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On July 23, 2022, at approximately 5:58am, I, Trooper Wood, was on routine patrol from Broward County traveling northbound on State Road 91 (Florida's Turnpike). Traveling north towards and into Palm Beach County, I noticed on my computer aided dispatch that Lake Worth Regional Communications Center (LWRCC) had received a call regarding a vehicle collision between a sedan and a gas tanker semi. The crash, according to my call notes, happened on northbound Interstate 95 (State Road 9) between Atlantic Avenue and Woolbright Road. I self-dispatched myself via my computer aided dispatch to the crash and arrived on scene at approximately 6:29am. Upon arrival, I made contact with the semi gas tanker and driver. I spoke to and identified the driver of the semi gas tanker by his Florida Driver License # (A632425752660) as Mr. JORGE, E, ARTEAGA and took his statement about what had happened and how this vehicle collision had occurred. Mr. Arteaga was not the owner of the semi-tractor and gas tank trailer, but a gas company by the name of ESP FUELING LLC, was. The tractor had a Florida Tag of 71AVCM, and the tanker trailer had a Florida TAG of 5347CX. Mr. Arteaga's identity and the tractor and semi tags were all verified by and on FCIC/NCIC.

Mr. Arteaga continue explaining to me that he was traveling northbound on Interstate 95 approaching Woolbright Road in lane three when he felt an impact collision towards the rear end of his trailer. Mr. Arteaga stated to me that he noticed out of his side mirrors, a white sedan fish tailing and losing control behind him. Mr. Arteaga pulled his tractor and trailer over into the right shoulder of Interstate 95 coming to a complete stop. While he was stopped in the right shoulder, he noticed and watched what he believed to be a white KIA continue traveling northbound on Interstate 95. He noted the white sedan (possibly KIA) suffered severe front-end damage as it continued past him. Moments later, I received further information via LWRCC that the white sedan that took off had possibly come to a complete stop in the right shoulder just north of the semi-tractor tanker. LWRCC was able to get a name and phone number of the driver of the white sedan as the driver called in the crash. Once I had finished talking with the semi driver, I advised him he was free to go. I then proceeded northbound a little further on Interstate 95, and I found the white sedan stopped in the right shoulder just north of Woolbright Road.

As I pulled into the right shoulder behind the white sedan, I ran the Florida Tag of 02AGPD through FCIC/NCIC. The vehicle came back to a white KIA Forte owned by a Ms. Yohana Junco Reyes. When I exited my patrol vehicle and approached the passenger side window/door, I found a female sitting in the driver seat with the keys still in the ignition. The airbag had also deployed from the driver's steering wheel. The passenger window was down. Before I asked for identification from the female sitting in the driver's seat, I asked what happened and if she was involved in an accident. I noticed and observed that the female's speech was slow, slurred, and that her eyes were bloodshot, watery and glassy. She was very lethargic and kept stating that she was hit by a semi. I could also smell a faint odor of alcohol emitting from her breath and from the car. I asked the female driver for her driver license and proof of insurance, which she found after looking for the items. I then identified her by her Florida Driver License number of J-526-960-00-756-0. A FCIC/NCIC records checked revealed that I was speaking to a Ms. Yohana Junco Reyes (DOB:7/16/2000). At this moment, the driver of the semi involved in the collision pulled over into the right shoulder north of the KIA Forte and my patrol vehicle. The driver began walking back towards me to confirm that the KIA Forte was the vehicle that collided with the rea

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end of his trailer. The KIA Forte had extensive front-end damage.

Based on the clues I observed from Ms. Junco Reyes, I requested to LWRCC to send me an additional unit, at which Sgt Rodriguez (ID#420) and Trooper Medastin (ID#1456) arrived minutes later. I also asked Ms. Junco Reyes where she was coming from and what she was doing. She stated that she was coming from Miami towards West Palm Beach, and that she was a runway model. Fire Rescue was then called to the scene to ensure that Ms. Junco Reyes had not suffered any injuries or required medical assistance. Once Fire Rescue arrived on scene, they determined that Ms. Junco Reyes did not suffer any injuries, and that she had refused to be checked out.

With additional units on scene, I, at approximately 7:28am, explained and stated to Ms. Junco Reyes that I was finished conducting my crash investigation and that I was now going to be conducting a DUI investigation. I read Ms. Junco Reyes her Miranda Rights while she was inside of the vehicle and asked her if she was willing to perform standardized field sobriety exercises (SFSEs) to determine if her normal faculties were impaired. Ms. Junco Reyes stated she would, at which time I asked her to exit her vehicle. Upon exiting her vehicle, Ms. Junco Reyes stumbled and walked in a westerly direction towards the flow of traffic on Interstate 95 causing Trooper Medastin to assist and correct her from walking into traffic and back towards my patrol vehicle.

At approximately 7:37am, I advised LWRCC that I was going to be conducting field sobriety exercises. Exercises were conducted roadside. The surface was flat, and light was provided by the sun. The exercises began and prior to administering each task, I thoroughly explained, demonstrated, and asked Ms. Junco Reyes if she understood the task prior to starting. Ms. Junco Reyes said she understood. Ms. Junco Reyes also stated that she did not have any injuries or medical conditions that would prevent her from doing the exercises. The SFSEs were administered in the following order with results.

