P R O B A B L E	My department-issued body-worn camera was activated during this incident: On Friday, September 26, 2025, at approximately 2015 hours, I was dispatched to the area of SR-706 (W Indiantown Rd) and S Caloosahatchee Ave, Jupiter, FL 33458, in Palm Beach County, in reference to a vehicle crash that had just occurred. As I was responding, Northcom Dispatch advised that one of the involved vehicles was on fire. Upon my arrival, I saw a pickup truck bearing FL Tag CPC88, later identified as a 2020 Honda Ridgeline, on fire, facing south on the northbound travel lane of S Caloosahatchee Ave at the intersection of SR-706. A FL DHSMV record query was later performed, which showed the registrant as Andrew George Saporito (W/M 04/05/1976). I exited my patrol vehicle and immediately approached the driver's door of the Honda to ensure there were no occupants inside. Standing approximately 20 feet next to the driver's side of the Honda was a white male wearing black shorts, a white long-sleeve shirt, and black flip-flops. The white male was trying to buckle a harness on a gray colored Frenchie dog. The white male was later identified as Andrew George Saporito by his valid Florida Class E Driver's License. I asked Saporito if the Honda was his vehicle and if anybody else was in there. Saporito stated it was his car, and there was nobody else in it. Due to Saporito standing so close to the vehicle fire, I directed him to move away for his safety. Saporito continued to attempt to buckle the dog harness, but appeared to struggle with it. When Saporito spoke, I noticed his speech was slurred, and it appeared he was swaying in an orbital manner while bent over at his waist, attempting to buckle the dog harness. Due to Saporito not moving and me fearing for his safety, I picked up his dog and told him to follow me to the parking lot of PNC Bank, 1240 W Indiantown Rd. Once I relocated Saporito, I asked him for his driver's license. Ofc. DiTommaso ID# 1273 to stand by with Saporito while I located the driver of the other vehicle.

I later met with a Hispanic male who later verbally identified himself as Luis Enrique Diaz-Mendez (W/M 12/22/1998). Diaz-Mendez stated he was driving his black Toyota Corolla bearing FL Tag QWVS33 northbound on S Caloosahatchee Ave, approaching the stop sign for the intersection of SR-706. Diaz-Mendez said he saw Saporito's truck make a right turn onto S Caloosahatchee Ave from SR-706. As Saporito's truck was turning, it entered his lane of travel and crashed into the front of his vehicle. Diaz-Mendez said Saporito did not say anything to him and appeared more worried about his truck. While on scene, I saw Diaz-Mendez's Toyota facing northbound in the northbound travel lane with the airbags deployed. I returned to Saporito and attempted to gather information about the crash. While speaking to Saporito, I noticed his eyes were glossy, and I noticed the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from him, which intensified as he spoke. Saporito stated, "I pulled in, the guy blocked him, and that was it". I asked Saporito where he was coming from, and he stated he did not want to answer. Saporito then spontaneously uttered "I'm innocent" and "I'm so sorry." I read Saporito his Miranda Warning, which he stated he understood. Post Miranda Saporito said, "It's a lot to take in," while gesturing with his hand where his truck was. I asked Saporito if it was his truck, and he said, "Yeah," and I said, "It's on fire," and he said, "Yeah." I then told Saporito I was trying to figure out how the crash happened. Saporito said that a crash did not occur. While speaking with Saporito, I noticed he was swaying in an orbital manner, had slurred speech, and I could smell the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage, which intensified as he spoke. Due to the nature of the crash and the potential hazards of the vehicle hazard, I deemed it impractical to have Saporito perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tasks (SFSTs). As a result of what I had seen thus far, I placed Saporito under arrest for Driving Under the Influence. I secured his hands behind his back, which were checked for proper spacing and double-locked to prevent further tightening. I then escorted Saporito to the rear of my marked patrol vehicle and requested that Ofc. Popilek ID# 1280 to conduct a prisoner search of Saporito. I saw Ofc. Popilek remove a black Honda key fob from Saporito's pocket. I then placed Saporito in the rear prisoner seat of my patrol vehicle. Once Saporito was in my patrol vehicle, I immediately transported him to Jupiter Medical Center for medical clearance due to his involvement in the vehicle crash. While in the emergency room, I asked Saporito if he would submit to a lawful sample of his breath to determine the alcohol content, which he refused. I then read Saporito Implied Consent, which he stated he understood, and again refused to provide a lawful sample of his breath. Saporito was later medically cleared, and he was transported to the Jupiter Police Department, where he was placed in a holding cell while I completed the arrest paperwork. When I directed Saporito to standup from the hospital bed, I noticed a wet spot on the mattress and Saporito's shorts were wet as if he had urinated himself. While escorting Saporito out of the hospital, I noticed the strong odor of urine coming from Saporito which followed from the hospital room to the

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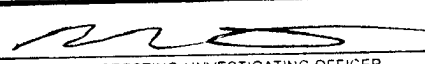

where my patrol vehicle was parked. While completing the arrest paperwork, a FLDHSMV query of Saporito's driving record revealed he had previously refused a chemical test on 05/07/2011, Citation Number 7922XDH in Palm Beach County, 04/12/2011, Citation Number 6831WCY in Palm Beach County, and 12/31/2004, Citation Number 6940ECG in Palm Beach County. I was later informed that Diaz-Mendez was transported to Jupiter Medical Center for an injury he sustained in the crash. I found probable cause to charge Andrew George Saporito with Driving Under the Influence Causing Property Damage/Personal Injury pursuant to FSS 316.193(3)(C)(1) and Refusal to Submit to Breath Test pursuant to FSS 316.1939(1).

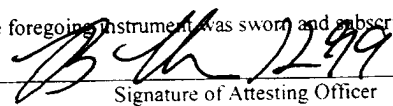
