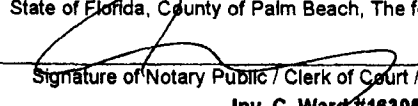
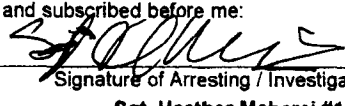

NARRATIVE:

On Monday, March 6, 2023 at approximately 2150hrs I observed a red Volkswagen SUV exit the plaza on the southwest corner of Forest Hill Blvd and Wellington Trace, Wellington, FL 33414. The red VW exited south onto Forest Hill Blvd and made an illegal u-turn through the median with a posted no u-turn sign to head North on Forest Hill Blvd. The red VW then made a left to go West on Wellington Trace. While travelling West on Wellington Trace the red VW crossed over the center line multiple times failing to maintain a single lane of travel. I was then able to pace the vehicle doing approximately 75-80mph until it approached Greenview Shores Blvd. There was a red light for the intersection of Greenview Shores Blvd and Wellington Trace. As the red VW neared the intersection, it slowed but did not come to a complete stop before turning right (North) onto Greenview Shores Blvd. At this time I activated my red and blue emergency lights and sirens to conduct a traffic stop on the red VW bearing Georgia tag TAU4277. I made contact with the driver and sole occupant of the vehicle, Adam William Edgar, who appeared to be under the influence of an unknown substance. Edgar had red glassy eyes and pinpoint pupils. I asked Edgar for his driver license, registration and insurance. Edgar provided his driver's license only. I then asked Edgar for his registration and insurance again, he then provided a receipt for something and not his insurance or registration. I asked for the registration and insurance a third time, which he then very slowly reached over to the glove box and pulled out a stack of papers. Edgar fumbled with the papers while trying to bring them over to his lap to look for the requested documents. At this time I requested a DUI unit to respond. Inv. C. Ward arrived on scene and took over the investigation. I issued Edgar citation AHP948E for failure to stop at a traffic control device (steady red light) pursuant to F.S.S. 316.074(1).

☐ Marsy's Law CVI FL Const. Art.1 § 16(b) I conducted the Standardized Field Sobriety Tasks (SFSTs) in front of my PBSO patrol vehicle using the in car video system with the following results. The area appeared flat and even to the naked eyed, well lit/and clear of any large debris. It was warm and not windy. The area was dry. Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN) The defendant was asked if he had anything wrong with his eyes that were not corrected by corrective lens. He stated that he was color blind. He stated that he was wearing contacts as well. The defendant was placed with their feet together and hands down by their side. The defendant was instructed to await the completion of the instructions prior to beginning the task. The defendant acknowledged that they clearly understood my instructions. I then instructed the defendant on the task. The defendant continually came out to the instructed position. The defendant stated that they clearly understood my instructions for the task. I placed my stimulus in front of the defendant and ask the defendant if they could see it to which he acknowledged that could. I asked the defendant what color the stimulus was to which they answered. "red.". Upon commencing the task the defendant moved their head side to side instead of following with their eyes only and did not follow the stimulus as instructed. I observed that the defendant had equal pupil size and did not exhibit resting nystagmus. The defendant's eyes tracked equally. I observed a lack of smooth pursuit in both of the defendant's left and right eyes. I observed a distinct and sustained nystagmus, a quivering/jerking from side to side, while the stimulus was held at maximum deviation in both of the defendant's left and right eyes. I observed the onset of nystagmus with the stimulus held at/or prior to 45 degrees in both of the defendant's left and right eyes. The defendant would sway and stumble while following the stimulus. I then checked the defendant for Vertical Gaze Nystagmus (VGN). I observed a distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in both of the defendant's left and right eyes.

Art.1 § 16(b) At this time I found probable cause to believe that the defendant was impaired for the purposes of operating and/or being in actual physical control of a motor vehicle pursuant to Florida State Statute 316.193(1a). I handcuffed the denfedant to the rear. I checked the handcuffs for proper fit and double locked them. I then placed the defendant in the rear of my PBSO patrol vehicle. An inventory search of the vehicle was conducted prior to tow per PBSO policy. I located noting to mention inside the vehicle. The vehicle was towed by rotation by Palm Beach Auto Salvage to their impound lot. I transported the Defendant to the Palm Beach County Jail Breath Alcohol Testing (B.A.T.) center. Once at the Breath Alcohol Testing Center I placed the defendant in a centrally located position where they could be easily monitored. I observed the defendant for 20 uninterrupted minutes during which time they did not ingest anything and/or regurgitate. After the 20 minute observation period the defendant was escorted into and isolated testing room which was video recorded. Once inside the room I requested a lawful sample of the defendant's breath for the purposes of determining its blood alcohol content. The defendant refused to give a lawful sample of their breath. The defendant was then read implied consent from a pre-printed PBSO implied consent form. The defendant stated that they understood and was again requested to give a lawful sample of their breath to which the defendant refused. The defendant was read there Miranda rights and stated that they understood. The defendant envolved their right to remain silent.

PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: Actual physical control (physical evidence or statements putting def. behind wheel of vehicle)

I was called to the scene of a traffic stop near the intersection of Greenview Shores Blvd and Wellington Trace, in Village of Wellington, Palm Beach County, Florida. I arrived at the scene at approximately 2222 hrs.

Sgt. H Maharaj # 14261 told me, in a signed sworn PC Supplement, that she had stopped the defendant's vehicle, a Red Volkswagen SUV bearing Ga Tag TAU4277 because the defendant's vehicle made an illegal u-turn. Sgt. H. Maharaj noticed that the defendant had articulable indicators of impairment, so she requested me to respond to conduct a possible DUI investigation. Sgt. H. Maharaj identified the defendant, to me, as the driver / sole occupant of the defendant's vehicle, at the time of the stop. (See Supplemental PC for further)

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

I made contact with the defendant, later identified by their Virginian Driver's License. I observed that the defendant had red, watery, bloodshot eyes. His pupils were dilated, even in direct light. The defendant was moving his mouth as though he was chewing on something but had nothing in his mouth. The defendant had slurred speech, and the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage, based on my training and life experiences, that came from their breath which intensified as they spoke to me. I

I asked the defendant to exit the vehicle. The defendant swayed while standing and stumbled while walking.

I asked the defendant to perform voluntary field sobriety tasks. The defendant refused, so I gave the Taylor Warnings explaining to him that if he chose not to complete the tasks then I would have to base my decision to arrest on the probable cause I already had observed. I explained the evidence that I had already observed. I advised the defendant that his refusal to complete the task could be used against him in any criminal proceedings. The defendant stated that he understood. I again asked the defendant to complete the voluntary roadside tasks and the defendant consented.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

asked the defendant if they had any medical problems and he stated that he has ADHD and Dyslexia. He stated that he takes Xanax as well as another medication for his anxiety, He stated that he took both medications in the morning. 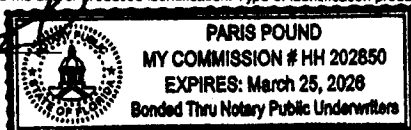

WALK & TURN:

I placed, with the assistance of another deputy, an approximately 2" wide piece of yellow on the ground. I asked the defendant if they knew their left from their right which they did. I asked the defendant if they could see the line and they stated that they did. I asked the defendant what color the line was and they stated yellow. I had the defendant place their left foot on the line with their right foot in front of the left, heel to toe. I instructed the defendant to remain in the position throughout my instructions and demonstration. The defendant was instructed not to start the task prior to me telling them to begin. The defendant acknowledged and stated they completely understood my instructions. The defendant was then instructed on the task which I also demonstrated. The defendant swayed during my instructions. The defendant came out of the stance prior to me telling them to begin. Once the defendant was told to begin the task they missed heel to toe, stepped off the line, used their arms for balance, made an improper turn, walked the incorrect number of steps, and slowed to balance/steady themselves. The defendant asked for additional instructions and swayed throughout completing the task. The defendant did not look at his feet as instructed while completing the task.

ONE LEG STAND:

The defendant was instructed to stand with their feet together and their hands down by their side. They were then instructed to remain in the position throughout the instructions and demonstration until instructed to begin. The defendant acknowledged and stated that they clearly understood the instructions. The defendant swayed while in the instructional position. After being told to begin the defendant put their foot down prior to being told to stop, used their arms for balance, and swayed. The defendant did not count in the manner instructed. The defendant did not point their toe or look at their toe as instructed. The defendant keep his legs straight as instructed.

FINGER TO NOSE:

The defendant was instructed to stand with their feet together and their hands down by their side. The defendant was then instructed to remain in the position throughout the instructions and demonstration until instructed to begin. The defendant acknowledged and stated that they clearly understood these instructions. The defendant swayed while in the instructional position. I instructed the defendant on the task and demonstrated the task. The defendant acknowledged the instructions stating that they clearly understood them. The defendant proceeded to miss/search for the tip of their nose with the tip of their finger, and did not bring their hand immediately bring back as instructed after numerous reminders to do so. The defendant did not keep their head tilted back and opened their eyes during the task. The defendant swayed throughout the task.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

The defendant was instructed to stand with their feet together and their hands down by their side. The defendant was then instructed to remain in the position throughout the instructions and demonstration until instructed to begin. The defendant acknowledged and stated that they clearly understood these instructions. The defendant swayed while in the instructional position. The defendant stated that they knew their English alphabet from A to Z. I instructed them on the task and then demonstrated the task. The defendant acknowledged the instructions stating that they clearly understood them. The defendant then proceeded to hesitate while saying parts of they alphabet and rhymed the alphabet after the letter L,M,N,O,P. The defendant did not keep their head tilted back during the task.

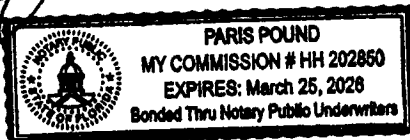
