Probable Cause

On Saturday August 24th, 2024, at approximately 12:07 A.M, I, Trooper Aison Desuyo (ID #5157), was on routine patrol in a fully marked Florida Highway Patrol Agency Vehicle with painted insignia (FHP3464 VIN 2C3CDXATXPH646014 Calibration date 05/20/2024) traveling southbound on Interstate 95 (State Road 9), north of State Road 804 (Boynton Beach Blvd) when I observed a blue in color Mazda sedan displaying a Florida tag number of IK74ZH traveling in the center lane. As I was traveling behind the Mazda sedan, I observed the vehicle begin to change lanes to the right from the center lane to the outside lane with no right turn signal utilized. I then observed the Mazda sedan begin to accelerate at which point I accelerated behind the vehicle and visually estimated the Mazda sedan to be traveling at 80 Miles Per Hour (MPH) in a posted 65 MPH speed limit zone. I was then able to successfully pace clock the Mazda sedan with my patrol vehicle at 83 MPH in a posted 65 MPH speed limit zone. I then observed the Mazda sedan change lanes to the right to exit on to State Road 804, at which point I then activated my emergency blue lights and sirens to conduct a traffic stop on the vehicle. The Mazda sedan was slow to respond to my blue lights and sirens, however, eventually came to a stop on the right outside shoulder. I then exited my patrol vehicle and approached the driver side of the vehicle.

Upon my initial interaction with the driver (who was identified by his Florida driver's license J250063901900 as Bradley Clark Jackson with a DOB of 05/30/1990), I observed his eyes to be glassy and watery, and there was an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from within the vehicle. I then advised Mr. Jackson the reason for the stop (speed and not utilizing the proper turn signal when

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changing direction) and asked where he was coming from. He advised he was coming from the Palm Beach County Fairgrounds. I asked him where he was going. He stated he was going to his residence. While Mr. Jackson spoke to me, I was able to detect an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath. I asked Mr. Jackson if he consumed any alcoholic beverages before driving. He stated he did. I asked him how many alcoholic beverages he consumed. He stated he consumed two alcoholic beverages at approximately 6:30 PM. I then asked Mr. Jackson to exit his vehicle. Mr. Jackson complied and stepped out the vehicle. I asked him how long ago did he leave the Palm Beach County Fairgrounds. He stated approximately two and a half hours ago. I asked him what time did he consume his final alcoholic beverage. He advised approximately two hours ago. I asked him what kind of alcoholic beverage he consumed. He stated a Vodka Soda. I asked him how much Vodka was in the drink he was given at the Fairgrounds. He stated approximately a double shot of Vodka. I asked how many Vodka Sodas he consumed. He stated he consumed two Vodka Sodas. I asked him if that would be approximately four shots of Vodka. He stated yes approximately. I asked Mr. Jackson if he would be willing to perform the voluntary Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises (SFSE's) to make sure he was safe to drive. He stated he was willing to perform the voluntary Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises. I asked him if he was willing to be relocated to a safer location to perform the voluntary Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises. He stated he was willing to be relocated. Mr. Jackson was then relocated to the Chevron gas station (located at 645 W Boynton Beach Blvd) to perform the exercises.

Each exercise was explained and demonstrated prior to the defendant performing.

The following exercises were conducted with the corresponding clues of impairment listed below:

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN) (Blue stimulus light pen used)

- Equal size pupil observed in both eyes
- Equal tracking with both eyes
- Lack of Smooth Pursuit observed in both eyes
- I observed distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes

It should be noted that Mr. Jackson had to be reminded to keep his head straight and to follow the stimulus with his eyes only.

Walk and Turn Exercise (A yellow marked line was utilized during the exercise in a level surface free from any debris).

- Fails to maintain starting position

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- Starts too soon (1 time)
- Missed heel-to-toe steps (5 walking forward, 4 walking back)
- Steps off the line (2 times walking forward, 1 time walking back)
- Incorrect number of steps (8 steps walking forward)
- Improper Turn

One Leg Stand (A watch was used to count the 30 seconds.) Left Leg raised.

Right Leg-

- Sways to the left
- Uses arms for balance (raised left arm more than six inches from sides)

It should be noted that Mr. Jackson did not raise his foot 6 inches above the ground.

Based on the evidenced collected though my investigation and the totality of the circumstances, I determined that there was probable cause to believe that Mr. Jackson committed the offense of driving under the influence and by being in actual physical control of the vehicle while under the influence of alcohol, and or any chemical substance, and or any controlled substance while his normal faculties were impaired.

The defendant was placed under arrest for DUI at 00:29 A.M. He was then placed into an FHP marked patrol vehicle. The Mazda sedan was towed from the location of the stop by Zucalla's Towing. All items within the vehicle were inventoried and documented accordingly by me. While inventorying the vehicle, a High Noon Vodka Seltzer (Raspberry Flavored) was located on the floorboard behind the driver seat inside a box of a dozen High Noon Vodka Seltzer's. Two of the cans inside the box were removed, one being the open container that still contained a little bit of clear liquid that emitted an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage. The defendant was then transported to the Palm Beach County Breath Alcohol Testing (BAT) facility. At the BAT facility, a 20-minute observation period was conducted by me where he did not ingest anything by mouth or regurgitate (mouth was confirmed to be empty prior to beginning of the observation period). Mr. Jackson was then taken to the Intoxilyzer room where he was asked to provide a breath sample to determine the level of alcoholic content within his body. Mr. Jackson asked what happens if this is his second refusal. Florida Implied Consent was read and explained. I asked Mr. Jackson if he understood Florida Implied Consent. Mr. Jackson advised he understood Florida Implied Consent. I asked Mr. Jackson if he still refused. Mr. Jackson still refused to provide a breath sample.

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Mr. Jackson was then booked into the Palm Beach County Jail without further incident and charged with the following:

Violation of F.S.S 316.193(1) – DUI Alcohol or Drugs

Violation of F.S.S 316.187(2)(b) – Unlawful Speed 65 Highway/ Turnpike

Violation of F.S.S 316.1939(1) – Refusal to submit to breath test (2nd or subsequent offense)

All the above events occurred within Palm Beach County, State of Florida.

The incident was recorded with my In-Car Camera (FHP3464) which will be made available upon request.

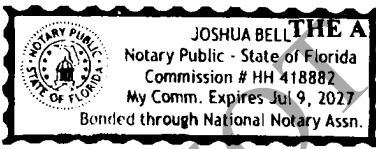
