 On the 9 day of June, 2023 at 04:11 (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

At approximately 02:36 hours on 06/09/2023, I was conducting patrol at 1501 W Frederick Small Rd (Jupiter Skate Park). My fully marked Jupiter Police patrol vehicle was parked at the entrance facing Stadium Dr. I observed a silver Toyota traveling northbound on Stadium Dr. The silver Toyota turned westbound on W Frederick Small Rd and while making that turn it drove over the white stop bar of the eastbound left turn lane and both solid yellow lines then corrected itself into the westbound lane. I began traveling westbound on W Frederick Small Rd and observed the silver Toyota bearing FL tag AX05MN facing westbound in the eastbound lane dropping a female passenger off just east of Parkside Dr.

I conducted a traffic stop on the aforementioned vehicle and came in contact with the driver and later found to be the offender, Chandler Andrew Pinkerton; W/M; 07/13/1994. I asked Pinkerton for his ID, registration, and insurance. While waiting for Pinkerton to find the documents I smelled an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from inside the vehicle. I asked Pinkerton where he was coming from tonight and he advised he was at a friend's house watching the Panthers game. Pinkerton had difficulty finding his insurance and registration, while looking he was fumbling around and dropped his phone under his seat. Pinkerton asked if he could get out of his vehicle to get the cell phone and I advised him he could. When he stepped out of his vehicle he was unsteady on his feet and dropped his vape he forgot was on his lap. I asked him again where he was watching the Panthers game and he said his friend's house. While I was speaking to Pinkerton outside of the vehicle I smelled an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming directly from his breath. I asked him how much he had to drink tonight and he stated "Nothing. Zero. I'm dead serious." I then asked him if the passenger had anything to drink tonight, Pinkerton advised she did have drinks. I am familiar with vehicles having an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from them if passengers inside the vehicle have been drinking. The female passenger had exited the vehicle just before I conducted the traffic stop. Once again I determined I smelled an odor of an unknown

alcoholic beverage coming from Pinkerton's breath which intensified as he spoke. Pinkerton was scrolling through his photos on his phone and asked "Do you mind if I call my mom?" I believe he wanted his mom to help him find his insurance even though Pinkerton is the registered owner of the vehicle. When I was conversing with Pinkerton he slurred his words. I asked him if he was only at his friend's house tonight and he said "I was literally two blocks down". Pinkerton had a paper wristband on and I asked where it was from, he said he picked his friends up from Johnny Mangos but he had to go inside. I asked Pinkerton if he was sure he didn't drink anything and he said "No, no I swear."

Based on my observations I asked Pinkerton if he would perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tasks so I know he would be safe to drive home. Pinkerton consented to perform the tasks.

As a result of the Standardized Field Sobriety Tasks, Pinkerton gave me many clues that indicated impairment (see DUI probable cause affidavit for further information regarding specific indicators of impairment).

I placed Pinkerton under arrest, placed handcuffs on him, checked for proper spacing, and double-locked them.


After I placed Pinkerton under arrest I asked him again how much he had to drink because he told Officer Gonzalez he was at the baseball game as well. Pinkerton advised he had 5 beers. I then placed Pinkerton in the back right seat of my patrol vehicle.

After placing Pinkerton under arrest, I requested at roadside that he provide a lawful sample of his breath for the purpose of determining the alcohol content. Pinkerton became argumentative and advised he would not answer questions or provide a sample of his breath. I advised Pinkerton of Implied Consent, and Pinkerton confirmed he understood. Pinkerton refused to provide a sample of his breath at 03:03 hours.

Pinkerton was charged with driving under the influence, normal faculties impaired pursuant to Florida State Statute 316.193(1) (A).

Pinkerton was transported to The Jupiter Police Department for booking and processing. He was then transported to Palm Beach County Jail without incident.

My department-issued Axon BWC was activated during the above investigation.

Additionally, if you refuse to take the test I have requested of you, and if your driving privilege has been previously suspended, or if you have been previously fined under s. 327.35215, for a refusal to submit to a lawful test of your breath, urine, or blood, you will be committing a misdemeanor, in addition to any other penalties which can be imposed by law. Refusal to submit to the test I have requested is admissible into evidence in any criminal proceeding.
