PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT I could smell a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from the inside of his vehicle. He was wearing a long sleeve pink shirt, black pants and black flip flops. I could see a walking cane in the front passenger seat. I told the driver I had a suspicion that he had been drinking an unspecified amount of alcoholic beverages. He told me he has not been drinking. He explained he was dining at a restaurant in Lake Worth. Prior to having him exit his vehicle I asked if he had any medical issues. He reported he was a trauma patient after being involved in a traffic crash. I was able to see scars to his body that substantiated his story. Based on my suspicion I asked if he would consent to perform Seated Field Sobriety Tasks for the purpose of determining if he was impaired while operating a motor vehicle. He obliged. I asked D/S Smith to face his vehicle toward mine. Afterward I escorted him to the front bumper of D/S Smith's patrol car and had him sit on the front bumper. I asked him to tell me when he reached a satisfying level of comfort. He told me he was comfortable. I could now smell a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath that intensified when he spoke. The following Seated tasks were explained, demonstrated and acknowledged by him prior to his performance: HGN, Finger to Nose, Hand Coordination, Palm Pat and The Romberg Alphabet Recitation. His deficiencies were recorded on another form in this work sheet. At the conclusion of the SFSTs, coupled with the Deputy's observation of the defendant's vehicle in motion and my observation of personal indicators of impairment exhibited by the defendant, probable cause was established for DUI. I told the defendant he was being placed under lawful arrest for DUI. He was searched and handcuffed (double locked and checked for tightness) prior to being seated into the rear of my patrol car. Back up deputies arranged for the defendant's vehicle to be towed by a tow service from PBSO's rotation list. Priority Towing responded to the scene and impounded his vehicle to their lot. The defendant's relative arrived on scene and took custody of his personal effects. Meanwhile I began transport to the main jail breath analysis facility for further processing. Upon our arrival I escorted the defendant into the facility and began a 20 minute observation period. During this time the defendant did not ingest anything into his body orally or otherwise. Neither did he regurgitate. I escorted him into the testing room and asked him to provide breath samples for the purpose of determining his alcohol content. He refused. I read him implied consent in which he acknowledged. I asked if he would reconsider and provide breath samples. He refused a second time. At this time he was deemed a "refusal". I advised him of his Constitutional Rights in which he acknowledged. He refused to give an interview. He was booked into the main jail for DUI.

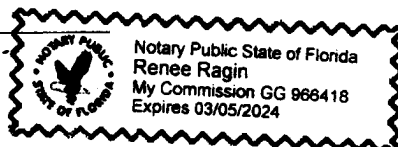

Subject was asked to sit on the bumper and advise when he was comfortable. He was asked to focus on the stimulus and follow it with his eyes. Lastly he was told not to move his head to assist in following the stimulus with their eyes. Subject showed equal pupil size that tracked equally. Both eyes lacked a smooth pursuit. Subject also turned his head to assist in following the light. He failed to follow my instructions and could not complete this task

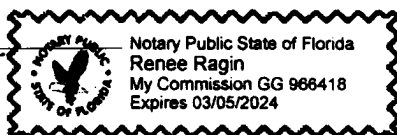

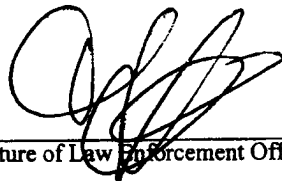
