I told her that she needed to stop drinking due to its effect on her life. Terri got upset and said she did not have a problem. Terri told me she was going to go for a drive. I was scared of what could happen if she drove in her condition and called 911 immediately. As I spoke with Michael, I noticed a Green Lexus Sedan bearing FL tag (CCA31) driving at a high rate of speed on the wrong side of the roadway past the residence going southbound. Michael pointed at the car and said that is my wife. The vehicle continued southbound and failed to stop at a stop sign just south of the residence. I got into my marked PBSO patrol vehicle and initiated a traffic stop by turning my overhead lights on. With my overhead lights and siren on, the vehicle drove out of the neighborhood, made a U-turn, and re-entered. I gave multiple verbal commands over the PA system to stop. During the attempted traffic stop, we drove at slow speeds. After re-entering the neighborhood, the vehicle stopped just west of the entrance. I made contact with the driver, who identified herself to me as Terri Kamen. The smell of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanated from Terri's breath. Terri told me she had left her home because Michael was judging her. Terri advised she was never in fear of Michael doing her harm. Terri stepped out of the vehicle and struggled to maintain balance as she had to use the car and me to keep herself from falling. ☐ Marsy's Law CVI FL Const. Art. 1 § 16(b) I made contact with the driver who was currently sitting on the curb side. She was later identified as Terri A Kamen through the Driver and Vehicle information Database. I noticed her eyes were red, watery and glossy. Her cheeks were flushed, mouth dry and she slurred her speech while speaking. Her movements were slow, calculated and lethargic. I assisted her upright and noticed she labored in maintaining her balance. I escorted her to the front of my patrol car. I could smell a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from her breath that intensified when she spoke. She was wearing loose blue pants, a blue shirt and no shoes. I told her I shared the suspicion of her alcoholic beverage consumption that the stopping deputy apprised me. She expressed how upset she was with her husband and often exclaimed she was going to kill him. Based on my suspicion I asked if she would consent to performing Standardized Field Sobriety Evaluations (SFSTs) for the purpose of determining if she was impaired while operating a motor vehicle. She obliged. Prior to her performance I asked if she had any physical problems with her body that would inhibit her from performing light physical exercises. I also asked if she was taking medication. She reported she neither has anything wrong with her physically, nor is she taking medication. I escorted her to a level surface that was smooth and free from obstructions and debris. I placed a yellow strip of masking tape on the surface that formed a diagonal line. The defendant identified the tape by giving its color and attempting to place her left foot on it when prompt to do so. The following SFSTs were intended to be administered after being explained, demonstrated and acknowledged by her: HGN, The Walk and Turn, The One Leg Stand, The Finger to Nose and The Romberg Alphabet Recitation. She failed to acknowledge the instructions for most of them; however, her deficiencies on the tasks performed were recorded on another form in this work sheet. At the conclusion of the SFSTs, coupled with the deputy's observation of the defendant's vehicle in motion and my observation of personal indicators of impairment exhibited by the defendant, probable cause was established for DUI. I told the defendant she was being placed under lawful arrest for DUI. A female deputy searched her. She was handcuffed (double locked and checked for tightness) prior to being seated into the rear of my patrol car. Her husband arrived on scene and was allowed to take custody of their vehicle.

Neither did she regurgitate. I escorted her into the testing room and asked her to provide breath samples for the purpose of determining her alcohol content. She obliged. The defendant gave two adequate breath samples that rendered results of .166 and .161. I advised her of her Constitutional Rights in which she acknowledged. I asked if she would consent to an interview and she agreed. After the interview she was booked into the main jail for the charge of DUI.

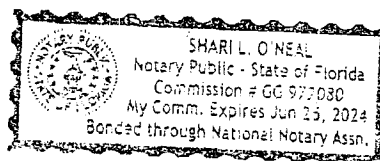
