**Probable Cause**

On Friday April 07, 2023 at approximately 12:45am, I was on routine patrol on southbound Interstate 95 (State Road 9) approaching Belvedere Road. I observed a black Lexus Nx (attached New York Tag: JPU4305) traveling in lane 3 traveling approximately 83mph in a 65mph posted speed limit. The black Lexus Nx was pace clocked by my marked patrol vehicle FHP 2047. The vehicle calibration will be provided upon request. The black Lexus Nx then left lane 3 and changed over to lane 4 and 5. The black Lexus Nx would be seen straddling between lane 4 and 5. While still observing the black Lexus Nx, I would see it changing over to lane 4. The black Lexus Nx would then change over to lane 5 and began slow down abruptly to approximately 41mph with no vehicle in front. The black Lexus Nx would then accelerate at a high rate of speed changing over to lane 4. While traveling in lane 4 can be seen straddling within its lane. At one point the black Lexus Nx rear left tire can be seen touching the white line separating lane 3 and lane 4. A vehicle in lane 3 can be braking and swerving to the left to avoid a collision with the black Lexus Nx. The black Lexus would then follow a vehicle ahead closely as you can see the black Lexus Nx brake lights activated on and off. The black Lexus Nx would then be seen changing over to lane 3 and traveling at 102mph. The black Lexus Nx then left lane 3 and went over lane 4. The black Lexus Nx then began to follow the vehicle in front of her closely as the brake light would activate multiple time. The black Lexus Nx would then be seen while in lane 4, without using its turning signal, change from lane 4 into lane 3. Failing to observe lane 3, the black Lexus Nx, almost collided with the vehicle who was traveling in lane 3. I then got behind the black Lexus Nx and activated my emergency lights and sirens to conduct a traffic stop on the vehicle. The driver pulled over to the right outside shoulder on southbound Interstate 95 Forest Hill Boulevard, while partially on the far-right lane. I approached the passenger side window and spoke to the driver through the open window. I smelled a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the interior of the vehicle. I spoke to the driver who was later identified by her Florida driver's license as Cailey Mary Smith (FL DL: S530113958390), through FCIC/NCIC. Ms. Smith later stated that the correct tag belonging to the vehicle was a FI Tag # BD18PG, as she handed me the correct tag.

Ms. Smith was observed to have red and glassy eyes. I began to question her and asked where she was coming from. Ms. Smith stated that she was coming from Jenson Beach and Stuart with a group of friends. I asked Ms. Smith if she had anything to drink and she advised that she had white wine two hours ago. While on my traffic stop, a white male was seen walking on the Interstate towards me. I then asked Ms. Smith to turn off her vehicle and as her for her car keys. The white male would soon be identified as I called for a second unit to transport the white male off the Interstate. As the second unit came on scene, the white male was transported off the Interstate as I continued my DUI Investigation with Ms. Smith. I then asked Ms. Smith if she was willing to perform voluntary field sobriety roadside exercise to determine whether she is impaired or not, and she did not agree to do so. I then advised

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Ms. Smith of her Taylor warnings and explained to her that if she is not willing to conduct voluntarily field sobriety exercise to determine whether she was driving impaired, I will have no choice but to go off her driving pattern and the strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from her breathe. I then advised Ms. Smith my decision would be based on the totality of the circumstances. Ms. Smith was then read her Taylor warning a second time and she stated that she understands and voluntarily agreed to perform field sobriety exercise. Ms. Smith agree to relocating off the Interstate to perform voluntary field sobriety roadside exercises. I placed Ms. Smith in my marked patrol vehicle and transported her off the Interstate and the Dunkin's Donut shopping plaza on 10th Avenue just west of Interstate 95.

Prior to the administration of the exercises I asked her if she wore glasses or contacts and she stated that she wore glasses but didn't have them on. (Note: The summary below is not intended to be a verbatim account of all the events that took place during the administration of the standardized field sobriety exercises. Video footage and audio is available upon request). Each exercise was explained and demonstrated prior to the subject attempting to perform the exercises. She acknowledged that she understood the instructions.

**Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus Exercise (pen was used as a contrasting stimulus)**

- I checked for resting nystagmus which was not observed in either eye
- I checked for equal pupil size and equal tracking; Both pupils were equal in size and both eyes tracked the stimulus equally.
- I did observed a lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes
- I did observed horizontal gaze nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes
- I did observe horizontal gaze nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in either eye
- I did not observe vertical gaze nystagmus in either eye

**Walk and Turn Exercise (Yellow tape in the parking lot was utilized during the exercise)**

**Clues:**

- Unable to stay in the starting position
- Did not walk heel to toe distinctly on multiple occasions
- Use arms to balance
- Starts too soon
- Improper turn (turns right instead of left)

**Notes:**

- Conducted the exercise two times

**One Leg Stand Exercise (Right Leg)**

**Clues:**

- Use arms to balance

**Note:**

- Did not count out loud

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-Bend leg

Based upon the performance of the above exercises and the totality of the circumstances I determined that there was probable cause to believe that Cailey Mary Smith committed the offense of driving under the influence by being in actual physical control/operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcoholic beverages, any chemical substance per Florida State Statute 877.111, or any controlled substance per Chapter 893, while their normal faculties were impaired. She was placed under arrest at approximately 1:25am for the above offense and handcuffed behind her back. Deputy Francis (20627) of the Palm Beach County Sherriff Office searched Ms. Smith. She was later transported to the Palm Beach County Breath Alcohol Testing (BAT) Facility at approximately 1:54am. At the BAT facility a 20 minute observation period was conducted where the defendant did not ingest anything by mouth or regurgitate (mouth was confirmed to be empty prior to the beginning of the observation period). She was then asked to provide a breath test sample to test for the alcoholic content of her breath. She agreed to provide the breath test samples. She provided a first breath test sample of 0.173 and a second breath test sample of 0.164. She was then read her constitutional rights from a prepared document and she stated that she understood her rights. See BAT video footage for a complete account of the breath test administration. Ms. Smith was issued a DUI citation along with a uniform traffic of failure to maintain a single lane, excessive speed, following to closely, improper tag display, proof of insurance and driver license not carried.

The black Lexus Nx was towed by Priority Towing. She was booked without incident. All of the above events occurred in Palm Beach County, FL.


