C A U S E	On 09/04/2025 at approximately 2342 hours, I responded to the area of Duncombe Drive and Ramsey Way in reference to a possible domestic disturbance. The caller advised that a male and a female had just parked a white car in front of his residence and now were standing outside of the vehicle arguing. He further advised that another male showed up and was holding a drink in his hand.									
	Just prior to my arrival, I was flagged down on Islamorada Drive and Ramsey Way by two males matching the description given, later identified as Kevin Langton (W/M 8/19/81) and Ryan Mullen (W/M 04/12/1995). Mullen began to inform me that he and his girlfriend had been arguing, however before I could get further information, I observed a white female walking down the street in our direction. The female, later identified as Breanna Spada (W/F 10/17/1997), was yelling unintelligibly towards Mullen and Langton. Mullen informed me that that was his girlfriend. I advised Mullen and Langton to wait by my patrol vehicle while I spoke with her.									
	Upon making contact with Spada, I observed her eyes were extremely bloodshot and glassy and she had the strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from her breath. She swayed while she stood and slurred her words heavily as she spoke with me. Her movements were slow and sluggish. I inquired as to what had occurred prior to my arrival, but Spada kept saying that she "just came here." I asked here where she came from but she could not give me a consistent answer. I asked Spada why she was upset and she said she was upset because it was an hour and a half later and I asked what she meant and she again said she just came here. I asked her where she came from and she said the bar. I asked her if she had been arguing with Mullen and Langton and she said she had not been. When I again asked her why she was upset she responded by saying it had been two and a half hours. She eventually advised that she had at some point been in a verbal argument with her boyfriend, Mullen, but could not give a straight answer as to when. Throughout our conversation, I had difficulty understanding what Spada was

<p>trying to say and she answered my questions in ways that did not necessarily make sense. During our conversation she dropped her drivers license which had been in her hand and nearly fell over while trying to pick it up.</p> <p>I requested Spada to side on a nearby curb while I spoke again with Mullen and Langton. Mullen made the following sworn statement: Spada, Langton and himself had gone down to a local bar earlier in the night. After, Mullen drove the three of them back to his residence nearby where we were. Spada and Mullen began to argue as Spada was insisting on driving home and Mullen was trying to prevent it due to her intoxicated state. Spada was eventually able to get into her vehicle, a white Nissan (FL IW78GU), despite Mullens attempts to stop her. Spada drove off and Mullen began to run after her. A short time later, while walking in the direction Spada had driven off in, he heard her talking and followed the sound of her voice. Mullen saw that Spada had crashed her vehicle into a tree on Wymberly Drive just south of Dakota Drive. Mullen tried to get Spada out of the driver's seat, however he could not get the door open properly. Mullen ran back to his house to get help from Langton. They both went back to the vehicle and Langton was eventually able to get Spada out of the driver's seat. Langton drove the vehicle back towards Mullen's house and parked it. Shortly after is when I arrived and found them. Prior to the crash the three of them had been out at a nearby bar where Spada had been consuming alcoholic beverages. Mullen could not advise how many she had, but did say that she was more intoxicated that she normally allows herself to become. The crash had occurred approximately 30 minutes prior to my arrival.</p> <p>Langton made the following Sworn statement: Mullen had come back to the house and said that Spada had crashed. They both went back to the car and Spada was still sitting in the driver's seat. They were eventually able to get her out of the driver's seat and attempted to talk her down as she was still upset.</p> <p>I spoke again with Spada to ask her about the crash. She advised that she had crashed her car but then became argumentative and said that she hit a tree so it was not a car crash. I asked her where the crash happened and she pointed in the opposite direction of where it had occurred. She then said she had not been in a crash. She became argumentative and said that I had been with her at the car during the crash and that I should know what happened. She refused to answer any further questions about the crash other then several statements that did not make any sense. I advised Spada that I was going to be conducting a criminal DUI investigation and she became agitated and began insisting that I had been at the car accident despite me telling her that I had not been. I read Spada Miranda Warnings which she advised she understood.</p> <p>I requested Spada submit to the Standardized Field Sobriety Tasks which she agreed to.</p> <p>The first task was the Horizontal Gaze nystagmus. Spada swayed while standing. I observed lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes. I observed distinct and sustained</p>



