The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did

The defendant willfully, maliciously, and repeatedly cyberstalked the victim by communicating indirectly, using words and images through the use of electronic communication, pertaining to a specific person, causing substantial emotional distress to that person and served no legitimate purpose, to-wit: On 10/29/2021 the victim contacted the Tampa Police Department and informed the affiant someone had been using Snapchat to perpetuate themselves as her and tarnish her character and caused her significant emotional distress. The victim relayed that a friend, witness P. Gilchrist, was with an out of town guest who was contacted by the fictitious Snapchat account user (defendant). Due to the explicit and sexual nature of the electronic communication, the victim's friend, P. Gilchrist, knew the Snapchat account user was not actually the victim because he knew of her actual normal behavior, which was inconsistent on how she was being portrayed. The affiant contacted witness P. Gilchrist and his guest. The affiant was shown multiple screenshots of a Snapchat account with the name of Rachel Kilman, the victim's name. Additionally, the Snapchat account was used to send actual photographs of the victim, Rachel Kilman, to specifically identify themselves as the victim, Rachel Kilman, refer to the victim's actual employment, refer to the victim's known associates, and other indicators to show the defendant was intentionally portraying himself as the victim. The "Snapchat Score" on the account indicated the account has experienced a high amount of activity and interaction with other Snapchat users.

During the ongoing offense, spanning at least four months, the defendant used the Snapchat account to lure the unsuspecting male witness to engage in a sexual encounter. During multiple conversations with the witness, the defendant sent provocative pictures, indicated the victim would randomly have sex with the witness despite never meeting him in person, inquired about his STD status, asked if he used condoms, and attempted to lure the victim to 5350 Bridge Street, Tampa FL. The address 5350 Bridge Street is visible from the defendant's apartment building at 5001 Bridge Street.

The affiant sent a subpoena to Snapchat that revealed the account was created on July 16, 2018. Several IP addresses were revealed and linked to Charter communications. A subpoena was sent to Charter Communications which revealed a residential internet access account was used to access the fictitious Snapchat account approximately 2,932 times. The residential internet account was held by the defendant, Trevor Van Knotsenburg. The account was linked to the defendant's router inside his residence. The defendant was also shown to utilize his apartment building's clubhouse WiFi to access the Snapchat Account. Additionally, the Snapchat account was accessed numerous times while using an IP address at the defendant's work, the Amalie Arena. The defendant was shown to use the Harbor Center Buffalo Marriott Hotel's internet access while he was traveling there for work, which was verified via his employer. The defendant was shown to access the Snapchat account while using the internet access at the Pegula Sports Arena located at 100 Washington Street, Buffalo, NY. The defendant was verified to be at the Pegula Sports Arena on the day the Snapchat account and internet was accessed.

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The defendant is known to the victim as they are co-workers. In 2016, the victim and the defendant went on 3-4 dates. A short time later, the victim informed the defendant she was not physically attracted to the defendant and did not wish to pursue a relationship. The defendant was upset with the victim's decision. The victim was not aware the defendant created a fictitious Snapchat account and did not have permission to portray himself as her, nor did he have permission to orchestrate a sophisticated ruse in order to make others believe she engaged in nefarious behavior and would be promiscuous with strangers. The victim was embarrassed and scared that someone was using her identity, photos, and identifying her place of work while luring men in with the promise of sexual relations and publicly portraying her as someone who engaged in such behavior.

The defendant was ID'd via FL Driver's License.
