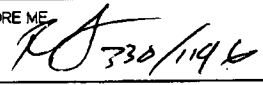

On Saturday, January 2, 2021 at about 1:41am, I responded to 251 S. U.S. Highway 1 unit 3 (Sunset Cigar Lounge) in reference to a Battery which just occurred. The caller, W/F Kelly J. Galindo (08-04-77) stated there was a male knocked out on the ground in front of the bar bleeding from the face. Galindo further told Northcomm Communications The suspect who struck the male on the ground was leaving in a white Toyota Camry with a Florida tag of AAA14. Galindo described the male who had struck the male as a white male wearing a light blue shirt and khaki shorts. The vehicle was seen northbound on U.S. Highway 1 near E. Indiantown Rd. As I approached the intersection of E. Indiantown Rd. and U.S. Highway 1, I noticed a white sedan driving northbound through the intersection. Ofc. R. Schneider (330) got behind the vehicle as it headed north through the intersection and saw its Florida tag of AAA14. As Ofc. Schneider and I were attempting to stop the white Toyota, Ofc. Lopez (325) was enroute to the scene at Sunset Cigar Lounge and Northcomm Communications were giving Galindo pre arrival instructions. Galindo told Northcomm communications the subject on the ground later identified as W/M Kevin J. Brown (10-27-59) was now awake. Ofc. Schnieder initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle. The vehicle stopped at 18275 N.A1A. Contact was made with the driver, W/M Jordan King (11-23-85) who was an UBER driver, and his two passengers in the back seat. The left rear passenger was W/M Mark Fenton(11-08-68) and the right rear passenger was W/M Anthony C. Clintlock (09-20-69). Clintlock was wearing a light blue sweatshirt and khaki shorts. I noticed Clintlock's hands were bloodied. I instructed Clintlock to exit the vehicle to which he complied. Clintlock was checked for weapons and placed into protective custody. Fenton was then instructed to exit the vehicle to which he complied. Fenton was checked for weapons. Fenton's hands appeared to be uninjured. I then spoke to Jordan.

Jordon told me he picked up Clintlock and Fenton from the Cigar Lounge, and he heard one of the passengers said he had been punched out of nowhere but they didn't know who they were fucking with and that they fucked that guy up. I then walked over to Clintlock. I told Clintlock was being detained until the details were sorted out. Clintlock said the guy punched him in the face and he fought back. I then drove to the Sunset Cigar Lounge. As I entered the parking lot, Palm Beach County Fire rescue was also arriving on scene. I made contact with Ofc. Lopez, who told me witnesses said Brown struck Clintlock first, and Brown was then beaten. I spoke to Galindo who was still on scene. Galindo said that all 3 subjects (Clintlock, Fenton, and Brown) were all intoxicated. Fenton and Clintlock were sitting on the outdoor chairs. Galindo said Brown was making fun of Clintlock and Fenton for being intoxicated, and they got into a verbal dispute. A few minutes later Brown punched Clintlock, and Clintlock and Fenton responded by pushing Brown away, causing Brown to fall to the ground. Galindo said when Brown fell to the ground he was not getting up or trying to fight. Galindo said Clintlock then repeatedly punched Brown while he was on the ground and had to be pulled off by other patrons. I transported Galindo to 18275 N.A1A. Clintlock was brought to the rear of Ofc. Schneiders's car. Galindo saw Clintlock from the backseat of my patrol vehicle and said "yes sir, that is him". I drove Galindo back to the scene and took a sworn statement from her regarding the incident, which was recorded with my body worn camera. Palm Beach County Fire rescue stated Brown was being transported to St. Mary's as a trauma alert. I eventually learned Brown's injuries were life threatening due to blood loss but was eventually brought to stable condition. Based upon the statement of Galindo, her identification of Clintlock as the person who repeatedly struck Brown when he was on the ground, and the injuries to Brown, probable cause exists that Clintlock committed Aggravated Battery causing bodily harm or disability contrary to Florida Statute 784.45(1) (a) (1). While at the Jupiter Police holding facility, a small ziplock bag containing a white substance fell from Clintlock's person. Through my training and experience the substance appeared to be Cocaine. I did not test the substance due to the risk of it containing Fentanyl. Based upon this, probable cause exists that Clintlock was in possession of Cocaine, contrary to Florida Statute 893.13.
