

#### Probable Cause

On August 9, 2022, at approximately 4:18 PM, Recruit Trooper Jeanbaptiste #5011 and I, were dispatched to a "reckless driver" that had exited on Lantana Rd and was heading eastbound, passing the FHP Lantana sub-station. Per the Lake Worth Regional Communications Center (LWRCC), the reckless vehicle was a silver Chevy Silverado with Georgia tag TDE9842 and was being followed by a witness.

Per LWRCC, the witnessed had been following the Silverado from Broward county and was now northbound on Interstate 95 (State Road 9) in Palm Beach County. The witness advised the Silverado was unable to maintain in its lane and was driving onto the inside shoulder and running over the express lane dividers. Per the witness, on one occasion the Silverado traveled onto the inside shoulder and the left side sideswiped the concrete barrier wall near Congress Ave. The witness continued to follow the Silverado while updating the LWRCC of the location.

As the Silverado was passing the FHP Lantana sub-station, Corporal Michael Deleeuw # 3332 was able to locate the vehicle by confirming the tag number provided. He then began to observe a driving pattern. At this time Recruit Jeanbaptiste and I, began to follow Corporal Deleeuw and the Silverado. Corporal Deleeuw observed the Silverado failed to maintain its lane and conducted a traffic stop on N Federal Hwy and Lantana road. The Silverado pulled into the Rocket Fuel gas station.

As Corporal Deleeuw was making a driver side approach, the driver of the vehicle stumbled out and dropped his cell phone on the ground. Corporal Deleeuw then asked the driver for his driver's license and explained the reason for the traffic stop and asked if there were any weapons in the vehicle. The Driver advise he had "Two" weapons and that his wallet was somewhere inside the vehicle. During this time, I observed an unknown odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from inside the vehicle and the driver to be unsteady on his feet. I also observed his pupils to be extremely constricted and his demeaner to be lethargic or slow. I also observed damage to the left side of the vehicle.

Corporal Deleeuw then asked the Driver if he consented to us look inside his car for his wallet and he stated "yes". During the search for his wallet, Criminal Interdiction Unit (CIU) Sgt. Kingery and I observed a prescription bottle in the center console that appeared to have different pills inside. The

prescription bottle read "Dextroamp-Amphetamin" and stated it was "a round shaped tablet". The pills inside appeared to be elongated or long tablets.

Due to the prescription bottle being suspicious, Sgt. Kingery opened the prescription bottle to confirm the pills were round shape and instead found white elongated pills. Based on Sgt. Kingery training and experience, he advised the white elongated pills were "Xanax bars". They were mixed with a white round pill which was consistent with the description on the prescription bottle. The wallet was finally located and the Driver was identified as, Robert Nelson Dunagan Jr DOB 2/25/73, via his Florida driver's license.

I then spoke with the witness, Norman Dylann Munnilal, who also stopped at the gas station. Mr. Munnilal again confirmed he had been following Mr. Dunagan from Broward and witnessed the "reckless" driving of Mr. Dunagan and when he ran over the express lane dividers and when he sideswiped the concrete barrier wall. Mr. Munnilal stated all this occurred northbound Interstate 95 from Hillsboro and Congress Ave in Palm Beach County.

Based on my training and experience, the statements from Mr. Munnilal, Mr. Dunagan demeanor and the "Xanax bars" located in plain view, I believed Mr. Dunagan to be driving under the influence of alcohol and/or controlled substances.

Recruit Trooper Jeanbaptiste and I then asked Mr. Dunagan to walk to the front of our marked patrol vehicle. Mr. Dunagan was then advised that we were now conducting a DUI investigation and read his Miranda rights at 4: 48 PM.

Mr. Dunagan advised he understood his rights. I then explained the reasons above of why were conducting a DUI investigation and asked if takes "Xanax". Mr. Dunagan stated "yes". I then asked him if they were legally prescribed and he stated "yes". I then asked him why they were mixed in with another prescription bottle and he advised for convenience. I then asked Mr. Dunagan if he was willing to perform field sobriety exercises and he stated yes.

The exercises were performed on-scene at the Rocket Fuel parking lot. For training purposes, Recruit Trooper Jeanbaptiste conducted the exercises with my assistance. Mr. Dunagan performed poorly on the following:

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus: We explained the instructions and Mr. Dunagan advised he understood. We asked if he uses or has eye contacts or eye glasses and he stated "Yes" but did not have any right now. During the exercise, Mr. Donagan failed to follow with his eyes only. Mr. Donagan had equal pupil size in his eyes but were extremely constricted. Mr. Donagan also failed to keep his arms by side and had his thumb in his pocket. He also had a slight sway.

Walk and Turn: For this exercise, we used a yellow line that was clearly painted on the parking lot. We asked Mr. Donagan if he could see the line and if it was clear of debris. He stated "yes". While

explaining the instructions, Mr. Donagan failed to maintain the starting positions several times. We had to advise him numerous times to keep the starting position. We also explained and demonstrated the exercise twice.

When told to begin, he stepped of the line on step "two" and missed all heel to toe steps. He also stopped to gain balance. He made an improper turn and missed all heel to toe steps walking back. Mr. Dungan also kept his thumbs inside his pockets while walking.

One leg stand: While explaining and demonstrating the instructions, Mr. Donagan began the exercises before being told to do so. Mr. Donagan chose to raise his right leg. He failed to keep it approximately 6 inches off the ground and stopped prior to the allotted time or when told to stop.

Based on the totality of the circumstances, Mr. Donagan was placed under arrest for DUI at 5:01 PM. At approximately 5:21 PM we took possession of the "Xanax bars" and counted a total of 72 pills. The two weapons Mr. Donagan had were also taken for safekeeping until he is released. Mr. Donagan was then transported to the Palm Beach County Jail Breath Test Facility. Once at the jail, were started a 20-minute observation at 5:55 PM

During this time, he did not eat or regurgitate anything. After the 20 minutes, Mr. Donagan was asked if he was willing to provide breath samples to determine his alcohol content and he consented. The first sample was of .009 and the second of .009. Based on the results, I then asked if he was willing to provide a urine sample. At this time, Mr. Donagan advised he would like to speak with his lawyer for advice on the urine sample. I then read him Florida Implied Consent and he stated he understood. Mr. Donagan the agreed to provide a urine sample. Mr. Donagan's urine sample was then obtained at 6:44 PM.

Post Miranda, Mr. Donagan stated he had "one Mikes Hard Lemonade" while on the boat earlier today. He also stated he takes "Xanax" for anxiety.

Mr. Donagan was then released to the county jail for further booking.

We then transported the "Xanax bars" and two weapons to the FHP Lantana sub-station for evidence and safekeeping.

\*Sgt James Kudla #2678 also arrived on-scene and assisted in obtaining a sworn recorded witness statement from Mr. Munnilal.

All events occurred in Palm Beach County.
