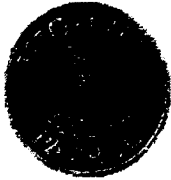

Probable Cause

On Friday June 16th, 2023 at approximately 12:48am I was conducting routine patrol in my fully marked Florida Highway Patrol vehicle (#0555/ Vin #2C3DXAT9KH609108). I was traveling northbound on N Dixie Highway (State Road 5) just south of Waterway Dr. S.

As I was approaching Waterway Dr. S in the outside lane, I observed a dark colored SUV pass by me in the inside lane to my right at a high rate of speed. I visually estimated the dark SUV to be traveling at 50mph in a posted 35mph zone. At this time, we were approaching 18th Ave S. Note: At 18th Ave. Note: N Dixie highway splits left and right into S Dixie Highway (State Road 805) and S Federal Highway (State Road 5).

The Dark SUV changed lanes from the inside lane to the outside lane placing itself between myself and another vehicle who were continuing right onto State Road 5 which turns into a single lane road. The dark SUV tailgated the vehicle in front of him while failing to maintain his lane to the left. Note: (At this time the left lane was actually and oncoming traffic lane, both lanes are separated by 2 solid yellow traffic control line) Once the vehicle in front of the dark colored SUV turned off the roadway, the SUV picked up in speed. I was able to retrieve a steady pace clock of the dark SUV at 58mph. While attempting to retrieve a pace clock the SUV failed to maintain its lane again to the left while crossing both solid yellow lines putting its drivers side wheels in the oncoming traffic lane. At this time, I activated my emergency lights and sirens and conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle. Instead of pulling off the roadway the SUV came to a controlled stop in the middle of the lane just north of 12th Ave S.

While I was initially behind the SUV I was able to enter the attached New Hampshire tag #PKM into NCIC/FCIC which came back to a dark blue 2015 Cadillac SRX registered to a Priscilla Marie Mc Innis out of New Hampshire. I approached the on the driver's side and explained the driver the reason for the stop. I immediately asked him why he was driving in the manner that he was. The driver did not have any idea as to how he was driving. I asked him if he knew what the speed limit was, he stated that he didn't know. He stated that he thought the speed limit was 35mph, however he passed a posted 35mph sign that was posted on the right side of the roadway prior. He had no clear understanding that he failed to maintain his lane into an oncoming traffic lane and that he was driving 23mph over the posted speed limit. It's important to note that while speaking with the driver I could immediately smell an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from within the vehicle. I also observed that his eyes appeared blood shot and glassy. The driver spoke with a very slow, quiet and slightly slurred/mumbled speech. He seemed to have a difficult time understanding basic questions and displayed a very slow response time. I asked the driver if he had anything to drink tonight, he stated no. I explained to him that I can smell the odor of alcohol and based on his driving pattern I do not believe that to be true. I asked the driver where he was coming from, he stated from Delray. I then asked him if he had his drivers license and registration for the vehicle, he handed his driver's license. He then lethargically reached over to the passenger glove box and retrieved the registration which was a small blue booklet containing numerous miscellaneous papers. He then handed it to me while looking at me

with a blank stare. I stated, that does not look like a registration and asked if he could open the small booklet and find it for me, which he did. I then returned to my patrol vehicle to verify the information that I was provided. I was able to identify the driver by Florida driver's license as Christopher Dwyer Mc Innis (DL: M252-104-83-261-0, W/M, DOB: 7/21/1983). I entered Mr. Mc Innis drivers license into NCIC/FCIC which revealed that it was suspended since 1/9/2023.

I returned to Mr. Mc Innis and advised that his drivers license was suspended. I advised him to step out of the vehicle and walk to the front of my patrol vehicle so that I may further speak with him. When he stepped out of his vehicle he stumbled and portrayed a poor ability to balance even while walking to the rear of his vehicle. Once at my patrol vehicle, I asked if he knew about his driver's license being suspended, he stated no. While speaking with Mr. Mc Innis, I could still smell a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath. I asked Mr. Mc Innis if he had any medical conditions or currently took any medications, he replied no, however he stated that he had a bad lower back but was unable to give a specific reason. He further stated that he had prescription medication from his doctor, I asked what it was, he advised that he did not know. (note: while inventorying the vehicle he was driving, I found no prescription medication of any kind.) I asked if he had any current injuries or past injuries that would affect his ability to walk or stand on one leg, he stated no aside from his back being bad.

