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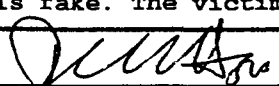

When _____ asked the victim about these bruises on her legs, she told him that they were from _____ hitting her. _____ then called BRPD, concerned that the victim was being physically abusive. The victim was at _____ where _____ and _____ currently reside. Upon seeing the victim, I noticed multiple obvious bruises to both of her legs. I then asked _____ if I could speak with the victim privately, to which he agreed. I then spoke with the victim inside, away from _____. I first let the victim know that I was there because _____ was concerned about some marks that she had. I asked her if she could show me her marks, and the victim then showed me both her legs with the bruises on them. I then asked her how she got those marks. The victim answered saying _____ hits her when he gets mad at her. I then asked her how he hits her? The victim replied, _____ hits her with the base of his hand and sometimes the outside of his hand, while demonstrating with her hand. I then asked the victim if she remembered how she got the mark that is on her leg now. The victim replied, it was from about two weeks ago when she was using his phone and got it wet by accident. I then asked the victim if she had any other marks on her body from him hitting her. The victim replied that he mostly just hits her legs. I then asked the victim what her relationship with _____ is like. The victim replied that he is sometimes nice to her but she believes it is fake. The victim also stated _____

that [REDACTED] has pulled her hair and has hit her back before. I then checked her back and scalp for any injuries but did not see any apparent marks. I documented the bruises on the victim's legs on my MVR body camera. The bruises I observed on the victim's legs were consistent with her statement. One of the bruises on the victim's upper left leg appeared to be from a fingerprint, such as from a hand grabbing the leg. After speaking with the victim, [REDACTED] informed me that the victim told him that she was afraid of me going to talk to [REDACTED] because it will make things worse. The victim also told [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] has made her smell his marijuana multiple times.

I then responded to 45 S Federal Hwy (Flannigans) to speak with [REDACTED]. Upon speaking with [REDACTED] she advised the following: While she and Martin [REDACTED] Martin was physically abusive towards her, hitting her and causing bruises to her face to the point where she had to wear makeup to come into work. She advised that Martin gets aggressive when he drinks but is calm when he does not drink or when he smokes pot. She advised that Martin threatens to kill her via text and call and has charged at her with knives. She advised she has not called the police on Martin for these incidents because she wanted to protect him, so [REDACTED] have [REDACTED] in their lives. Upon asking [REDACTED] if she has seen Martin physically hit [REDACTED] she replied that she has seen him grab the victim's hair. I then inquired about Martin ever hitting [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] replied that Martin has hit [REDACTED] so hard that it left an obvious handprint on his buttocks. He, however, had told [REDACTED] that the handprint was from falling from a tree. [REDACTED] then advised that Martin treats the victim differently because the victim and [REDACTED] are more alike. I then asked [REDACTED] if she saw the bruises that were on the victim's legs. [REDACTED] advised that she had picked up the victim from Martin's hotel room today at approximately 1615 hours and did not notice the bruises. [REDACTED] had mentioned the bruises to her after taking the victim to go swimming. [REDACTED] advised that she would not feel comfortable leaving the victim alone with Martin.

I then responded to 2901 N Federal Hwy, Room 422 to speak with Martin. Inside the hotel room was also the [REDACTED]. After asking to speak with Martin, I informed him that I was conducting an investigation and needed to ask him questions. I then read Martin his Florida Constitutional Warnings from a preprinted card issued by BRPD. Martin advised he understood his Constitutional Warnings and agreed to speak with me without an attorney present. Martin denied the allegations of hitting the victim or [REDACTED]. It should be noted that while speaking with Martin, I could smell a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from Martin's breath and person. Martin advised that [REDACTED] picked the victim up today at approximately 1615 hours. I then asked Martin if he knew about the bruises that were on the victim's legs. Martin advised that the victim got those bruises from play fighting with [REDACTED]. According to Martin, the victim and [REDACTED] were play fighting two days ago, resulting in the bruises to the victim's legs. It should be noted that the bruises I observed on the victim's legs were not consistent with play fighting two days

