pill (which was later found inside an unmarked container in his pocket) an hour before he drove. The many pills within that container were yellow, oval and inscribed with "518". I used a pill identifier to determine that the pills were Levodopa Carbidopa. This was consistent with the name Mr. Digangi provided. At approximately 2142pm I asked Mr. Digangi if he would be willing to perform Field Sobriety Exercises, he stated he would. -Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN) was explained and demonstrated using standardized instructions. Mr. Digangi did not lack smooth pursuit in both eyes, did not have distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes, and did not have nystagmus prior to 45 degrees. Mr. Digangi did not have vertical nystagmus. Mr. Martinez Garcia was also swaying side to side. -The beginning of the walk and turn evaluation was explained and demonstrated using standardized instructions. Mr. Digangi was asked to use an imaginary line to walk across while doing the exercise. Mr. Digangi raised his arms up at his sides and did not properly walk the nine heel to toe steps as instructed. Mr. Digangi did not count out loud and did not properly take a series of small steps to turn around. -The beginning of the One Leg Stand evaluation was explained and demonstrated using standardized instructions. Mr. Digangi stated that he was unable to perform this exercise but tried to make an attempt to do so. Mr. Digangi ended up not being able to perform this exercise. At approximately 2150 pm I placed Mr. Digangi under arrest for DUI. Mr. Digangi was

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properly handcuffed, double locked and placed in the back seat of my patrol vehicle. At approximately 2208 pm, implied consent for breath was read and Mr. Digangi agreed to provide a sample. I arrived at Orient Jail at approximately 2257pm, Mr. Digangi provided two breath samples. The breath alcohol content of sample one was 0.00 g/210L, the breath alcohol content of sample two was 0.00 g/210L. At approximately 2330 pm I read Mr. Digangi implied consent for urine. Mr. Digangi agreed and a urine sample was obtained and properly secured in a urine kit. Mr. Digangi was then turned over to the Hillsborough County Jail for further booking procedures.