I explained that based on the totality circumstances (also explained them) that I have reason to believe that he may be under the influence of alcohol or a controlled substance. I offered Mr. Mc Innis the opportunity to take voluntary Field Side Sobriety exercises to help me better determine his level of intoxication, Mr. Mc Innis agreed. I asked if him if would feel comfortable performing these exercises at our current location, he stated yes.

Prior to administering the voluntary exercises in front of my patrol vehicle, I advised Mr. Mc Innis to stand in the starting position with his feet together and his hands at his sides. I asked Mr. Mc Innis if he wore contacts or glasses, he stated no. I asked if he could clearly see the black tip of my pen along with the tip of my finger, he stated yes. I asked him again if he had any medical conditions, was on any medications or had current injuries, he stated no. Each exercise was explained and demonstrated (numerous times until he understood) prior to Mr. Mc Innis attempting to perform them. Video and audio footage are available upon request. The summary below is not intended to be a verbatim account of all the events that took place during the administration of the standardized field sobriety exercises.

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus Exercise

A black ballpoint pen with a black tip was used as a contrasting stimulus. Mr. Mc Innis stated that he could clearly see the tip of the stimulus as well as the tip of my finger and that he did not wear contacts or glasses. The exercise was explained and demonstrated, Mr. Mc Innis stated that he understood the

instructions. Mr. Mc Innis failed to keep with head straight numerous times and had to be reminded to follow the stimulus with eyes only constantly. I observed that Mr. Mc Innis had a clear and obvious orbital sway while in the correct standing position.

- I checked for resting nystagmus which was not observed in both eyes.
- I checked for equal pupil size and equal tracking; Both pupils were equal in size but both eyes did not track the stimulus equally.
- I observed a lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes.
- I observed horizontal gaze nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes.
- I observed horizontal gaze nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in the right eye.
- I did not observed vertical gaze nystagmus in either eye.

Walk and Turn Exercise

Yellow tape was placed vertically in front of my patrol vehicle. Mr. Mc Innis agreed that ground surface was level and that he could perform the exercise. The exercise was explained and demonstrated multiple times until Mr. Mc Innis stated that he understood the directions. Mr. Mc Innis had a very difficult time understanding the directions or maintaining focus. I elaborated that his back was sore, however I explained to him that he had no issues other than poor balance up until this point. I explained to just attempt the exercise to the best of his ability. Mr. Mc Innis could not maintain the starting position and consistently used his arms for balance. As I tried to explain the exercise he appeared to daze off, then unable to recall my explanation. I had to explain the exercise multiple times until I felt he understood. He still was unable to perform the exercise correctly.

- Unable to maintain starting position
- Used arms to balance (the entire time)
- Did not count out loud
- Stepped off the line
- Did not touch heel to toe
- Incorrect number of steps

One Leg Stand Exercise

The exercise was explained and demonstrated numerous times until Mr. Mc Innis stated that he understood the directions, however he still had no clear recollection of the instructions despite me re-explaining them several times.

- Swayed
- Put foot down (consistently)
- Hopped
- Foot was not parallel with the ground
- Unable to maintain balance

Based upon the performance of the above exercises and the totality of the circumstances I determined that there was probable cause to believe that Christopher Dwyer Mc Innis committed the offense of driving under the influence by being in actual physical control/operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcoholic beverages, any chemical substance per Florida State Statute 877.111, or any controlled substance per Chapter 893, while their normal faculties were impaired. He was placed under arrest at approximately 1:13am for the above offense. He was handcuffed behind his back in the front of my patrol vehicle and placed in the rear right seat. Prior to placing Mr. Mc Innis in my patrol vehicle, I conducted a search of his person which yielded no results. A vehicle inventory was also conducted which yielded no results.

I transported Mr. Mc Innis to Palm Beach County Breathe Alcohol Testing (BAT) facility with no further incidents. Mr. Mc Innis underwent a 20-minute observation period at approximately 1:45am where he did not ingest anything by mouth or regurgitate (mouth was confirmed to be empty prior to beginning the observation period. At approximately 2:10am Mr. Mc Innis provided a refusal. He was read Florida Implied Consent, he again provided a refusal. Mr. Mc Innis was read Florida Miranda Warning, he advised that he did not want to answer any questions. (See BAT video footage for a complete account of the question and answering segment). Mr. Mc Innis was then booked into Palm Beach county jail with no further incident.

All events occurred in Palm Beach County, State of Florida.



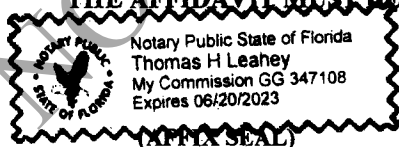
