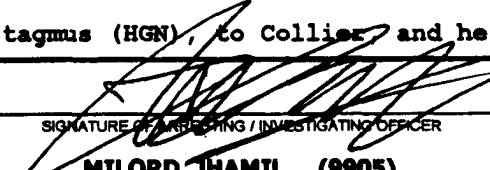

On July 11, 2025, at approximately 3:34 AM, I responded to Police Officer Castelly's traffic stop as a backup officer.									
P.R.O.B.A.B.L.E	Upon arrival at the scene, PO Castelly notified me that the driver, Aiden Collier (w/m 08/29/2001), who was one of two occupants in the vehicle, was showing signs of impairment. PO Castelly notified me that he conducted a traffic stop on Collier's vehicle for an illegal U-Turn and driving southbound in the northbound lanes. PO Castelly then advised me that when he made contact with Collier, he immediately smelled alcohol emanating from the vehicle. PO Castelly also notified me that Collier had red, glassy eyes. Also, Collier had a passenger who was identified as Jack Collins (w/m 04/27/2003) with him as well.								
	I made contact with Collier and asked him where he was coming from. Collier stated that he was coming from Johnny Mangos. I then attempted to ask Collier more questions, but Collins was continuously being loud and belligerent. Collins was removed from the scene by PO Vickers so I could continue my investigation. I then asked Collier if he had anything to drink, and he stated that following: "Not enough to be over the legal limit." I then asked Collier how long ago he had those drinks, and he stated it was a couple of hours ago. While talking to Collier, I noticed that his face was flushed, he had red, glassy eyes, dilated pupils, slurred speech, and the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath. I asked Collier if he would be willing to complete several Standardized Field Sobriety Tasks (SFSTs) in order to dispel my suspicion of him driving under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol. Collier stated the following: "I don't know what is in my best interest, I don't think I am impaired." I then advised Collier of his Taylor Warnings two times. Collier then stated that he would do the tasks.

that he understood. I placed the stimulus (a red Topoptix Streamlight) in front of Collier and advised him to follow the pen with his eyes only. Collier swayed from left to right throughout this task. As I began to move the pen, would kept his eyes forward and did not follow the stimulus. I had to remind him to follow the pen with his eyes only, numerous times. Collier was eventually able to follow the pen, and his eyes showed the following signs: a Lack of Smooth Pursuit in both the right and left eyes, Distinct and Sustained Nystagmus at Maximum Deviation in both the right and left eyes, Onset of Nystagmus Prior to 45 degrees in both the right and left eyes, Vertical Gaze Nystagmus in both right and left eyes, and a lack of convergence in his left eye. I explained and demonstrated the second SFST, Walk and Turn, to Collier. I used bright yellow tape to make a straight line. I placed the bright yellow tape down on the ground and performed nine heel-to-toe steps down the straight line to set it into the ground. I asked Collier if he was comfortable walking a straight line in the shoes he was wearing, and he stated that he was comfortable. Collier would continuously argue with me about the line not being straight. It should be noted that the line was straight. It should also be noted that Collier stated that he could see the bright yellow line. I instructed Collier to get into the proper starting position (left foot on line with right foot in front, touching heel to toe). Collier placed his right foot on the line instead of his left foot. I had to instruct Collier again to place his left foot on the line. While I was explaining the SFST to him, Collier broke the starting position by stepping off the line and removing his hands from his sides. Collier would then interrupt me before I could finish the instructions. Collier then stated that he did not understand the instructions. As I attempted to give him the instructions again, Collier walked off the line and would interrupt me. I informed Collier that I would count this task as a refusal. Collier then stated that he would complete the task and just needed the instructions one more time. I instructed Collier to get back into the starting position. Collier placed his hands towards the front of his legs. I instructed Collier that he must place his hands down at his sides. Collier would not pay attention to me and looked elsewhere. Collier then broke the starting position again by walking off the line. Collier broke the starting position a total of three times. Collier then attempted to begin the task before being told to do so. Collier eventually stated that he understood the instructions and demonstration I showed him. Collier was instructed that he could begin the task. Collier did nine steps the first time and ten steps the second time. Collier did not miss any heel-to-toe touch steps the first time. On the second set of steps, Collier missed heel-to-toe touches on the first step. Also, during this task, Collier did an improper turn by turning in the wrong direction, was not able to maintain his balance, stopped while walking, and stepped off the line. I explained and demonstrated the third SFST, One Leg Stand, to Collier. While explaining the instructions to Collier, he broke the starting position by separating his feet and removing his hands from his sides. Collier also began to laugh and stated the following: "You can't even do it." It should be noted that as I was demonstrating this task, I did

