The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did On 03/19/2022, at approximately 0139 hours, the affiant observed a white Lexus SUV, bearing New Jersey tag R47MNJ (VIN:JTJBM7FX7G5137165), traveling northbound on S Us Highway 301 at a high rate of speed. The white Lexus SUV was measured traveling 70 MPH in a posted 50 MPH zone via the front antenna of the affiant's HCSO issued BEE III Radar (SN:BEE932000307). The affiant conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle and made contact with the driver/defendant. The affiant detected the distinct odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from the defendant's breath, observed his eyes to be red/bloodshot and watery, him to fumble for request documents, and his balance to be unsteady. The affiant requested the defendant to perform Standard Field Sobriety Exercises (SFSEs), which the defendant agreed to do. During the SFSEs, the defendant exhibited multiple signs of impairment and was subsequently arrested for DUI. During an inventory search of the defendant's vehicle, the affiant discovered a small clear plastic baggie, containing a white powder substance, between the center console and passenger seat. Utilizing a HCSO issued field reagent test kit, the white powder substance produced a presumptive positive test result for cocaine. After a proper 20 minute observation period was conducted, the defendant agreed to provide two lawful samples of his breath. Breath Technician K. Kirkland (ABN:255300) provided the affiant with the results and they are as follows: first BrAC sample .115%, second BrAC .116%. The defendant was positively identified via his Florida driver's license.
