NARRATIVE: The undersigned has probable cause to believe the above-named defendant on the 07 of March 2024 at 19:02 at SR417SB MM9 (Zone: KORS1) in Orange County did

On March 3rd, 2024, at approximately 7:02 pm, I was on patrol in Orange County, Florida when the Florida Highway Patrol dispatcher requested that I go investigate a vehicle that was reported by a concerned citizen. Dispatch stated the vehicle was a dark grey Jeep Wrangler bearing the Florida Tag# UDAUDA, traveling south on State Road 417 and had just passed mile marker 9, which is located within the jurisdictional limits of Orange County. The vehicle was reported traveling recklessly, as it failed to maintain within its lane, nearly colliding with other vehicles and at one-point colliding with a construction barrel.

I caught up to the reported vehicle at State Road 417 and Osceola Pkwy which is located within the jurisdictional limits of Osceola County. As I approached the exit dispatch advised that the concerned citizen, driving a white truck with its hazard lights on and that it would be behind the grey Jeep that he called about. While exiting State Road 417, I observed the white truck with its hazards directly behind a grey Jeep matching the description of the reported vehicle. Upon verifying I was with the correct vehicle, due to safety concerns and to avoid any further risk to the motorist public, I immediately engaged my emergency lights and sirens to lawfully order the vehicle to stop. The Jeep had a delayed response to pulling over and when it began to pull over, it struck the curb. It then came to a stop just before turning right on Osceola Pkwy.

When I walked up to the Jeep, I observed a young female with black hair and yellow clothing in the driver's seat. No other occupants were in the vehicle. Upon opening the door to speak to the female, she looked at me and started crying. I asked her if she was ok and asked her what was going on while hysterically crying, I could not understand what she mumbled back. I explained to her that she was being stopped due to her driving pattern. The female was later identified as Alexandra Joy Weissman (Ms. Weissman), by her Florida driver license.

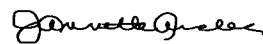
While speaking to Ms. Weissman, I observed that she had bloodshot and glossy eyes. When she spoke, her speech was mumbled and hard to understand at times. She demonstrated mood swings and was very emotional. Additionally, when she spoke, I could smell the odor commonly associated with an alcoholic beverage emitting from her breath. I asked Ms. Weissman to turn her car off and give me the keys, to which she complied. Once I was in possession of the car keys, I told Ms. Weissman to stay in her vehicle while I spoke with the witness. She continued to cry as I walked away.

I then spoke to the witness, who I identified the witness as Ricky Singh (Mr. Singh). Mr. Singh showed me videos of the Jeep veering off the roadway completely and failing to maintain its lane. He stated that he also saw the Jeep hit a construction barrel and continued driving. Mr. Singh provided a sworn statement. After speaking with Mr. Singh, I went back to the vehicle to speak with Ms. Weissman. I explained to her that she was being detained and I suspected that she is driving under the influence (DUI). I read Ms. Weissman her constitutional rights (Miranda rights) and asked her if she understood what I had just rear to her. She stated she did while still crying. Post-Miranda, I asked her where she was coming from and she stated she was coming from her house and was traveling to her friend's house for an upcoming wedding. I asked her if she was aware of her driving pattern. She stated she was, but it was only because she was upset with her boyfriend from an argument they had. I explained to her that there were some indicators that lead me to the suspicion that she was driving under the influence. I also attempted to ask her questions where she did not want to answer. I explained to her that it was her right not to answer questions but that I would still proceed with my investigation and ask her questions. I asked her a series of questions which included: Are you sick or injured? She stated "no". Do you have any physical defects? She stated "no". Have you ever had a head injury? She stated "no". Are you under the care of a doctor or dentist? She stated she is for migraines. Are you diabetic? She stated, "no". When did you last eat? She stated, this morning I ate a sandwich with yogurt. Have you had anything to drink? She stated that she had one cup of wine at around 3 pm. I asked her while pointing at the car she was sitting in if she could tell me what car she was in. She stated it was a 2014 Jeep Wrangler. Do you wear contacts or Glasses? She stated "no". What color is your eyes? She stated "Brown". How much do you weigh? She stated "126 pounds".

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What time do you think it is? She stated "6:50pm". It was 7:35pm. From a scale of 1-10 how impaired do you think you are? She stated "2".

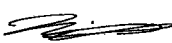
I asked her if she would be willing to do voluntary standardized field sobriety exercises (SFSE). She stated she did not want to do them. I advised her what the adverse consequences would be in not doing them. She still said she was not going to do them because she was so worked up from arguing with her boyfriend. I had Ms. Weissman step out of the vehicle where she walked to my car. While walking, Ms. Weissman had a hard time maintaining her balance, and I observed her stumble.

Therefore, based on the totality of the circumstances, at approximately 7:40pm I placed Ms. Weissman under arrest for DUI without incident. I then request for a female deputy to come to the scene to search her prior to transport. While waiting on a deputy Trooper Bradley Jones #1720 conducted a vehicle inventory where he showed me a water bottle that had a liquid with the odor commonly associated with wine.

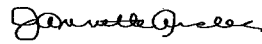
After clearing the scene, I transported Ms. Weissman to the Orange County Breath test center. After the 20-minute observation period, Ms. Weissman refused to provide a legal sample for her breath for testing. At approximately 10:16 pm, the implied consent warning was read to her. She indicated that she understood and still refused. Ms. Weissman was placed into the breath test center's holding cell while I completed the necessary probable cause affidavit. Upon completion, Ms. Weissman, was transported to the Orange County Jail for booking.

All events initially occurred in Orange County and ended in Osceola County Florida. All events were recorded by the video system outfitted on my marked issued patrol unit by the Florida highway patrol #0524.

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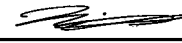