	not sway or put my foot down until I completed the instructions. Collier stated that he understood the instructions and the demonstration I showed him. Collier was instructed that he could begin the task. Collier lifted his right foot, counted to 1001, removed his arms from his side, and put his foot down. Collier did not lift his foot back up; instead, he looked at me and smiled. Collier then asked for the instructions again. Collier would continuously interrupt and argue with me. Collier would keep asking for the instructions after I demonstrated it for him a total of two times. I counted this task as a refusal due to Collier's consistent arguing. I attempted to explain and demonstrated the Finger to Nose, to Collier and he would look away from me. I again attempted to explain and demonstrate the task to Collier however, he would constantly look away from me and break the starting position. Due to Collier not paying attention this task was not able to be completed. Due to Collier's unwillingness to perform the tasks, he was placed under arrest for suspicion of driving under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol. While attempting to place handcuffs on Collier, he would tense up and slightly pull away. Handcuffs were eventually able to be placed on Collier, and they were checked for fit and double locked. Collier was also searched before being placed into the back of my marked patrol vehicle. At the time of the arrest was wearing a blue shirt, blue shorts, and white shoes. While in my marked patrol car, I asked Collier if he would provide a sample of his breath to determine the alcohol content. Collier stated that he would like to call his mom. I informed Collier that he would not be able to call his mom at this time. I again asked Collier if he would be willing to provide a breath sample, and he kept stating that he wanted to call his mom. Collier then stated that he would take the test later. I informed Collier that he would not be able to take the test later. Collier then stated that he would like some legal assistance. I read implied consent to Collier, and he stated that I could take his blood. I advised Collier that taking his blood is not necessary at this time. I again asked Collier if he would like to provide a breath sample, and he argued with me. Collier then refused to give consent for his breath at 04:12 AM. An inventory search of Collier's vehicle was conducted due to it being towed. While searching the vehicle, there were two silver cans with the branding of Coors Light on them in the in the rear of the vehicle. Both the cans had a heavy smell of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from them. Based on my investigation, I believe probable cause exists to charge Collier with the following:

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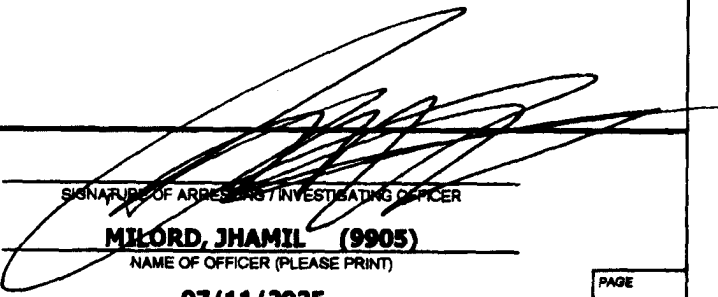

	Aiden Collier did drive or was in actual physical control of a vehicle, while under the influence of alcoholic beverages or chemical substances as set forth in Florida Statute 877.111, or a controlled substance as set forth in Chapter 893 or any combination thereof, and was affected to the extent that his or her normal faculties were impaired; or while having a blood alcohol level of .08 or more grams of alcohol per 100 milliliters of blood or breath alcohol level of .08 or more grams of alcohol per 210 liters of breath, contrary to Florida Statute 316.193(1). Collier was issued citations for the following: Driving under the influence, improper right turn (#AK2M47E), failure to obey a traffic control device (#AK2M48E), and driving onto oncoming traffic (#AK2M49E). Collier's vehicle was towed off the scene by Kauffs Towing. Collier was turned over to Palm Beach County Jail Personnel without incident. This incident was video recorded on my department-issued cellphone. At the 00:30 mark, you see me make contact with Collier. At the 1:10 mark of the video, you see Collier admit to having some drinks. At the 02:44 mark, you see me ask Collier if he would like to do the SFSTs. At the 3:30 mark, you see me advise Collier of his Taylor Warnings. At the 6:00 mark of the video, Collier states he will do the SFSTs. At the 6:05 mark, I begin the SFSTs uninterrupted until the 20:35 mark of the video. However, during that interval, you see Collier constantly arguing with me and refusing to do some of the tasks. At the 20:35 mark of the video, you see me place Collier under arrest. There is also another video of me asking Collier for a breath sample. At the 00:20 Mark of the video, you see me ask Collier for consent to get a sample of his breath. At the 1:50 mark of the video, you see me read implied consent to Collier. At the 3:30 mark of the video, you see Collier refuse to give a breath sample after being read his implied consent. At the 2:30 mark until the end of the video, you see Collier consistently arguing with me about attempting to give blood instead of his breath. Both videos were submitted to NPBPD Records. No further information.

