	On the <u>19th</u> day of <u>November</u> 20 <u>21</u> at <u>1901</u> ☐ A.M. ☒ P.M. (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)										
	On 11/12/2021, at approximately 0010 hours, I was conducting surveillance of the Royal Inn which is located at 675 Royal Palm Beach Blvd. The Royal Inn is a known high crime area with a prevalence of narcotics, prostitution, and firearms related offenses. While doing so, I observed a 2018 black Ford Mustang, bearing FL tag HFRR11 pull into the Royal Inn for a few minutes. The vehicle drove to the rear of the motel and then was seen pulling back out and leaving westbound on Southern Blvd.										
	D/S E. Lerner #35617 observed the 2018 Black Ford Mustang, bearing FL tag HFRR11, driving westbound on Southern Blvd in the City of Royal Palm Beach, FL 33411, approaching Forest Hill Blvd, going 56 MPH in a 50 MPH zone (fully calibrated speedometer).										
	D/S E. Lerner initiated a traffic stop in his PBSO issued marked vehicle (Asset #68230) utilizing his red and blue emergency lights. The vehicle in question pulled over in the southbound left turn lane of the intersection at Quercus Ct. and Forest Hill Blvd. in the Village of Wellington 33414. Contact was made with the driver, Victor Findley DOB 11/22/1999, and the passenger, Yventon Nelson DOB 11/04/1999. Both occupants identified themselves with their FL driver's license without incident. After D/S Lerner made his initial contact with Findley and Nelson, he returned to his vehicle to conduct a records check. In the meantime, I made contact with Findley and as I began walking up to the driver's door of a the vehicle, I detected a strong odor of what I believed to be Marijuana emanating from within. It should be noted that both windows of the vehicle were rolled down for a few minutes prior to me making contact with Findley, which would provide the vehicle with an opportunity to air out the smell. The odor was still strong and immediately recognizable when I approached.										
	As I made contact with Findley, I also noticed his eyes were bloodshot red and consistent with someone under the influence of Marijuana, based upon my training and experience. I asked Findley where he was coming from, in which he advised he was coming from his friends house in the City of Lake Worth Beach. I asked Findley if he had a medical Marijuana card, in which he advised he did not. I told Findley that I smelled a strong odor of Marijuana from inside his vehicle and asked him if he had any Marijuana inside. Findley sighed and hesitated for a second, before stating he had Marijuana on him and proceeded to pull out a small, red "Snow Montana" bag out of his right front pants pocket and handed it over to me. Inside the bag was a green leafy substance, which based upon Findley's statement and my training and experience appeared to be Marijuana. I asked Findley if he had any other narcotics or weapons in the vehicle. Findley froze in place and stared at me without uttering a word. After a few seconds, I told Findley to step out of his vehicle and he replied with "are you going to search my car?" I told him I was based upon probable cause due to the plain smell of Marijuana inside the vehicle as well as his actual possession of such. Findley's face became pale and he quietly uttered "what if there is something else?" Findley's voice was soft and shaky, which led me to believe he was nervous. I asked Findley what he meant and he paused again and then uttered he had "under a pound" of weed in the car. I told Findley to step out of the vehicle in order for me to conduct a full search. Findley complied and exited the vehicle without incident. Nelson also stepped out of the vehicle and was asked about his whereabouts. Nelson stated Findley picked him up from his house prior to arriving at the Royal Inn and has been in the passenger seat since. Nelson did not know why Findley pulled into the Royal Inn and stated once they arrived Findley was on the phone with someone. After a brief conversation, Findley drove back out and continued west on Southern Blvd.

A search of the vehicle pursuant to probable cause based on the plain smell of Marijuana coupled with the driver's actual possession of such was then conducted. As I began my search on the driver side, I noticed a large black pouch behind the driver seat. I flipped the pouch, which was transparent on the other side, and I observed a large quantity of a green leafy substance, which based upon my training and experience, I recognize as Marijuana. Inside the pouch, I observed approximately fifteen (15) "Snow Montana" bags, which were the same bags that Findley carried his personal Marijuana in. I continued my search and located a black digital scale inside the glove compartment. The rest of the search did not yield anything noteworthy. As I concluded my search, I walked over to Findley and before I could say anything Findley spontaneously uttered the following, non verbatim: "I'm so sorry, I bought all that from this website called Hashlantean.com and I was supposed to get my medicinal card tomorrow and I promised myself I would stop buying weed from that site and do it the right way through the dispensaries." He further uttered "I only bought this much so I could sell half and keep the other half to smoke." The suspected Marijuana was field tested positive with Duquenois-Levine Reagent and had a total package weight of 215 grams. The suspected Marijuana was submitted into evidence for testing. Findley was asked why he was at the Royal Inn to which he stated that he was going to sell some Marijuana to someone there but got "creeped out" and left without getting out of his car. It should be noted the Royal Inn is less than 1000 feet away from the Racetrack gas station and convenience store which is located at 665 Royal Palm Beach Blvd. It should also be noted that the Royal Inn is on the same property as the Racetrack gas station and the business was open to the public between the hours of 11pm and 5am (24 hour business), is not solely or primarily a restaurant (has no restaurant), has fewer than 5 employees after 11pm and before 5am (2 employees maximum), has less than 10,000 square feet of retail floor space, and Findley stated he did not have any family members that work at or have ownership interest in the business. As a result, pursuant to FSS 812.171, the Racetrack gas station is considered a convenience business. On 12/17/2021, I received the test results from the PBSO Chemistry Lab in reference to the suspected Marijuana as follows: MARIJUANA Schedule I - Net Weight: 197.61 grams +/- 0.25 grams at a coverage probability of 99.73%. Methods of analysis: Weight analysis, Macroscopic examination, Microscopic examination, Gas Chromatography-Mass Spectrometry Based upon my investigation, I believe Victor Findley committed the following acts: Possession of a Controlled Substance w/ Intent to Sell within 1,000 ft of a convenience business pursuant to FSS 893.13(1)(e)(2) - For knowingly possessing 197 grams of Marijuana on or about his person, coupled with fifteen (15) Marijuana bags and a digital scale, all with the intent to sell, also according to his own admissions of such, as well as due to the large quantity of Marijuana, which is too large for personal use, while Findley was at the Royal Inn to sell the Marijuana, within 1,000 ft of the Racetrack convenience store. Possession of Drug Paraphernalia pursuant to FSS 893.147(1)(a) - For knowingly possessing the digital scale and fifteen (15) Snow Montana bags, which were used to pack, repack, store, contain, or conceal a controlled substance (Marijuana).
