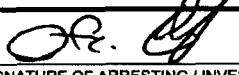


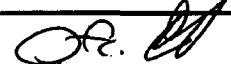

On 07/28/22 at approximately 1735 hours BRPD officers were dispatched to the area of 906 SW 6th St Cir in reference to a suspicious vehicle. According to the caller, there was a black Hyundai with a Maine tag driving around the Boca Terrace Condominium complex on two "popped" tires. Ofc. R. Forbes arrived in the area at approximately 1748 hours. While driving southbound on SW 21st Ave, he observed a black, 4-door Honda bearing Maine tag TNSTIM exiting Boca Terrace Condominiums and driving northbound on SW 21st Ave. While the vehicle was pulling out of the complex, Ofc. Forbes observed that the vehicle had two flat tires on its passenger side. Ofc. Forbes positioned his marked patrol unit behind the Honda, which turned right and drove eastbound on W. Camino Real. Due to the fact that the driver of the Honda was operating a vehicle on two completely flat tires on a public roadway, Ofc. Forbes was concerned that the operator may be sick, injured, or impaired. The registration on the vehicle was also expired, having expired on 06/30/22. Ofc. Forbes effected a traffic stop on the vehicle at the 1900 block of W. Camino Real and made contact with the driver and sole occupant of the vehicle, Timothy Lacombe, who was identified by his Maine Driver's License. I arrived on scene at 1753 hours. Prior to meeting with Lacombe I observed the passenger side of his vehicle. Both tires were completely flat. The front passenger side tire had been driven while flat to such an extent that rubber was dislocating from the tire itself. I then walked to the driver's window and met with Lacombe, who was positioned in the driver's seat of the vehicle. I introduced myself to Lacombe and asked why he was driving on two flat tires. Lacombe said he was over at "Reflections" and hit a "bump." When I asked Lacombe what "Reflections" was, he responded by saying "uh" and then did not respond further. I had to again prompt Lacombe about "Reflections," asking what it was. He then responded by saying "Reflections of Boca," which was down the street. I noticed that Lacombe's speech was slow and slightly

slurred. I asked Lacombe if he had consumed any alcohol beverages today and he responded by indicating that he had consumed two beers earlier in the day. Lacombe indicated that he drank the two beers approximately four hours ago. Based upon the condition of Lacombe's vehicle, his slurred speech, and the fact that he had difficulty engaging in conversation, I asked if he would participate in some voluntary roadside exercises to dispel my alarm that he was impaired. Lacombe agreed to participate in voluntary roadside exercises. The exercises were conducted at the entrance of Boca Sailing and Racquet Club. As Lacombe exited the vehicle, Ofc. Forbes indicated that he observed a bulge in Lacombe's right shorts' pocket. I also observed the bulge. As I got closer to Lacombe to examine the bulge, I could detect the strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from Lacombe's person. The exercises were conducted on a flat, dry surface at the entrance of Boca Sailing and Racquet Club. The first exercise conducted was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus exercise. While conducting this exercise, I observed a lack of smooth pursuit, distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation, and onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees. Several times during the exercise I had to instruct Lacombe to stop moving his head and to follow the stylus with his eyes only. At times Lacombe would also fail to follow the stylus. Lacombe also swayed from side-to-side throughout the exercise. The next exercise conducted was the Walk and Turn exercise. I explained the exercise and demonstrated it for Lacombe. As we did not have an actual line for Lacombe to walk, we used a natural barrier line made by the converging of two different types of bricks in the entranceway. During the exercise Lacombe could not keep balance during instructions, started the exercise too soon, missed heel-to-toe, stepped off the line, took an improper turn, and took an incorrect number of steps. The next exercise conducted was the One Leg Stand Exercise. I explained the exercise and demonstrated it for Lacombe. Lacombe advised that he understood the exercise. Lacombe began the exercise by picking up his right foot, but before he could commence counting he lost his balance and had to place his foot back down on the ground. During the exercise Lacombe swayed while balancing, put his foot down, and used his arms for balance. He also did not count as instructed. The next exercise Lacombe conducted was the Finger to Nose exercise. I explained the exercise and demonstrated it for Lacombe. Lacombe advised that he understood the exercise. The sequence given was as follows: left, right, left, right, right, left. During the exercise, when I called either "right" or "left," Lacombe would move his head to the right or left side of his body by using his neck. Lacombe did not attempt to

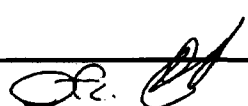

	Based upon the totality of my investigation, Lacombe was arrested at 1825 hours and handcuffed. The handcuffs were double-locked and checked for tightness. Lacombe was transported back to BRPD, where he underwent a 20-minute observation period to ensure that he did not take anything by mouth or regurgitate. Lacombe was asked for a sample of his breath to determine its alcohol content. Lacombe provided two valid samples of his breath, which were .271 at 1918 hours and .278 at 1921 hours. Based upon the above-listed investigation, I find probable cause to believe that Lacombe drove a vehicle while under the influence of alcoholic beverages to the extent that his normal faculties were impaired, and/or that he had a breath-alcohol content in excess of .08 grams of alcohol per 210 liters of breath, contrary to Florida Statute 316.193(1).

(If you do talk to me it has to be because you want to and not because anyone is forcing you to speak.)
- (3) You have a right to the presence and representation of a lawyer of your choice before you make any statement and during any questioning. *Tell me in your own words what you think this means.*
(You can talk to a lawyer before we ask you any questions and you can have him/her with you now, during our questioning.)
- (4) If you cannot afford a lawyer, you are entitled to the presence and representation of a court appointed lawyer before you make any statement and during any questioning. *Tell me in your own words what you think this means*
(If you do not have money for a lawyer and you want one, a lawyer will be given to you for free.)
- (5) If at any time during the interview you do not wish to answer any questions, you are privileged to remain silent. *Tell me in your own words what you think this means.*
(If you decide to talk to me then change your mind, you can stop answering my questions at any time.)