P R O B A B L E C A U S E S T A T E M E N T	On July 11, 2025, at approximately 3:34 a.m., while patrolling the 100 block of U.S. Highway 1, I observed a white Toyota pickup truck traveling southbound on U.S. Highway 1. The driver then entered the northbound turning lane through a divided median and proceeded southbound in the northbound lanes to conduct a U-turn in a location clearly marked with traffic control devices prohibiting U-turns.								
	The vehicle turned into the parking lot of the Brass Ring Pub. At that time, I activated my emergency lights from my marked police vehicle. The driver, later identified as Aiden V. Collier (W/M, DOB: 08/29/2001), initially stopped the vehicle, and the passenger, later identified as Jack A. Collins (W/M, DOB: 04/27/2003), exited the vehicle. Collier then began driving again while Collins yelled at him to stop the truck. Collier ultimately came to a complete stop in a back alley located on Castlewood Drive.								
	Upon approaching the vehicle, I detected the odor of alcohol emanating from within. I made contact with the driver, Collier, and observed that his eyes were red and glassy. While attempting to obtain Collier's driver's license and vehicle credentials, Collins became verbally aggressive toward P.O. H. Vickers, yelling, "We don't have to answer questions or give him our IDs."								
	P.O. Vickers issued Collins a lawful order to stop as he approached the vehicle. Collins refused and pulled away from the officer's attempt to stop him, resulting in his detainment at the scene.								
	Due to observations indicating possible impairment, I transferred control of the scene to P.O. J. Milord to conduct a field sobriety test on Collier.								
See P.O. Milord's report for further details.

WALK & TURN:

WALK & TURN. I explained and demonstrated the second SFST, Walk and Turn, to Collier. I used bright yellow tape to make a straight line. I placed the bright yellow tape down on the ground and performed nine heel-to-toe steps down the straight line to set it into the ground. I asked Collier if he was comfortable walking a straight line in the shoes he was wearing, and he stated that he was comfortable. Collier would continuously argue with me about the line not being straight. It should be noted that the line was straight. It should also be noted that Collier stated that he could see the bright yellow line. I instructed Collier to go into the proper starting position (left foot on line with right foot in front, touching heel to toe). Collier placed his right foot on the line instead of his left foot. I had to instruct Collier again to place his left foot on the line. While I was explaining the SFST to him, Collier broke the starting position by stepping off the line and removing his hands from his sides. Collier would then interrupt me before I could finish the instructions. Collier then stated that he did not understand the instructions. As I attempted to give him the instructions again, Collier walked off the line and would interrupt me. I informed Collier that I would count this task as a refusal. Collier then stated that he would complete the task and just needed the instructions one more time. I instructed Collier to get back into the starting position. Collier placed his hands towards the front of his legs. I instructed Collier that he must place his hands down at his sides. Collier would not pay attention to me and looked elsewhere. Collier then broke the starting position again by walking off the line. Collier broke the starting position a total of three times. Collier then attempted to begin the task before being told to do so. Collier eventually stated that he understood the instructions and demonstration I showed him. Collier was instructed that he could begin the task. Collier did nine steps the first time and ten steps the second time. Collier did not miss any heel-to-toe touch steps the first time. On the second set of steps, Collier missed heel-to-toe touches on the first step. Also, during this task, Collier did an improper turn by turning in the wrong direction, was not able to maintain his balance, stopped while walking, and stepped off the line.

ONE LEG STAND:

I explained and demonstrated the third SFST, One Leg Stand, to Collier. While explaining the instructions to Collier, he broke the starting position by separating his feet and removing his hands from his sides. Collier also began to laugh and stated the following: "You can't even do it." It should be noted that as I was demonstrating this task, I did not sway or put my foot down until I completed the instructions. Collier stated that he understood the instructions and the demonstration I showed him. Collier was instructed that he could begin the task. Collier lifted his right foot, counted to 1001, removed his arms from his side, and put his foot down. Collier did not lift his foot back up; instead, he looked at me and smiled. Collier then asked for the instructions again. Collier would continuously interrupt and argue with me. Collier would keep asking for the instructions after I demonstrated it for him a total of two times. I counted this task as a refusal due to Collier's consistent arguing.

FINGER TO NOSE:

I attempted to explain and demonstrated the Finger to Nose, to Collier and he would look away from me. I again attempted to explain and demonstrate the task to Collier however, he would constantly look away from me and break the starting position. Due to Collier not paying attention this task was not able to be completed.

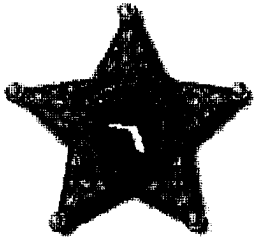

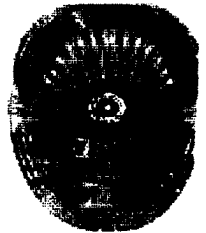