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus Task:

Prior to beginning this Task, it was determined Ms. Junco Reyes was not wearing glasses. Ms. Junco Reyes eyes were checked. Her eyes displayed equal tracking and her pupils were equal size. Ms. Junco Reyes was instructed to follow the stimulus with her eyes only, keeping her head still. After stating she understood the instructions, Ms. Junco Reyes attempted this task.

The results of this exercise displayed:

Kept moving head to follow the stimulus.

Lack of Smooth Pursuit in both eyes

Distinct and Sustained Nystagmus at Maximum Deviation both eyes.

Onset of Nystagmus Prior to 45 Degrees both eyes.

No Vertical Nystagmus.

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Walk and Turn Task:

Prior to attempting this test, Ms. Junco Reyes was instructed to put her left foot on the line and her right foot in front of it, with her right heel touching the toe of her left foot. She was instructed to stand in this manner with her hands to her sides until the task instructions were completed and the exercise demonstrated. Ms. Junco Reyes was instructed not to begin the task until told to start. Ms. Junco Reyes stated she understood. She was also instructed to take nine heel to toe steps down a line (line was provided by yellow tape) and walk back down the line in the same manner. While taking her nine heel to toe steps, she was instructed to keep her arms down to her side, look down at her feet, and count her steps out loud. Once she reached the first nine steps, she was to take a series of small steps on her lead foot and turn around making a small circle to go back down the line. She was instructed to keep her arms down, watch her feet, and count her steps out loud. Once she returned from the second nine steps back down the line, she was to turn around and step off the line. The exercise and instructions were demonstrated by me and Ms. Junco Reyes stated that she understood. After the instructions were given and demonstrated, Ms. Junco Reyes displayed the possible clues.

Walk and Turn task observations:

No heel to toe going down the first 9 steps or second 9 coming back.
 Attempted to start the exercises before instructed to start.
 Did not stay at starting position during instruction period but went up on her tippy toes.
 Did not look down at feet going down for first 9 steps nor did she look down on second 9 coming back.

One Leg Stand Task:

Prior to attempting this task, Ms. Junco Reyes indicated she did not have any medical problems that would have prevented her from performing the task, but she wanted to decide which foot would be the best foot to stand on. Ms. Junco Reyes was instructed to stand with her heels together and hands down to her sides while the instructions were given and during the task. She was instructed not to begin the task until she was instructed to start, and after the task had been demonstrated. When instructed to start, she was to raise the foot of her choice off the ground, approximately 6 inches. While her leg was raised, she was to keep her leg straight, watch her raised foot, and to count out loud by thousands (one thousand one, one thousand two, one thousand three...) and to continue the task until told to stop (30 seconds). After this task was demonstrated and she indicated that she understood the instructions, Ms. Junco Reyes completed the task.

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When Ms. Junco Reyes attempted this task, she displayed the following clues:

Did not look down at raised foot.
Hopped.
Almost fell over.
Stopped to think of which number she was on counting on.
Placed foot down during "one thousand count"
Counted only up to one thousand thirteen.

At 7:39am, following completion of SFSEs, I placed Ms. Junco Reyes under arrest due to my observations and her performance of the SFSEs. I suspected Ms. Junco Reyes to be under the influence of alcohol and or controlled a substance while operating a motor vehicle, resulting in a collision. Before placing her in the back of my patrol vehicle Ms. Junco Reyes was asked to remove her personal items and asked if she had anything illegal on her person. After placing Ms. Junco Reyes in the back of my patrol car, at approximately 7:45am, I transported Ms. Junco Reyes to the Palm Beach County Jail.

Once we arrived at the Jail, I conducted a twenty-minute observation period of Ms. Junco Reyes that began at 8:02am. I verified that there was nothing in her mouth and that she did not regurgitate anything from the mouth. Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office (PBSO), Certified breath test operator, prepared the Intoxilyzer for use. After the twenty-minute observation period was over, PBSO certified breath test operator and myself, asked Ms. Junco Reyes to submit to a breath test at which she stated she would.

At 8:28am, the first sample was taken, and Ms. Junco Reyes yielded a breath sample of .109. At 8:31am, a second sample was taken, and the second breath sample yielded a result of .108.

Once the breath test results were completed and yielded the results of a .109 and .108, I attempted to read Ms. Junco Reyes her rights again and ask her a few more questions. Ms. Junco Reyes stated that she was in Miami with some friends and she had consumed whiskey in a slow manner.

Based upon the aforementioned information, I have reason to believe and do believe the defendant, Yohana Junco Reyes did violate F.S.S. 316.193, Driving under the Influence to which; the defendant was found behind the wheel of a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol and/or a controlled substance. This offense did occur in Palm Beach County, Florida, where I am a sworn law enforcemer officer.

Ms. Junco Reyes' license was surrendered.

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Ms. Junco Reyes was arrested for DUI and was transported to the Palm Beach County Jail where their personnel took custody of her.

Ms. Junco Reyes' vehicle was inventoried by Trooper Medastin prior to it being towed.

In-Car Video Surveillance is available and uploaded to the server.

All of the above events occurred in Palm Beach County.
