The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did:

On 03/26/2022, at approximately 2315, the defendant was operating a blue Jeep Wrangler, bearing Indiana tag HN7561, in the parking lot of the above location. While in the parking lot, the vehicle struck a concrete pole. The witness positively identified the defendant as the person who was operating the vehicle at the time of the traffic crash (22-236379 / DHSMV #89431506). Upon contact with the defendant, the affiant detected the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from the defendant's breath, observed his eyes to be red/bloodshot and watery, his speech to be slurred, and him to have unsteady balance. The affiant requested the defendant to perform Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises (SFSEs), which the defendant refused to do. The defendant was then placed under arrest for DUI based on the totality of the circumstances. After a proper 20 minute observation period was conducted, the defendant agreed to provide two lawful samples of his breath. Breath Technician K. Kirkland (ABN:255300) provided the affiant with the results and they are as follows: first BrAC sample .081%, second BrAC .080%. The defendant was positively identified via his Florida driver's license.
