On Tuesday June 13, 2023 at approximately 2241hrs I responded to Gateway Boulevard and Lawrence Road, Boynton Beach, FL 33436 in reference to a D.U.I. investigation on a possible impaired driver. Upon arrival I spoke with Sgt. [REDACTED] that advised the following: I was leaving the parking lot of Duff's Restaurant located at 6545 Boynton Beach Blvd, unincorporated Boynton Beach, Florida when I noticed a w/m wearing a black tee shirt and black pants walked toward her vehicle, a 4d Nissan Murano SUV. The female was unsteady on her feet. I circle around the parking lot and noticed that the vehicle had moved from the Duff's parking lot. I searched the area and located the vehicle in the parking lot of 7-11. I waited for the female in the parking lot. I noticed the female exiting the store and get into the driver's seat of the Nissan and drive away. I followed the vehicle northbound on Jog Road and I noticed that the driver could not maintain her single lane. She drifted in and out of her lane. I continued to follow her to Gateway Blvd where she turned left to travel eastbound. As I was following her, she continued to drift and straddled the outside lane and almost fit the curve. I conducted a traffic stop by activating my lights and sirens. Once the vehicle pulled over, I met the driver and explained why she was being pulled over. I noticed when I walked up toward the driver's door that the driver was attempted to drink a soft drink and place something inside of her mouth. I instructed her not to eat or drink while I was on this traffic stop. She advised me that she was coming from work where she had two beers and dinner with a friend. I asked her for her license and registration. She handed me a bunch of papers and told me that the papers were her license and registration. While standing at her driver door, I could smell a strong alcoholic odor emitting from the driver's person. The driver was later identified as Aimee Balentine.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

Upon making contact with the defendant who was seated in the driver seat of her vehicle. I immediately smelled an obvious odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from within the vehicle. I observed the defendant's eyes to be glassy, watery, and red. I also observed the defendant to have a slow and slurred speech. The defendant had a pale and flushed face. The defendant was asked to step out of her vehicle and speak with me in front of my patrol car, as she stepped out of her car. She staggered to the side and had an unstable balance. I also observed the defendant to have a sway as she stood normally without walking. As she spoke with me I immediately smelled a strong and obvious odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from her breath. Later she kept asking the same question as if she had forgotten that she had already asked me several times before. It should also be noted that the interior of my vehicle had a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage after she was sitting in my vehicle after a few minutes.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

The defendant stated she has no physical defects or injuries except for her left hip that was hurting her. She said that she uses that hip to hold her clients as she massages them and it hurts from her hip to her chest. Throughout my interactions with the defendant I observed her walking normal. She stated she had no medical conditions except for anxiety. She said that she was taking Klonopin for her anxiety. She stated she has not hit her head recently. She stated she was on her way home, from eating with a friend. She stated she was driving on Congress Avenue. After saying that she asked me if she was wrong. She thought for a little bit and then said, "Gateway?". She stated that she had only drank two beers while at dinner. She said they were Yeng-Ling beers and that she drank the first one at 2000hrs and the last was at 2200hrs.

ODORS:

An obvious odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from her breath which intensified as she spoke with me.

SPEECH: Slow, slurred, thick and at times difficult to understand.

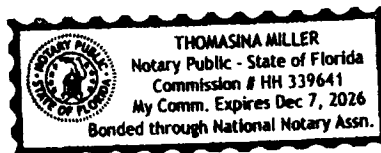

Other Observations:

The defendant was placed into the instructional stance for Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus. She verbally identified the red stimulus that I was holding up. She was told to follow the stimulus with her eyes only and not to move her head. I checked her eyes for equal pupil size, equal tracking, and resting nystagmus. I observed a lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes. I observed distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes. I observed onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in both eyes. She was reminded several times not to move her head. I did not observe any vertical nystagmus in neither eye. She swayed from side to side throughout this process.

WALK & TURN:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the Walk & Turn to her. She stated she understood the instructions and asked a few questions for me. She failed to maintain the instructional stance by separating her feet help steady herself. She swayed from side to side. She did not walk heel to toe, stepped off the line, stopped to steady herself, took more than nine steps, did not count the steps out loud, and made an improper turn. She used her arms to assist in balance herself while in the starting position. She started this task without being instructed to start.

ONE LEG STAND:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the One Leg Stand to her. She stated she understood the instructions and asked a few questions of the task. She failed to maintain the instructional stance by separating her feet to help steady herself. She swayed from side to side. She lowered the foot several time, did not count out loud, and did not look down at her foot. She did not hold her foot out in front of her as I had instructed and kept her foot pointed up. She started this task without being instructed to start.

FINGER TO NOSE:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the Finger to Nose task to her. She stated she understood the instructions and asked a few questions. She failed to maintain the instructional stance by separating her feet to help steady herself. She missed all attempts with both the right and left hand. She used the pad of his fingers, touched under the nose, and to the side of the nose. I had to remind her several times to drop the hand the moment she touched the tip of the nose.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the Rhomberg Alphabet task to her. She stated she understood the instructions and had a few questions for me. She failed to maintain the instructional stance by separating her feet to help steady herself. She swayed from side to side. She correctly recited the Alphabet.

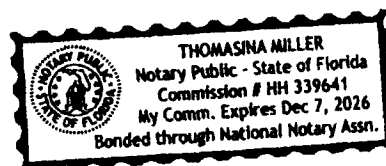

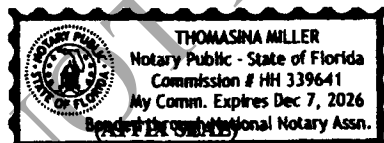
