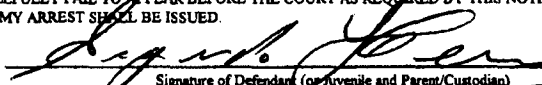
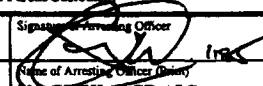

On the 8 day of August, 2022 at 22:23 (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.) On 08/08/2022 at approximately 2152 hours, I responded to 6760 W Indiantown Rd. (McDonald's) in the Town of Jupiter, Palm Beach County, Florida in reference to a careless driver. At the time, I was driving an unmarked Jupiter Police Department patrol vehicle (vehicle 2109), I was wearing a JPD uniform clearly identifying myself as a Jupiter Police Officer, and I was wearing my department-issued Axon body camera. Dispatch advised several callers had reported a white pickup was traveling southbound on Interstate 95 weaving all over the highway. The truck purportedly had an advertisement on the tailgate for "jamproinc.com" and had exited onto eastbound S.R. 706 (W Indiantown Rd.). The callers advised the truck entered the parking lot of 6760 W Indiantown Rd. and parked. One of the callers did not wish to remain on scene however, another of the callers remained to provide a statement. Upon arrival, I made contact with the aforementioned citizen informants. I identified them to be Tera S. Toft (w/f; 12/25/1975) and Kevin R. Vahle (w/m; 03/17/1975). Both citizen informants advised they were following the aforementioned pickup southbound on Interstate 95. Vahle advised the pickup drifted out of the outside southbound lane of travel, in Martin County, and almost struck his vehicle. Vahle further advised the pickup was weaving "from guardrail to guardrail". Toft advised me she took a video of the pickup as it was traveling in front of them. Vahle showed me the video on her phone and I observed a white pickup traveling on a three-laned roadway which appeared to be consistent with the lanes of Interstate 95. In the video, the pickup was traveling in the outside lane, drifted out of the lane (onto the shoulder), and drove straddling the solid white fog line, on the rumble strips of the highway for some distance. I ultimately provided Toft with a link to upload the video to evidence.com. I then drove to the parking lot of McDonald's and observed a white Toyota Tacoma bearing FL tag # HNDB24 parked on the north side of the parking lot. On the rear tailgate, I

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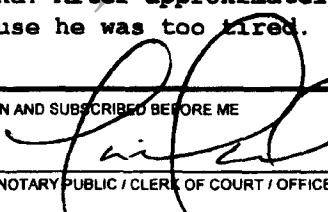

observed an advertisement for "jamproinc.com" matching the description provided by the callers. When I approached, the vehicle was running and Officer Fandrey had already made contact with the driver. I approached the driver side window and made contact with the driver and sole-occupant of the vehicle. I identified the driver to be Segundo Herrera (w/m; 08/05/1961) by his valid Class E Florida driver license. Herrera had bloodshot eyes and I could smell the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage on his breath which intensified as he spoke. Herrera advised he was on his way to a job site in Miami and had pulled over to rest. Herrera stated he was coming from his home in Port St. Lucie, FL. He also stated he had drank two beverages with his son before driving. Herrera estimated his level of impairment on a scale of 1 (being sober) to 10 (being sick) at a 3. Based upon my observations and the statement of the citizen informants, I requested Herrera exit the vehicle. He complied. I then requested Herrera perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tasks (SFSTs) and he agreed. I first conducted the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus task. I am a certified Drug Recognition Expert (IACP # 32395) and I conducted this task in accordance with my training. Herrera had pupils of equal approximate size, he did not have resting nystagmus and was able to track a horizontally-moving stimulus equally. I observed Lack of Smooth Pursuit and Distinct and Sustained Nystagmus at Maximum Deviation in both Herrera's eyes. I had to remind Herrera multiple times to keep his eyes focused on the stimulus and to keep his head still. Herrera swayed from front to back throughout the duration of the task. I did not observe the Onset of Nystagmus prior to 45 Degrees in either eye. Vertical Gaze Nystagmus was not present. I next conducted the Walk and Turn. During the Instructions Stage, Herrera lost his balance and broke his feet from the starting position twice. When told to begin, Herrera missed heel-to-toe on steps 1, 3, 4, 5, and 6. Herrera took 8 steps down the line and stopped. I asked if he remembered what to do and he turned improperly by taking small steps with both his feet. On the return walk, Herrera missed heel-to-toe on step 2 and 4. Additionally, Herrera stepped off the line (to the left) on step 2. Herrera took 9 steps back down the line. I then conducted the One Leg Stand. Herrera advised he understood the instructions and raised his left leg off the ground. Almost immediately, Herrera lost his balance and placed the heel of his left foot on the ground. Herrera continued counting but I had to remind him to keep his eyes on his elevated foot. I also reminded Herrera to keep his foot off the ground, as the majority of the task he had the heel of his foot on the ground. After approximately 25 seconds, Herrera advised he was unable to finish the task because he was too tired.

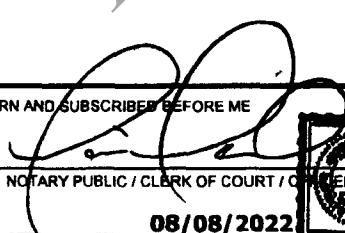
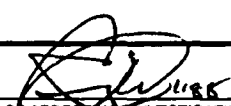

Before completing the Finger to Nose, I confirmed Herrera knew the difference between his left and right. When told to begin, I reminded Herrera to tilt his head back and close his eyes. The cadence for this task was: Left, Right, Left, Right, Right, Left. On the first call of left, Herrera hovered his finger over his nose before touching the pad of his left index finger to the tip of his nose, failing to immediately return his arm to his side. I reminded Herrera to immediately return his arm to his side once, as he confirmed he understood the instructions previously. For the remainder of the task, despite already reminding him to return his hand to his side, Herrera failed to return his arm to his side. On the first call of right, Herrera touched the pad of his right index finger to the bridge of his nose. On the second call of left, Herrera touched the pad of his left index finger slightly above the tip of his nose. On the second call of right, final call of right, and final call of left, Herrera touched the pad of the appropriate index finger to the tip of his nose. Herrera advised his highest level of education was 2 years of college and that he was comfortable with the alphabet from A to Z. Herrera appropriately recited the alphabet when told to begin but opened his eyes after the letter "I". Based on Herrera's performance, I placed him under arrest for DUI. I requested at roadside Herrera provide a lawful sample of his breath for the purposes of determining the alcohol content. Herrera agreed and I transported him to the Palm Beach County Breath Alcohol Testing Facility (BAT). Upon arrival at the BAT, I conducted a 20 minute observation period to ensure Herrera did not ingest or regurgitate anything. When the observation period was over, I again requested Herrera provide a lawful sample of his breath for the purpose of determining the alcohol content. Herrera agreed and provided two adequate breath samples of .110 and .105, both over the legal, per se limit of .08. Based on the aforementioned facts resulting from my investigation, I find Probable Cause exists to charge Segundo Herrera with DUI pursuant to FSS 316.193(1)(b).
