On Friday, May 22, 2022, at approximately 1718 hours, I was assigned to uniformed road patrol at the Florida Atlantic University (FAU) Boca Raton Campus 777 Glades Rd Boca Raton, Florida 33458. I was parked in Lot 3 facing the westbound lane. I visually observed a white Dodge Challenger two-door driving eastbound in the westbound lanes of NW 20th St and East University Drive. I drove east in the eastbound lane with my emergency lights and siren activated. The white Dodge Challenger approached the U-turn lane on NW 20th street (west of East University Drive). The vehicle then drove west in the eastbound lanes towards the front of my marked patrol vehicle. I turned my marked patrol vehicle around, and the white Dodge Challenger turned left, driving south onto St. Lucie Ave S. I turned left onto St. Lucie Ave and placed my marked patrol vehicle behind the white Dodge Challenger. The White Dodge Challenger stopped in the southbound lane of St. Lucie Ave adjacent to Parking Lot 1.

I approached the passenger side of the vehicle and made contact with the driver, who was identified through his Florida driver's license as Robert Greg Boone (FL DL B500767742670). I noticed that Boone had glassy eyes, and when asked for his driver's license, he started to fumble through his wallet. Once he gave me his driver's license, I asked Boone for his registration and proof of insurance. Boone then opened his glove box. I asked Boone where he was coming from, and he stated that he was coming from a work event and got lost. Boone seemed to have forgotten that I asked him for his registration. Boone then fumbled through his wallet and advised if I could expedite the traffic stop if Boone would give me his license. At this time, Boone had already given me his driver's license.

I asked Boone to step out of the vehicle. Boone complied. While Boone was exiting out of the driver's door, he stumbled and appeared to have lost his balance. I then asked Boone to step to the rear of the white Dodge Challenger. Due to my observations, I informed Boone that I would need him to perform some field sobriety tasks. I asked Boone if he had physical disabilities. Boone replied no. I asked Boone if he had any eye problems. Boone replied no. I asked Boone if he was sick or injured. Boone replied no. I asked Boone if he had taken any drugs or medication. Boone replied no. I then proceeded to the SFST (Standardized Field Sobriety Tasks).

I first checked for Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus. I asked Boone if he was wearing contacts. Boone replied no. I informed Boone that I was going to check his eyes. I instructed Boone to keep his feet together by having his heels and toes touching while having his arms to his side. I asked Boone if he understood. Boone said yes. I told Boone to keep his head still and follow my stimulus with his eyes only, and I asked if he understood. Boone said yes. I proceeded to check his eyes. His pupils were equal in size, and I did not notice resting nystagmus.

The results of the task displayed four out of the six possible clues.

- A lack of smooth pursuit in the right and left eye
- Distinct and sustained nystagmus in the left eye at maximum deviation.
- Distinct and sustained nystagmus in the right eye at maximum deviation.
- Onset of nystagmus in the right eye and left eye prior to 45 degrees

Walk and Turn Task

I instructed Boone to put his left on the line and his right in front of his left foot so that the heel of his right foot would touch his left foot toes and to have his arms to his side and not move until I told him to begin. I asked Boone if he understood. Boone replied yes.

I provide Boone with the following instructions:

-Take nine steps heel to toe steps while looking down at his feet and counting each number out loud.

On the 9th step, to leave, you lead foot on the line and take a series of small steps with his other foot.

Return down the line by taking nine heel-to-toe steps looking down at his feet, and counting each number out loud.

While walking to keep his arms down to his side while he walked.

During this time, Boone would move and step of the line and had to be instructed to return to the correct position. I asked Boone if he understood. Boone replied yes. Boone was in the correct starting position, and I told him to begin. Boone did not heel to toe step on step 6,7,8 and stopped at 8. Boone then stopped, kept his right foot planted, and proceeded to turn with his left foot and stepped off the line. Boone then started the return walk of the task. Boone took ten steps and did not walk heel to toe, and did not count out loud.

I then asked Boone to perform the One Leg Stand. I explained and demonstrated to Boone how to perform the task. I then asked Boone if he understood the instruction that I gave him. Boone said yes. During the One Leg Stand, Boone did not look down at his raised right foot. Boone then counted to 8 and put his foot down. Boone also was swaying and used his arms for balance.

I then asked Boone to perform the Finger to Nose task. I explained and demonstrated to Boone how to perform the task. I asked Boone if he understood the instructions that I gave him. Boone said yes. During the finger-to-nose task, Boone did not properly touch the tip of his nose with the tip of his finger on 3, 4, 5, and 6. On number 5, Boone started with his left finger and then corrected himself by using his right finger. Boone had his eyes open and did not tilt his head during the
