

I observed a gray 2020 Hyundai Veloster bearing FL/LQRY86 travelling North at 200 block of N. Congress Avenue with extremely dark window tint. I conducted a records check of the license plate which revealed that one of the registered owners of the vehicle had a suspended license (suspended on 3/23/2024). Due to the dark window tint, I was unable to identify if the driver of the vehicle was the registered owner with a suspended drivers license. I conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle which pulled over at the 600 block of N. Congress Ave. I made contact with the driver and sole occupant of the vehicle who was identified as W/F Barbara Nerestant by a Florida Drivers License that she had pulled from her wallet, which was located in a small black bag located on the front passenger seat. It should be noted that Barbara was not the registered owner with the suspended drivers license, and indeed had an active drivers license. While speaking to Barbara, I smelled the odor of burnt marijuana emanating from within the vehicle. I asked Barbara when the last time she had smoked marijuana in the vehicle and Barbara stated "earlier tonight, when I got off work". I asked Barbara if there was any marijuana in the vehicle, and Barbara stated "a little". At this time, Barbara was removed from the vehicle and stood by with my backup officer while I conducted a search on the vehicle.

A search of the vehicle was conducted which yielded the following items: located within the same black bag from the passenger seat that Barbara pulled her wallet from was two black plastic tubes with pop-open style tops. Within one tube was 4 orange in color oval shaped tablets with along with additional crushed up orange tablets. I placed the tubes on the roof of the vehicle when Barbara spontaneously uttered that she had Adderall. The second black plastic tube that was located within the black bag contained a small plastic baggie with a white powdery substance. Both tubes were collected and brought back to my patrol vehicle Officer Perez, who had been standing with Barbara, approached me and advised that Barbara had spontaneously uttered that she had cocaine in the vehicle. The tablets located within one of the black tubes was identified as 30mg Amphetamine/ Dexamphetamine tablets (brand named Adderall). The white powdery substance that was located within the second tube was field tested utilizing a #07 Scott Reagent field test, which yielded positive results for the presence of Cocaine. Both the Adderall and Cocaine were placed into my patrol vehicle and later turned into BBPD Evidence. The baggie of Cocaine weighed out to 0.56 grams.

During the investigation, I utilized a Laser Labs Enforcer 2 Tint Meter (SN 2024061023) to measure the drivers side front window, which measured at 04%.
Due to the above investigation, I find probable cause to charge Barbara Nerestant in accordance with F.S.S. 893.13(6)(A), Possession of Cocaine; and in accordance with F.S.S. 893.13(6)(a), Possession of a Controlled Substance (Adderall). Due to the windows of the vehicle being at 04%, Barbara also received a citation for illegal window tints. Barbara was transported to BBPD HQ for booking procedures, and later transported to Palm Beach County Jail.