<p>nystagmus at maximum deviation in the left eye. I was unable to check her right eye due to Spada being unable to keep her head still. I gave Spada several attempts at the task, however she was argumentative throughout the entire task and would not allow me to complete it. She was unable to keep her head still and kept trying to talk and laugh during the task. I advised her of Taylor warnings, but she continued to argue with me during every attempt to complete the task. I eventually asked her to move on to the next task.</p> <p>The second task was the walk and turn. Spada was unable to get into the starting position. She began walking before I was able to read her the instructions. I instructed her to wait until I read her the instructions to begin and asked her to get back into the starting position, which she could not hold for more than a few seconds. Spada interrupted me several times while I attempted to explain the task. Once I finished my explanation, I asked if she understood, which she stated she did and did not have any questions. Spada took 11 steps up the line. She missed heel to toe on steps 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 10, and 11. She fell completely off the line on steps 4, 5, 6, and 11. After her 11th step she walked entirely off the line, turned to face me, shrugged and said something unintelligible. She did not attempt to walk back down the line. Spada did not count her steps out loud and held her arms out for balance.</p> <p>The third task was the one leg stand. Spada continued to interrupt me during my instructions and tried to begin prior to me completing the instructions. She lifted her leg up and then almost fell backwards. I completed my instructions and advised her to return to the starting position. I asked her if she needed me to explain the instructions again, to which she stated she understood and did not want another explanation. She stated that she understood she could not complete the task but advised she would continue. Spada could not hold her leg up for more then a few seconds at a time. She put her foot down three times and on the third time, approximately 15 seconds into the task, she did not pick it back up again. Spada used her arms for balance and did not count out loud. Part way through the task, she began to complain that she could not do it.</p> <p>The fourth task was the finger to nose. Spada continued to interrupt me while I explained the task to her. Once I finished my explanation, she advised that she understood and had no questions. When I called left there was a delay, before she touched the pad of her finger to the bottom of her nose. She then asked if she was supposed to put her finger back down which I advised she should. I called right and she placed the tip of her finger under her nose near the nostril. I called left and she began to raise her right hand, before correcting and using her left finger to touch the left side of her nose. I called right and she raised her left hand up to make an L before raising her right hand and began to make hand signs while saying she would make an "R" from her finger. She did not attempt to touch her nose. I called right again to ensure she heard me but she did not acknowledge it. Once she put her hand down, I called</p>

I called left and with an open hand she touched her left index finger to the bottom of her nose.</p> <p>The third task was the Romberg alphabet. Spada continued to interrupt and argue with me while I attempted to explain the instruction and get her into the starting position. She would not allow me to finish the explanation before she began to say the alphabet in the following manner: "A B C D E F G F A B C D F I G." She then stopped and became argumentative again.</p> <p>Based on my investigation, observations, and totality of circumstances, probable cause was established to believe that Spada was in actual physical control of a vehicle while under the influence of an alcoholic beverage, chemical, or controlled substance, to the point where her normal faculties were impaired contrary to F.S 316.193. She was placed into handcuffs which were properly spaced and double-locked and placed into the rear of my patrol car at 0042 hours.</p> <p>At 0046 hours I asked Spada if she would submit to a lawful test of her breath for the purpose of determining the alcohol content. She refused and was read implied-consent from a pre-printed template. She continued to state that she would refuse to take any kind of breathalyzer.</p> <p>Spada was transported to JMC for medical clearance. She was then transported to The Jupiter Police Department and then transported to County Jail without incident.</p> <p>Officer Sales-Lopez completed the crash investigation. He advised that the damage was only to her vehicle and the tree that she had struck did not have any lasting damage to it. During a vehicle inventory, 3.5g of FTP marijuana was located and turned into evidence for destruction due to no name labeled on container. The vehicle was towed by all hooked up.</p> <p>The incident was captured on my BWC. The above narrative is a summary of the events that took place and not purported to be verbatim.</p>

I requested that the driver submit to a **BREATH** test for the purpose of determining its alcohol content.