P R O B A B L E	ago. I then asked Martin if I could speak to the 10 year-old privately. Martin agreed and the 10 year-old stepped outside the hotel room to speak with me privately, away from Martin. Once the [REDACTED] stepped outside, I noticed there were also some bruises on his legs. He advised that he does not punch or hit the victim; he would pull her hair a little when he gets mad, but not to hurt her. He advised he does not physically hit or fight the victim, contradicting [REDACTED] statements. I then asked him how [REDACTED] disciplines them when they misbehave. He replied that if they do something really bad, they will get a "butt whooping" by [REDACTED]. He advised that when you get it [the "butt whooping"] one time, you don't want to get it again. I then asked him if [REDACTED] has ever hit them anywhere else beside the buttocks to discipline, such as arms or hair, and he replied, "he's not abusive." He advised that [REDACTED] hates alcohol but drinks it to relax, and he last drank it last week. I asked him if he played any sports, and he replied he plays baseball. I asked him if while playing baseball, does he ever get any marks or bruises from baseball. He replied that he does not. I then asked him how he got the bruises that were on his legs, and he replied he got them from falling from trees. The bruises I observed on his legs were not consistent with falling from any trees.						
	Based on my investigation, I developed probable cause to arrest Martin Janzen for child abuse pursuant to F.S.S. 827.03(2)(c) after he knowingly and willingly used excessive force on the victim, resulting in physical injury without causing great bodily harm. I handcuffed Martin, checked for tightness and proper fit, out of the children's view. Martin Janzen was then transported to Palm Beach County Jail.

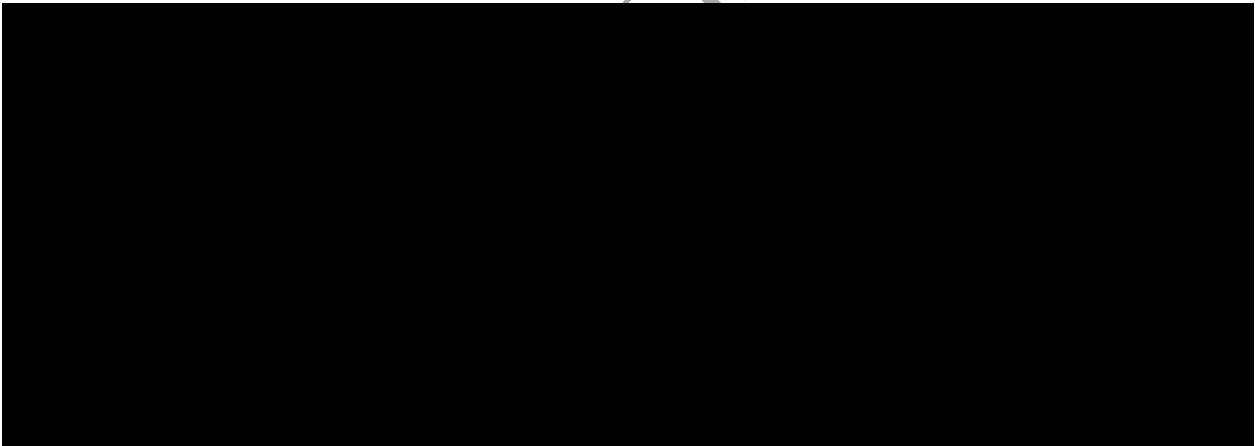

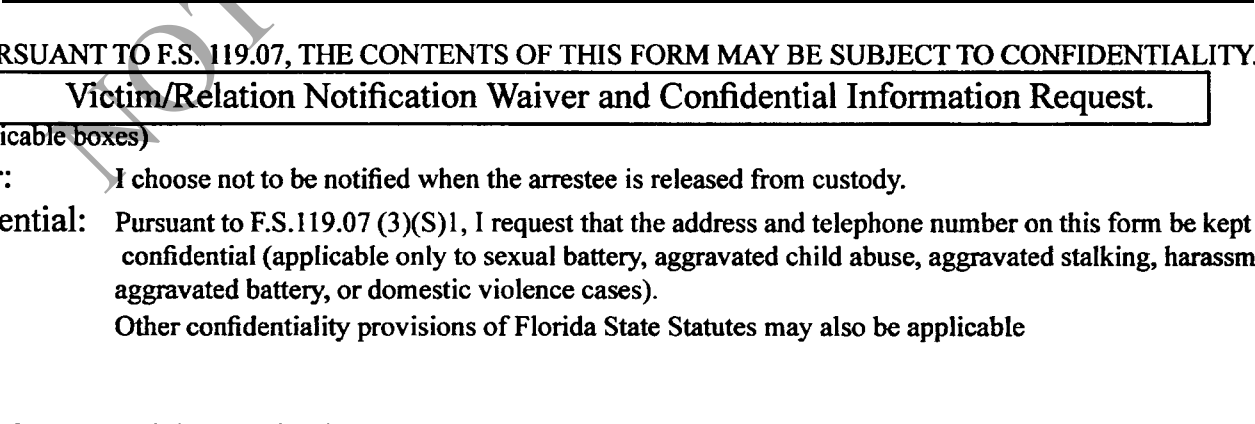
