PERSONAL CONTACT/DRIVING PATTERN/OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

On the above date and time, I responded to the area of 1000 N Congress Ave, City of Boynton Beach, Palm Beach County, FL, 33436 in reference to a traffic stop. Ofc Matlock ID 1154 of the Boynton Beach Police Department contacted me and advised that he conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle and the driver was exhibiting signs of impairment.

On arrival I spoke with Ofc Matlock who advised the following: Ofc Matlock was traveling southbound on Congress Ave at the intersection of Woolbright Rd when he observed a Black Jeep Wrangler made a northbound turn from Woolbright Rd to Congress Ave with no headlights activated (time of night was 23:25 PM). Ofc Matlock made a U-turn and attempted to catch to the vehicle, which was traveling north on Congress Ave at a high rate of speed. Ofc Matlock caught up with the vehicle and noticed the vehicle changing lanes, from the center to the right lane without signaling. The vehicle continued north on Congress Ave, when Ofc Matlock observed the vehicle swerving towards the sidewalk/bike lanes, two times. Based on his observation, Ofc Matlock conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle at the 1000 Block of N Congress Ave. I reviewed the dash cam from Ofc Matlock's vehicle (4976) which corroborated his statement. Video will be submitted in evidence.com.

Ofc Matlock advised that he made contact with the driver and sole occupant identified via her FL DL as W/F Allison Joy Berman. Ofc Matlock advised that she asked Berman for her driver license, proof of insurance and registration, and Allison provided her DL and kept showing her registration several times as her proof of insurance. Ofc Matlock advised that he immediately detected a strong odor of unknown alcohol beverage emitting from Berman's breath and her eyes were bloodshot red and glossy.

I approached Berman from the driver side of the vehicle, which was bearing PA tag: KCW0233 (2015 Jeep Wrangler), and confirmed her identity by showing her license. I immediately detected the extremely strong odor of unknown alcohol beverages emitting from her breath. Berman's eyes were extremely glossy and red bloodshot. I informed Berman the reason for the stop and informed that she was exhibiting signs of impairment. Berman stated she was at "Bru's Room" for dinner, where she also had only "1" shot of Vodka. Berman stated she did not feel intoxicated and felt ok to drive home at which time I asked her if she would agree to perform the SFST's to dispel my suspicion that she was intoxicated, which she agreed.

Berman was asked to exit her vehicle, at which time I observed her walking and drifting to the right, and unable to hold her balance.

Prior to the SFST's Berman advised she did not have any physical injuries that would prevent from performing the SFST's.

HGN: Berman had difficulty following the pen (red pen) and moved her heads twice.

WALK AND TURN:

Berman was walked to a well lit and level surface area, at which time I utilized a blue tape for the straight line. Berman confirmed the line appeared straight with no obstacle. The exercise was explained and demonstrated to Berman and she stated she understood. During the instruction phase, Berman stepped of the line and unable to maintain her balance 3 times.

During the walking phase, Berman missed heel to toe on every steps and took 12 steps both ways. Berman stepped off the line, used her arms for balance and made an improper turn.

ONE LEG STAND:

The exercise was explained and demonstrated to Berman and she stated she understood. The following clues were observed: Berman used her arms for balance , and put her foot down .

FINGER TO NOSE:

The exercise was explained and demonstrated to Berman and she stated she understood. Berman failed to return her arms to her side after every call.

ROMBERG/ALPHABET:

The exercise was explained to Berman and she stated she understood. Romberg was administered and Berman estimated 1 minute and 58 seconds when she was asked to estimate only 30 seconds.

Based on my investigation, Berman was arrested for driving under the influence of alcohol at 00:16 hrs (Handcuffed, D/L and checked for spacing) and was transported to the Palm Beach County BAT in my vehicle (905).

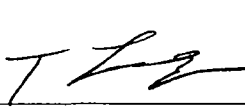
I arrived at the BAT at 00:47 hrs at which time I started my 20 minutes observation. Once completed, Berman was asked to provide samples of her breath for the purpose of determining the alcohol content and she agreed. Berman provided the 1st breath sample at 01:14 hrs for (.206) and the second sample at 01:17 hrs for (.201). Q/A's were not completed after Berman refused.

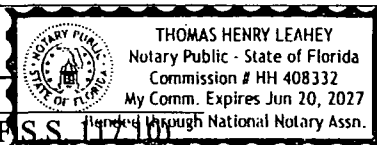

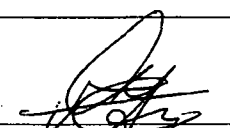
