Probable Cause

On Thursday, September 19th, 2024, at approximately 02:26 A.M, I, Trooper Aison Desuyo (ID #5157), was dispatched by the Lake Worth Regional Communication Center (LWRCC) to a two vehicle traffic crash on northbound Interstate 95 (State Road 9), south of State Road 798 (Palmetto Park Road), involving a red in color commercial motor vehicle displaying a Tennessee tag number of P8461HY with a trailer attached that was displaying a Tennessee tag number of U483607 and a gray in color Kia SUV (Sport Utility Vehicle) that was displaying a Florida tag number of PYJG08. Upon my arrival (at 02:47 A.M), I observed the gray Kia SUV and the Commercial Motor Vehicle stopped on the right outside shoulder. I observed the driver of the Kia SUV in the driver's seat of the vehicle and the driver of the Commercial Motor Vehicle to be standing on the right outside shoulder in front of the Kia SUV. I then approached the driver of the Kia SUV (who was later identified by her Florida driver's license L536100855960 as Camila Landeiro Borges with a DOB of 03/16/1985).

It should be noted that prior to my contact with Ms. Landeiro Borges, I asked the Boca Raton Fire Rescue Personnel if they already evaluated Ms. Landeiro Borges, to which they advised me that Ms. Landeiro Borges refused medical treatment on scene. I observed Ms. Landeiro Borges as the sole occupant of the vehicle, sitting in the driver's seat of the Kia SUV behind the wheel of the vehicle with the vehicle off, however, the vehicle was a push to start and the key fob that is required to activate the vehicle was inside her purse. Ms. Landeiro Borges' purse that contained the key fob to the Kia SUV was in her immediate vicinity, sitting in the center console area right next to her.

Upon my initial contact with Ms. Landeiro Borges, I observed her eyes to be glassy and watery, and there was a slight odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from within the vehicle. I asked her if she was injured from the collision. She advised she was not. I then spoke to Ms. Landeiro Borges in reference to the traffic crash. Ms. Landeiro Borges advised me she was traveling northbound on Interstate 95, however, she was unable to advise me which lane. Ms. Landeiro Borges stated that as she was traveling straight ahead, the front portion of her vehicle collided with the rear portion of the trailer of the Commercial Motor Vehicle that was traveling in front of her. Ms. Landeiro Borges then advised me she stopped on the right outside shoulder and began requesting assistance. I asked Ms. Landeiro Borges where she was coming from, to which she replied south.

After speaking with Ms. Landeiro Borges, I then approached the driver of the Commercial Motor Vehicle (who was identified by his Georgia driver's license as Stephen Mccauley with a DOB of 02/13/1995). I began speaking with Mr. Mccauley in reference to the traffic crash. Mr. Mccauley advised me that as he was traveling northbound on Interstate 95 in the outside lane of the general-

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purpose lanes, he felt an impact to the rear portion of his trailer, then felt a second impact immediately after the first impact. Mr. Mccauley then advised me that he then pulled over to the right outside shoulder where he discovered the Kia SUV just south of his Commercial Motor Vehicle with damage to the front portion that was consistent with a traffic crash. Mr. Mccauley was also able to place Ms. Landeiro Borges behind the wheel of the Kia SUV and provided a written witness statement to me that supported this.

My traffic crash investigation concluded that the Kia SUV was traveling in the outside lane of the general-purpose lanes, and Ms. Landeiro Borges failed to maintain a safe following distance behind the Commercial Motor Vehicle, resulting in the front portion of the Kia SUV to collide with the rear portion of the trailer attached to the Commercial Motor Vehicle. I then advised Ms. Landeiro Borges that I was now concluding my traffic crash investigation and would be conducting a criminal investigation for DUI (Driving while Under the Influence). I asked her if she understood. She advised me she did. I then advised Ms. Landeiro Borges of her Miranda Warning rights. I asked Ms. Landeiro Borges if she understood her Miranda Warning rights. She advised she did. I asked her if she was still willing to speak with me. She advised she was. I asked Ms. Landeiro Borges where she was coming from. She advised she was coming from south. I asked her if she was driving at the time of the crash. She stated she was. I asked her if she was the sole occupant of the vehicle. She stated she was. I asked Ms. Landeiro Borges if she consumed any alcoholic beverages before driving. She stated she was on a strict diet as she was a body builder, so she was unable to drink. I asked Ms. Landeiro Borges when was the last time she consumed an alcoholic beverage. She advised me she did not know. I asked Ms. Landeiro Borges how long she was driving before the crash occurred. She stated approximately 30 minutes. While Ms. Landeiro Borges spoke to me, I was able to detect an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from her breath. I asked Ms. Landeiro if she was willing to perform the voluntary Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises to make sure she was safe to drive. Ms. Landeiro Borges advised she was. I advised her that due to the degraded slope of the outside shoulder and the wet surface, I offered Ms. Landeiro Borges the opportunity to relocate to a nearby parking lot where it was a dry and level surface. Mr. [REDACTED] advised she was fine performing the exercises on the right outside shoulder.

