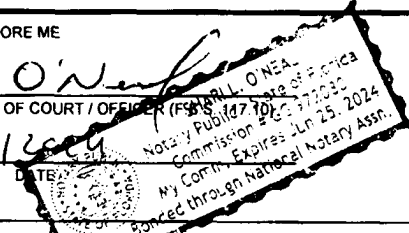

On Sunday February 18th, 2024, I, Officer Renteria, was dispatched to RCA Boulevard/ PGA Boulevard at 0146 hours in the City of Palm Beach Gardens, Florida in reference to a male on the road with a disabled vehicle. My department issued body worn camera was used on this call. Upon arrival, I observed a black, four door Jeep disabled on the far-left lane, bearing Florida tag PCCR59, on the north bound lanes of PGA Boulevard. I observed a missing tire on the driver side, and damage to the front bumper of the vehicle. I made contact with the driver, Alex Anthony Martin, who was already standing outside his vehicle. Officer Trudeau was first on scene to observe how the scene was upon arrival. When asking Martin what occurred, he appeared to be nervous about what happened. He responded with slurred speech stating that he was on his way home to Palm Beach Gardens, coming from West Palm Beach. He stated that he was hanging out with a friend at his residence. I asked Martin if he had anything to drink, to which he stated "yes". He advised that he had "one beer". Salvador stated that he had that beer three hours ago with his friend. Due to the damage on his front bumper, driving on one rim, blood shot eyes and slurred speech, I conducted a DUI investigation. I asked Martin if he would be able to perform a series of Standardized Field Sobriety Tests, to which he stated "yes". I asked him if he had any injuries and if he is wearing any eye contacts. He responded to no injuries but is currently wearing contacts. Martin performed the horizontal gaze nystagmus. Throughout my observation, I noticed Martin's eye to be involuntarily jerking. I observed a lack of smooth pursuit. He was also swaying side to side.

	Martin performed the walk and turn. During the instructional phase, he was unable to keep balance, swayed and stepped out of position. He also started prior to being directed to. After instructions were given and Martin stated that he understood, Martin started on command. I observed the following clues: Martin lost balance and stumbled while completing the turn. He also miscounted. Martin also used his hands for balance. Martin performed the one leg stand. The instructions were explained and demonstrated to Salvador, who stated he understood. During the instructional phase, he was unable to keep balance, swayed and stepped out of position. He also did not count as instructed. Martin performed the finger to nose test. During the test, Martin did not follow the instructions and did not keep his eyes closed and head tilted back. Throughout the test, he would tilt his head forward. Based on the totality of the circumstances stated above, I placed Martin under arrest for DUI. He was placed into handcuffs, which were checked for proper fit and double locked. He was searched incident to arrest. Salvador was transported to the Palm Beach County Breath Alcohol Testing Center (BAT) without incident. Upon arrival at the BAT, he was placed in a seat and was observed for 20 minutes and did not ingest anything or vomit. Martin did use the restroom upon arrival. At the end of the observation, I brought Martin on camera and asked him to submit to the breath test and to which he agreed to my request. He provided a breath sample to Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office Breathalyzer Technician O'Neal ID 6212 blowing a 0.130 BrAC at 0330 and 0.127 BrAC at 0333. Martin was read the results, to which he advised he understood that he is over the legal limit. I find probable cause to charge Martin with DUI - DUI breath over .08 per FL Statue 316.193(1)(C). I issued a citation DUI - Driving Under the Influence (AINOIME).

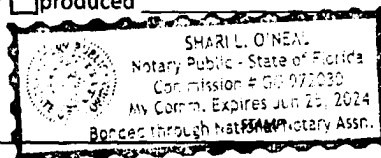

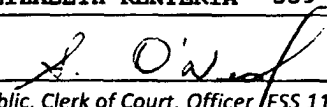


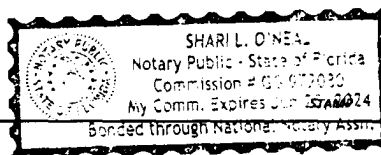