The SFSE's were conducted on the right outside shoulder where it was the flattest available surface and well-lit from the street lights and my patrol vehicle's white lights.

Each exercise was explained and demonstrated prior to the defendant performing.

The following exercises were conducted with the corresponding clues of impairment listed below:

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN) (Blue stimulus light pen used)

- Equal size pupil observed in both eyes

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- Equal tracking with both eyes
- Lack of Smooth Pursuit observed in both eyes
- I observed distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes
- I observed onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in both eyes

Walk and Turn Exercise (A yellow marked line was utilized during the exercise on a surface free from any debris).

- Fails to maintain starting position
- Missed heel-to-toe steps (3 times walking forward, 6 times walking back)
- Steps off the line (2 times walking forward, 2 times walking back)
- Incorrect number of steps (10 steps walking forward, 8 steps walking back)
- Improper Turn

It should be noted that there was a difficulty placing the yellow tape down due to the wet surface, however, I was able to locate two dry portions on the right outside shoulder where I placed both ends of the yellow tape on to hold it down. It should also be noted that while Ms. Landeiro Borges performed the exercise, the yellow tape was not removed from the surface.

One Leg Stand (A watch was used to count the 30 seconds.) Left Leg raised.

Right Leg-

- Sways to the right and left
- Puts foot down (4 times)
- Uses arms for balance (Raises arms more than six inches from sides)

Based on the evidenced collected though my investigation and the totality of the circumstances, I determined that there was probable cause to believe that Ms. Landeiro Borges committed the offense of driving under the influence and by being in actual physical control of the vehicle while under the influence of alcohol, and or any chemical substance, and or any controlled substance while her normal

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faculties were impaired.

The defendant was placed under arrest for DUI at 03:44 A.M. She was then placed into an FHP marked patrol vehicle. The Kia SUV was towed from the location of the stop by Emerald's Towing. All items within the vehicle were inventoried and documented accordingly by me. The defendant was then transported to the Palm Beach County Breath Alcohol Testing (BAT) facility. At the BAT facility, a 20-minute observation period was conducted by me where she did not ingest anything by mouth or regurgitate (mouth was confirmed to be empty prior to beginning of the observation period). Ms. Landeiro Borges was then taken to the Intoxilyzer room where she was asked to provide a breath sample to determine the level of alcoholic content within her body. Ms. Landeiro Borges refused. Florida Implied Consent was read. I asked Ms. Landeiro Borges if she understood Florida Implied Consent. Ms. Landeiro Borges advised she understood Florida Implied Consent. I asked Ms. Landeiro Borges if she still refused. Ms. Landeiro Borges advised she still refused to provide a breath sample.

Ms. Landeiro Borges was then transported by to the Good Samaritan Hospital (located at 5208 Okeechobee Blvd) in reference to medical clearance. Following her medical clearance, Ms. Landeiro Borges was transported back to the Palm Beach County Jail where she was then booked without further incident and charged with the following:

Violation of F.S.S 316.193(1) – DUI Alcohol or Drugs

Violation of F.S.S 316.1925 – Careless Driving

All the above events occurred within Palm Beach County, State of Florida.

The incident was recorded with my In-Car Camera (FHP0778) which will be made available upon request.



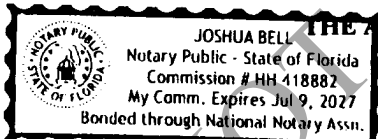
